Regardless of the recent changes in Minnesota law related to the legalization of marijuana, an individual who is a current user of marijuana is still federally defined as an "unlawful user"

> of a controlled substance and therefore is prohibited from shipping, transporting, receiving, or possessing firearms or ammunition.

"Until marijuana is legalized federally, firearms owners and possessors should be mindful that it remains federally illegal to mix

The 2023 Mille Lacs Energy Cooperative (MLEC) Annual Meeting was held on Thursday, May 18, at the Minnesota National Golf Course in McGregor. There were 205 registered members, with a total of 321 in attendance.

As only two members filed for the two open director positions, according to Article II, Section 8 of the MLEC Bylaws, both directors were elected by acclamation, and

discussed the various projects MLEC completed in 2022 and how the cooperative navigated supply chain issues and inflation. CEO Sarah Cron explained the access charge increase and how cooperatives set rates. Accounting and Finance Manager Lincoln Messner presented the financial report to the members.

Special guest speaker David Saggau, CEO and President of Great River Energy, gave a wholesale power report. He discussed carbon-free legislation and rate projections for the future.





was an extraordinary storyteller, a joke lover, a man that loved to laugh and to share with others the what he saw as the best things in life. He looked after and worried about his family, both immediate and extended, something that he started at age 15 when his father died. He quit school and went to work to support the family. He never quit working for the family, even in his later years, and was the guy to fix things. Like most of the Sharp boys of his generation he liked to read western paperbacks. He was an avid deer hunter and a fine man with a rifle, even as he got older. For many years he loved to spear in the winter in his spear house, and he taught several of the later generation how to do that. He had a route that he would sometimes drive, stopping by friends and relatives to visit and to see how things were going. 



ATF clarification on new Minnesota marijuana law | Continued from Page 1

marijuana with firearms and ammunition," said ATF's Acting Special Agent in Charge Jeff Reed, of the St. Paul Field Division. "As regulators of the firearms industry and enforcers of firearms laws, we felt it was important to remind Minnesotans of this distinction as the marijuana laws adjust here in the State of Minnesota."

People who are looking to purchase firearms must attest whether or not they are an unlawful user of marijuana on an ATF Form 4473 during a firearm transaction.

As states began easing re-

strictions on marijuana, ATF issued an open letter to Federal Firearms Licensees in 2011 to provide guidance on how to best comply with federal firearms laws and regulations.

The 2011 guidance reminds Federal Firearms Licensees that it is unlawful to transfer a firearm to any person knowing or having reasonable cause to believe that the person is an unlawful user of a controlled substance.

The Controlled Substance Act recognizes five categories while classifying various drugs, substances, and other

sidered a Schedule I drug, which under federal definition, has no accepted medical use and a high potential for abuse. Other drugs in this category include heroin, LSD, ecstasy, etc.

Federal law does not provide any exception allowing the use of marijuana for medicinal or recreational purposes.

ATF is a law enforcement agency that protects our communities from violent criminals, criminal organizations, the illegal use and trafficking of firearms, the illegal use and storage of explosives, acts of arson and bombings, acts of terrorism, and the illegal diversion of alcohol and tobacco products.
