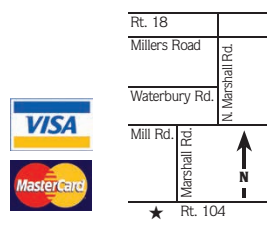

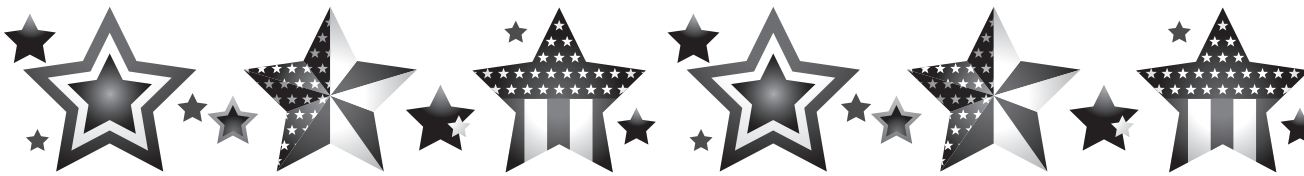

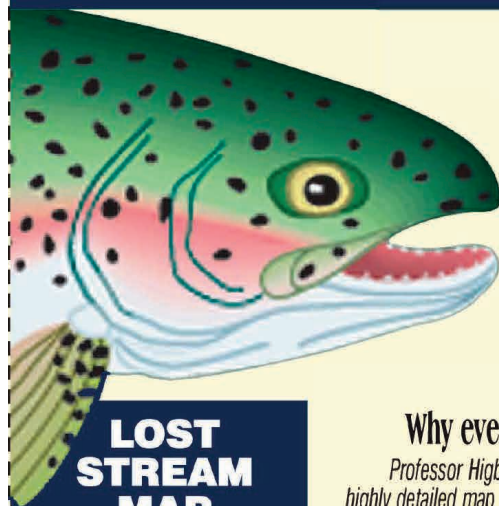

LOST STREAM MAP

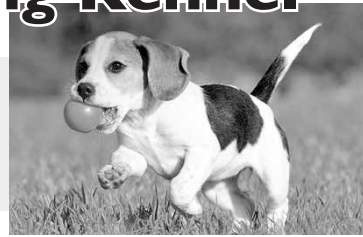

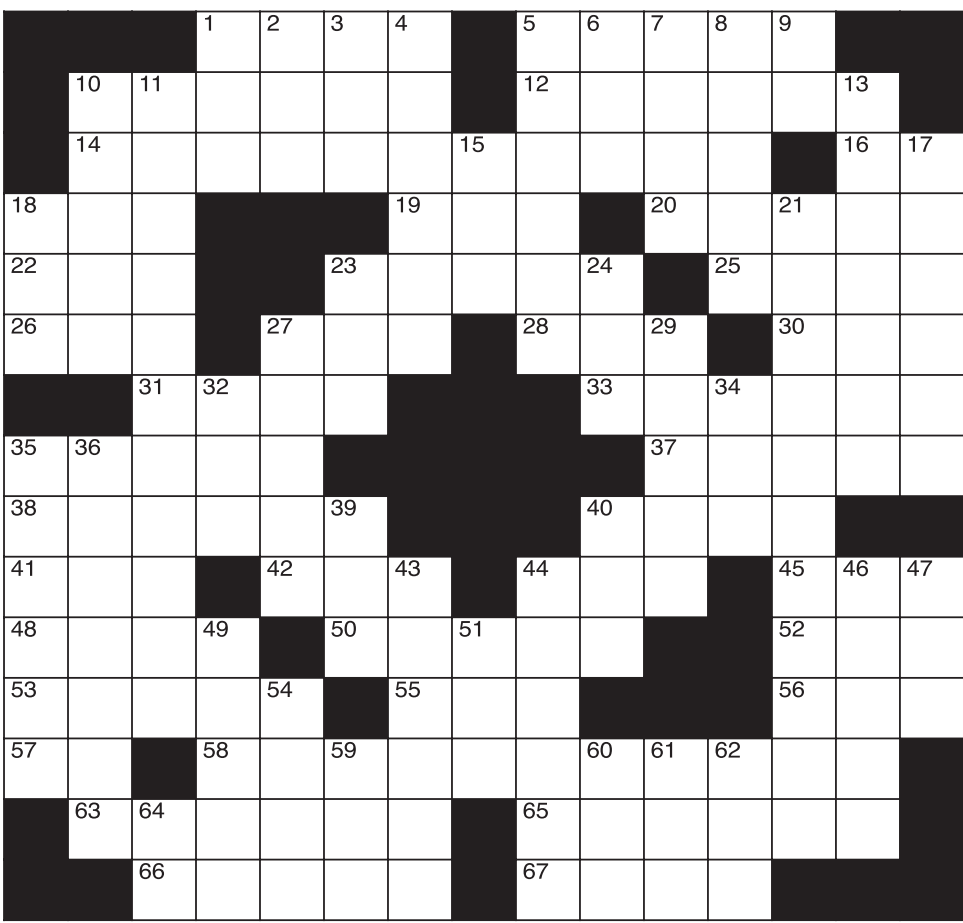

Roy-Hart High School Teacher Named Outstanding Science Teacher of the Year

Royalton-Hartland High School teacher Colleen Burkett was recognized as Outstanding High School Science Teacher of the Year by the Western New York American Chemical Society (WNY ACS). The ACS is the world's largest scientific society and one of the world's leading sources of authoritative scientific information. "I am honored to be recognized as the Outstanding Science Teacher of the Year by the American Chemical Society," says Burkett. "I have been a member of this professional society since college and have seen so many wonderful educators and scientists recognized for their efforts in their field of expertise. I am honored to be included in that list of individuals!"

Ms. Burkett received her Bachelors of Arts in Chemistry in 2006 from the College of Wooster. Following this she joined the University of Arizona's Surface and Imaging Facilities as a research assistant. She trained and led numerous teams that involved high school, undergraduate, and graduate students in analysis and problem solving in a laboratory setting. She created coursework and assessments while acting as a lead teaching assistant throughout her time in Arizona. She completed her Masters in 2017 at Arizona and began as a Chemistry teacher at Royalton-Hartland High School in January 2018. Superintendent Jill Heck remembers fondly when Colleen came to work for the district, "She was experienced, knowledgeable and had such a great background in chemistry from her work in the field. We were fortunate to get her on our staff, and she will continue to be an asset to Roy-Hart Central School District in the future."

She also teaches both Regents Chemistry and College Chemistry through Niagara County Community College (NCCC). She has developed a

new curriculum through a professional development grant and implemented a modern classroom format often referred to as "Flipped Classroom," with student-centered self-paced learning. She has ensured that her students meet academic benchmarks while remaining up-to-date and well-informed on science topics and progress. "The single best thing about being an educator is seeing the "lightbulb moment" for a student," she says. "It's the moment that they finally make a connection between something we're learning and a real-world phenomenon. It's the moment that they finally grasp a difficult topic we've been working on for a while. It's the moment when they tell you, "OH! This makes sense!" I know most of my students won't go on to study chemistry beyond high school, but I love getting kids excited about science in their real lives and I hope they carry this enthusiasm with them into the future."

Burkett is known for offering support to her fellow teachers at Roy-Hart with her expertise in digital tools and learning management systems. She is very dedicated to her students, colleagues and the community. Burkett is grateful for the support she receives in return. "This award also made me incredibly thankful for a supportive administration. My principal, Gary Bell, and superintendent, Jill Heck, have given me the freedom to explore new and interesting teaching methodologies in my classroom and we see it paying off dividends in the way my students are motivated to learn! A big thank you to Sarah English from Sweet Home High School, who has been a great mentor over the past five years. It would also be remiss of me to not thank my parents, Thomas and Cynthia Burkett, who were excellent examples of dedicated educators in the Western New York region."

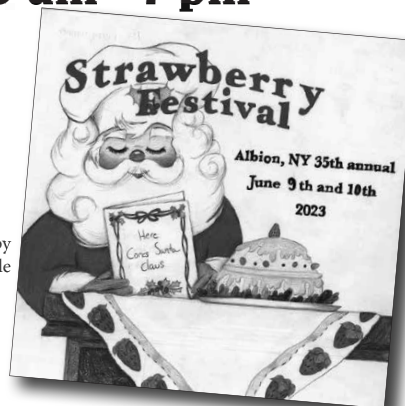

VILLAGE OF ALBION

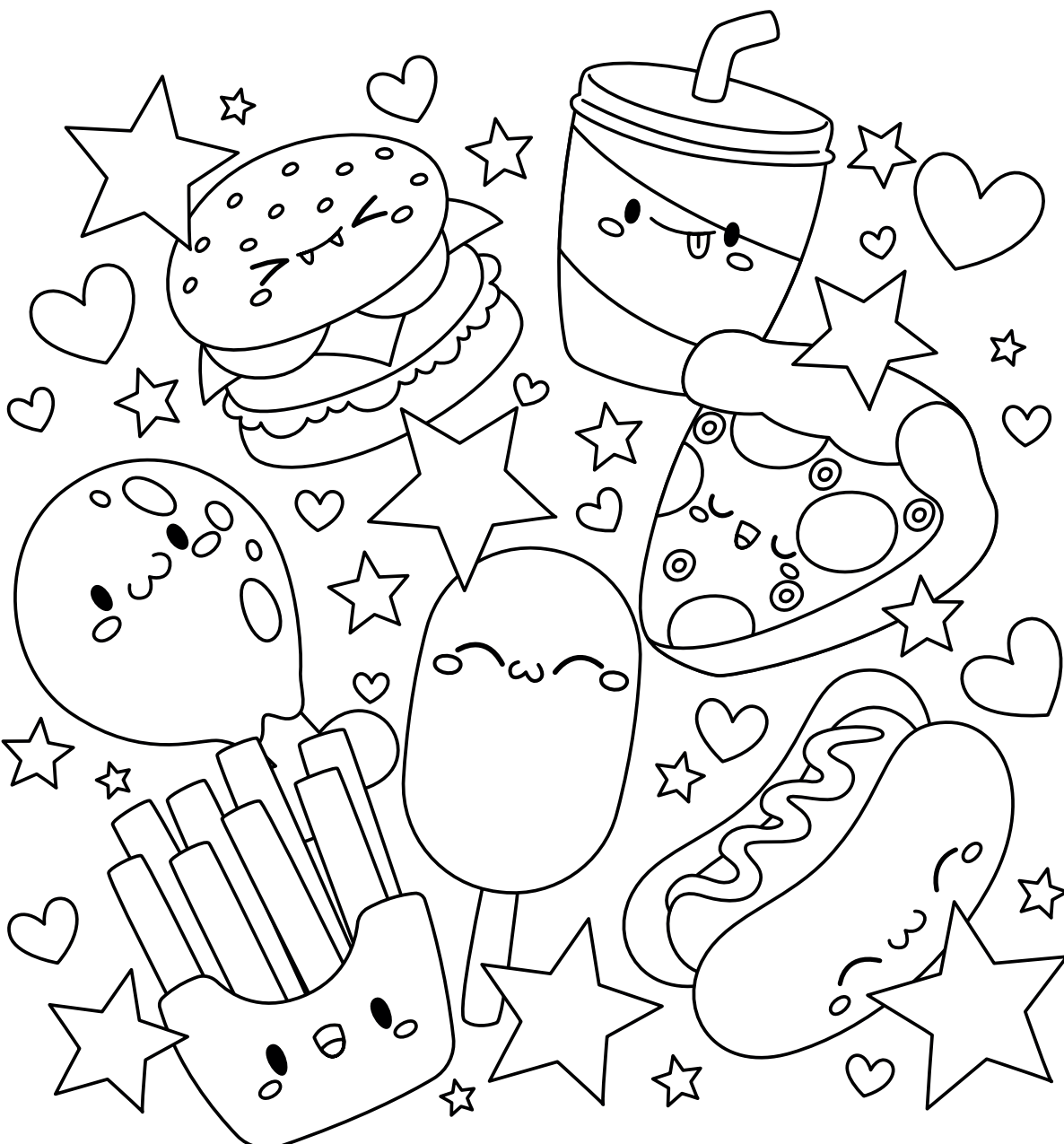
The Village of Newport was laid out in 1821, with approximately 100 acres where the Erie Canal crosses Oak Orchard Road (Route 98). The booming village was selected as the new county seat for the County of Orleans. The village was renamed Albion in 1826. The Erie Canal played an important part in the growth of early Albion. In about 1860, one of the main businesses was the quarrying of Medina Sandstone, which can be seen used as a main building material in and around downtown.

Serving as the central focal point of our historic district is the Orleans County Courthouse. It is a fine example of the Greek Revival style and was constructed in 1857-58 for \$20,000. This property is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is protected by the United States Department of the Interior.

To the south of the courthouse is the county clerk's building. It was built in 1882, in the Eastlake style, and was designed by the same architect who designed the "Million Dollar Staircase" in our capital building in Albany. This building is basically still used for its original purpose, with the county's legislative chambers on the second floor.


As one looks at the many historic churches surrounding our courthouse square, one begins to realize the history and the many architectural styles represented in Albion.

We hope you enjoy your day in Albion and at our Strawberry Festival!

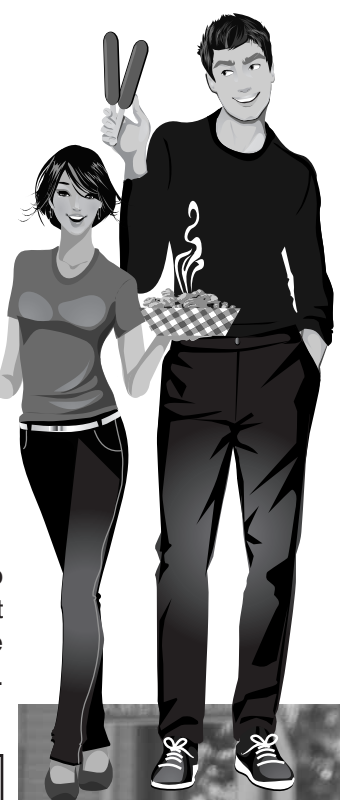

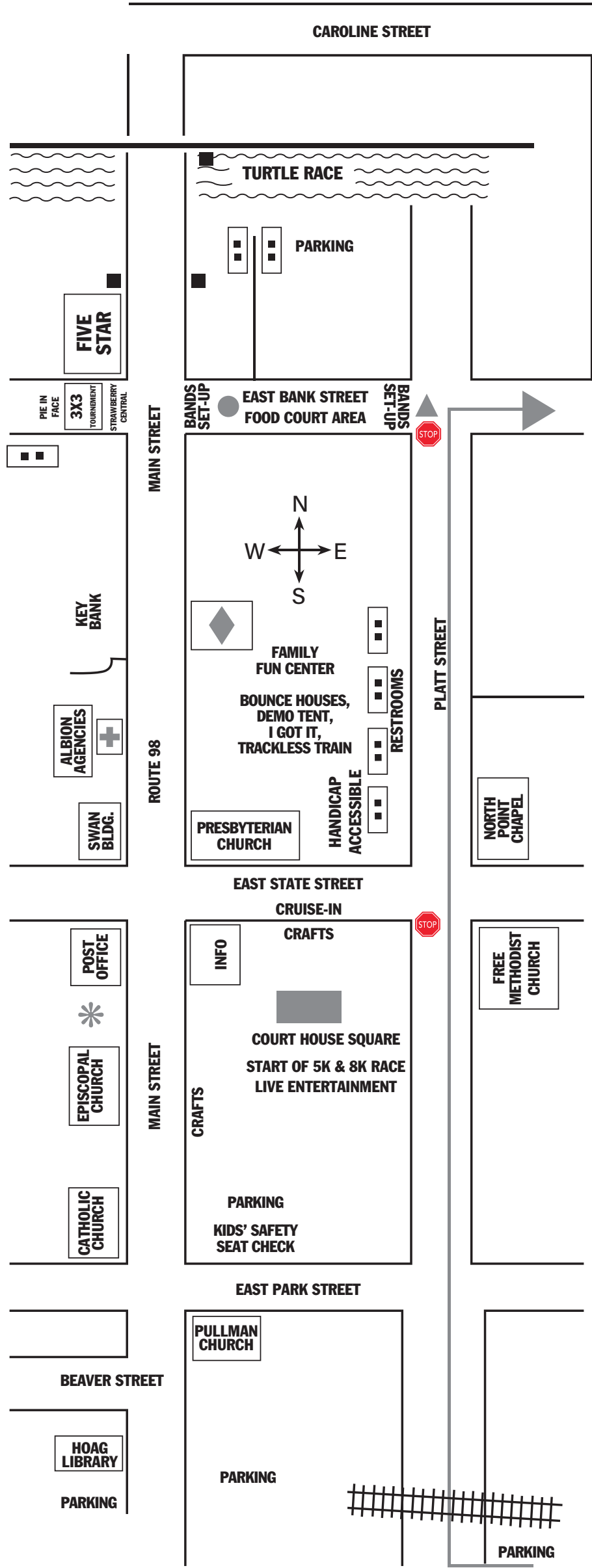

Refill with Randy

Good morning! Grab your favorite cup. Fill it up. And let's start this week right... TOGETHER!!!

Good morning! Grab your favorite cup. Fill it up. And let's start this week right by joining Randy as he remembers a friend's kindness during a time of crisis and talks about what it means to stand in the gap for someone.

There are a few things I want to mention up front today. First, I would like start by saying thank you to all who have taken the time to drop me a message on FB or introduce yourself to me out in the community. I am grateful for your feedback and hope to connect with more of you over time. Second, I would like to note that today's article follows up two previous ones from March 12th and April 23rd in case you wanted to reread them here (insert link to Hub Articles). And lastly, I wanted to note that I am writing this on May 30th which is significant because it was eleven years ago on this day when my mother lost her battle to brain cancer.

As I wrote about previously, after almost four months of surgeries, radiation, and chemo, which only worked to slow down the inevitable, my mother went to The Aurora House (a hospice home in Spencerport) to spend her final two weeks. It would have been more convenient to stay close to home but unfortunately our own Hospice Home here in Orleans County, the Martin-Linsen Residence, was still under construction. Thankfully though there was an apartment downstairs at the Aurora House which I was able to stay in for the duration of my mother's time there.

As the days went by I spent less and less time away as my mother grew weaker. If this was a marathon, as many people had referred to the process of caring for a loved one, I was about to hit the wall. It had been days since I had been able to eat or sleep much and part of the

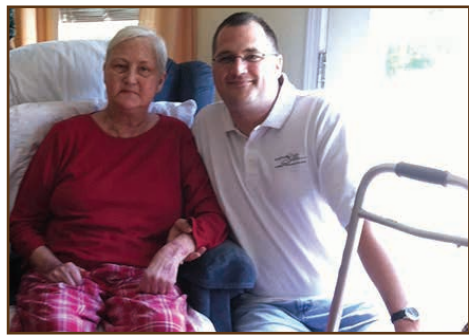


reason was that I didn't want to leave mom's side. I didn't want her to be alone. And that's when my friend John "Jack" Burris showed up to stand in the gap. One night he walked in around 10pm and announced that he was going to stay with mom through the night so that I could go downstairs and sleep. I knew it would be no use protesting so I did just that and, as it turned out, his timing was perfect because mom ended up passing away that next day and, thanks to being able to sleep, I had enough strength to deal with it better.

Now jump ahead to September of the same year. I had written previously about how I had begun running and eventually finished

the Niagara Hospice Half Marathon in 2011. It just so happened that the morning before mom passed I had signed both myself and my wife Sheryl to run it in 2012. (Quick note to any husbands reading this... I do not suggest signing your spouse up for a 13.1 mile race without her knowledge unless you can blame it on making an emotional decision like did.)

Well, long story short, I actually tried to run in the Strawberry Fest 5K that next week and ended up on an ambulance about the 2 mile mark for what they thought was a heart attack. Thankfully it turned out to just be the result of adding physical stress to the mental and emotional stress I had been under for so long and my body said no more. This was when I went on sabbatical and at times tried running again but could not train the way I needed to



by the time September rolled around. And that's when I called on Jack once more to stand in the gap and run the Half Marathon in my place.

Up to that point he had never ran that kind of distance but, just as I had run in memory of my friend Matt Jones the previous year, he agreed to take my place and run for mom. I will never forget that day, and only partly because my wife won't let me forget how I signed her up and then didn't even run it myself. No, I will always remember Jack using every last effort to get across the finish line and then immediately taking the medal, putting it around my neck, and saying "This is for mom". Jack and I have had many adventures together since that time,



whether driving to NYC to take care of my sister after her breast cancer surgery or working together on the Hands 4 Hope Street Ministry Truck, but it was his initial willingness to literally stand in the gap when I needed it most that forged the friendship that I am grateful for to this day.

Strawberry Shortcake



INGREDIENTS

- Yield: 4 generous servings*
- 2 pints ripe, strawberries
 - ½ cup sugar, or more to taste
 - 4 cups flour
 - 3 tablespoons sugar
 - ¼ teaspoon salt
 - 5 teaspoons baking powder
 - 1 ¼ cups butter
 - 3 cups whipping cream
 - ¼ teaspoon vanilla extract

PREPARATION

1. Pick over and hull strawberries. Cut in half or slice, depending on size. Gently crush about a quarter of the berries with a fork to release their juices. Mix with remaining berries and the ½ cup of sugar, adding more sugar if necessary. Set aside, covered, for about half an hour to develop flavor.
2. Preheat oven to 450 degrees.
3. Into a large mixing bowl, sift together flour, 3 tablespoons sugar, salt and baking powder. Add ¾ cup of softened butter, and rub into dry ingredients as for pastry. Add 1¼ cups cream, and mix to a soft dough. Knead the dough for one minute on a lightly floured pastry board, then roll it out to about ½-inch thickness. Using a 3-inch biscuit cutter, cut an even number of rounds - 2 rounds per serving.
4. Use a little of the butter to grease a baking sheet. Place half the rounds on it. Melt remaining butter and brush a little on the rounds; place remaining rounds on top. Bake for 10 to 15 minutes, or until golden brown.
5. Remove from the oven, and pull shortcakes apart. Brush the insides with some of the remaining melted butter.
6. Beat remaining cream until it thickens. Add vanilla. Beat again just until thick.
7. Place a bottom half of a shortcake on each plate. Top with a generous spoonful of berries. Cover with a top half, add a few more berries, and top with whipped cream. Serve immediately.

Tip: Extra shortcakes may be frozen, but they should be warmed before using. They are also good toasted for breakfast or tea.
