Lyman White Park on the river in Brainerd open to public

Up to bat, you fly out a few times and hit a few foul balls, but, eventually, you hit one out of the park.

This is what happened to the Brainerd Riverfront Committee, which, after almost 13 years of planning and changes, brought the Lyman P. White Park on the Mississippi River in Brainerd to fruition.

Once just a parking lot across the street from Brainerd High School sports fields, the new outdoor complex has an amphitheater, two covered pavilions, two overlooks, a kayak launch, restrooms, organic playground and many

more features.

Families can stroll along riverfront paths, picnic, play, learn, or listen to music.

At the ribbon-cutting on June 3, Mayor Dave Badeaux said "We are the ones who had to say no."

It was up to the city council and parks department to keep the ambitious project on time and within budget. "But today is the day we get to celebrate saying yes," exclaimed Badeaux.

The federal government contributed planning expertise and the state of Minnesota, a LCMR grant, to the project.

Don Gorham of the Riverfront Committee was excited to expand the vision to the west side of the river, and to the north. "Mr. Mayor and city council, give the Riverfront Committee a new

challenge," he proposed.

Lyman P. White was considered the Father of Brainerd. He built one of the first homes in north Brainerd at Juniper and Seventh streets. He also donated the land for the

St. Paul's Episcopal Church and was instrumental in the formation of Gregory Park.

His son Almond donated the Mississippi Park land in 1921. At one time it was known as Tourist Park.

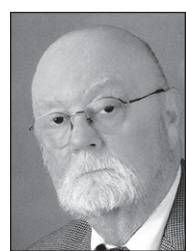
Jerome is survived by two sons: Donald Novak and Jerry Novak of Fifty Lakes; two daughters:
