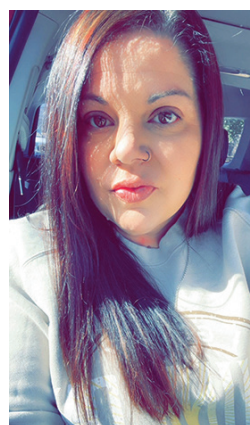

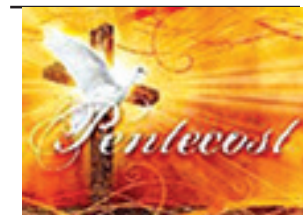

In the 1950s to 1970s, urban renewal programs caused many aging Victorian houses to be destroyed, with the loss of artistic hardware. 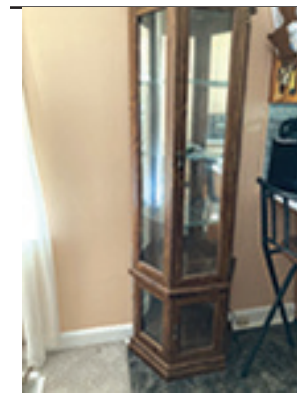

5 minute Peanut Butter Pie



Ingredients

- 1 graham cracker crust
- 8 oz cream cheese

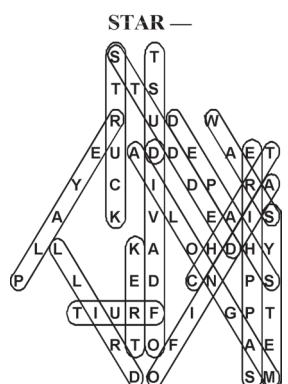
