



Piedmont Pets

When humans grieve, it is natural to revisit memories of experiences shared with the deceased loved one. My mother died on May 5th, and I have been thinking about is her role in how I feel about animals.

My first memories take place in Hawaii in the late 1950s. Since I was about three, my memory is rather short; however, I remember my mother holding a black kitten and telling me to be very gentle with her. Sadly, this was in the days before vaccinations were common and the kitten died shortly afterwards from distemper.

From this time, I also remember being introduced to another Army family's cocker spaniel. She was a beautiful buff color and whenever we visited, Princess would be sure to sit by me because I was always the one who would give her treats. I remember my mother telling me about the dogs she had when she was growing up.

Mother had a lifelong fear of lizards and mice. Despite her fear, she let my sister have a mouse that had come from an Army research lab. Although she never, ever touched the mouse that I remember, I do have a distinct memory of her telling me to be very still as the mouse was allowed to explore the pockets of my bathrobe. Her fear of any animal never caused her to treat the animal with anything other than kindness.

That became apparent when Daddy was transferred to Ft. Riley, Kansas. It was there that one of Daddy's company would go out on maneuvers in deserted areas of the prairie. One day, another sergeant in the company was going to be transferred and he told Daddy that he had picked up a horned toad during maneuvers, but could not take it with him. So, the tough sergeant with a marshmallow heart brought the horned toad home with him. You can imagine how Mother felt about! And yet, once again, she taught my sister and me how to meet the needs of that poor creature who should never have been kept as a pet. (Note: We only had that horned toad for a short time. The next time Daddy went out on maneuvers to the same area as before, he set the


Next came Baumholder, Germany. Army life wasn't really conducive to having dogs and cats as pets; however, Mother and Daddy let Susan have a parakeet. Mother was the caretaker and I remember her faithfully making sure Dixie had clean food and water bowls, a clean cage and time outside the cage. When we left, Dixie was given to a German woman who helped clean the barracks.

The final Army duty station was near San Diego, California. Susan and I were allowed to have hamsters, but when Mother went to the pet store to buy food one day, she saw a beautiful long-haired white cat that was deaf. She had plans on returning the next day to buy the cat; however, when she took Daddy and my sister there, they decided on the cutest dachshund beagle mix puppy and brought him home.

We named him Walter. Daddy said Walter had to stay outside most of the time. Mother just smiled. Walter slept with them that first night and every night of his life. He was Mother's constant companion.

As I look back, I realize there are lessons to be learned from how my Mother treated animals. The most important lesson of all is that no matter the species or circumstance, animals deserve to be treated kindly. Thank you, Mother.

Advertising Art

Advertising and store collectibles have historical significance and brand recognition as well as artistic value. A combination of all three brought this lamp a price of \$2,700 at Morford's Antique Advertising Auctions.

The lamp was made by Fenton, a well-known art glass company. Its bell-shaped blue shade for Bell Telephone Co. is eye-catching. The inscription "Local and Long Distance Telephone" marks it as a relic of the past.

There is little need for public telephones today when most people carry a phone with them and can get service wherever they go. But even before the age of cellphones, people liked having access to a telephone anywhere they went. This lamp probably hung in a hotel lobby to let visitors know there was a telephone available.

Q: Plastic and metal lunchboxes from the 1960s and 1970s really interest me. I have a Holly Hobbie lunchbox with thermos that I carried in grade school. Are lunchboxes hot collectibles?

A: Collectible lunchboxes bring back childhood memories of favorite television shows, movies, cartoons, sports teams and musical groups. Holly Hobbie (1944) is an American writer and illustrator whose artwork sometimes appears on lunchboxes. She is the author of the popular "Toot and Puddle" children's books and creator of the character bearing her name. In the early 1970s, Hobbie sold artwork of a cat-loving, rag-dress-wearing little girl in a giant bonnet to American Greetings. This series of illustrations became immensely popular, and her originally nameless character became known as "Holly Hobbie." Your lunchbox, if authentic, is worth about \$40.

TIP: Learn the dates of business cards and other advertising from telephone numbers. Numbers were first used in 1878. The seven-digit number was

in use by the 1940s; fewer than seven digits date the card from 1878 to the 1940s. From the 1920s to the 1950s, most urban areas had a two-letter "exchange" followed by numbers.

Q I really enjoyed a series of movies with Noah Wyle called "The Librarians." I read that it's being turned into a series. Where and when can I watch? —H.H.

A Noah Wyle ("ER") starred as librarian Flynn Carsen in three separate TV movies beginning in 2004: "Quest of the Spear," "Return to King Solomon's Mines," and "Curse of the Judas Chalice." The action-adventure telefilms were later spun off into a successful weekly series called "The Librarians," which ran for four seasons on TNT with Wyle, Rebecca Romijn ("Star Trek: Strange New Worlds") and John Larroquette ("Night Court").

Now, five years after its cancellation, the CW network has announced that it will launch another series, "The Librarians: The Next Chapter," with original executive producer and showrunner Dean Devlin at the helm. There will also be a "new team to help him clean up the mess he made, forming a new team of Librarians."

Her role as Det. Muncy on "SVU" began as a recurring one before turning into a series regular by the seventh episode of season 24. However, during a crossover episode with "Law & Order: Organized Crime," her character announced that she's leaving for a new assignment on the DEA task force. So far, Burnett hasn't comment-

ed on her departure from the show, but hopefully she'll bounce back with a new gig soon.

NBC recently announced that "SVU" will be back for an impressive 25th season this fall, which will solidify stars Mariska Hargitay and Ice-T as the longest running male and female actors in television. Some are speculating whether Burnett's exit might mean they're making room for Kelli Giddish to return as Det. Rollins, but at this stage, it's just speculation.

Q What happened to Christine Quinn on the Netflix series "Selling Sunset"? Is she still selling houses? —W.J.

A After five years as the villain on the real estate reality series "Selling Sunset," Christine Quinn either left or was fired from the Oppenheim Group, the brokerage firm featured on the show. She doesn't appear to miss it, however, hinting that she might someday start her own firm, and she's also said in interviews that she'd like to get back into "scripted" acting again. Her previous credits include parts on "Ballers" and "Drop Dead Diva."



Easy Crab cakes Recipe



INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound crab meat
- 3 tablespoons dry bread crumbs
- 2 teaspoons fresh parsley (chopped)
- 1 teaspoon Old Bay Seasoning
- 1 egg
- 2 tablespoons mayonnaise
- 1/2 teaspoon ground dry mustard

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven broiler.
Combine crab meat, bread crumbs, Old Bay Seasoning, and parsley. Mix until well incorporated. But do not overmix. Crab meat should be lumpy.
In a separate bowl, beat together mayonnaise, mustard, and egg. Combine with other ingredients and mix well.
Form into patties and refrigerate for about half an hour. This will allow the crab cakes to firm up and prevent them from cracking or breaking up in the pan.
Put the patties into a lightly greased baking sheet. Broil for 10 to 15 minutes (or until lightly brown).

Tips & Tricks for Easy Crab Cakes

Do not over-mix the ingredients, or the crab meat will break apart. Gently and slowly fold the ingredients together to keep all the yummy lumps intact.
Before forming your crab cake patties, refrigerate the mixture for about 30 minutes. This will make them a lot easier to form and will also prevent them from falling apart.




