

GOLDEN CHICKEN CORDON BLEU

Yeild 2 servings

Ingredients

- 2 boneless skinless chicken breast halves (6 ounces each)
- 2 slices deli ham (3/4 ounce each)
- 2 slices Swiss cheese (3/4 ounce each)
- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/8 teaspoon paprika

• 1/8 teaspoon pepper

- 1 large egg
- 2 tablespoons 2% milk
- 1/2 cup seasoned bread crumbs
- 1 tablespoon canola oil
- 1 tablespoon butter, melted

Directions

1. Flatten chicken to 1/4-in. thickness; top each with a slice of ham and cheese. Roll up and tuck in ends; secure with toothpicks.

2. In a shallow bowl, combine the flour, salt, paprika and pepper. In another bowl, whisk egg and milk. Place bread crumbs in a third bowl. Dip chicken in flour mixture, then egg mixture; roll in crumbs.

3. In a small skillet, brown chicken in oil on all sides. Transfer to an 8-in. square baking dish coated with cooking spray.

4. Bake, uncovered, at 350° until a thermometer reads 170°, for 20-25 minutes. Discard toothpicks; drizzle with butter.





ORANGE-SPICED CHICKEN

Yeild 4 servings

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup thawed orange juice concentrate
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1/4 cup soy sauce
- 1 teaspoon Chinese five-spice powder
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 4 boneless skinless chicken breast halves (5 ounces each)

Directions

1. In a small bowl, combine the first five ingredients. Pour 1/2 cup marinade into a large resealable plastic bag; add chicken. Seal bag and turn to coat; refrigerate for 2 hours. Cover and refrigerate remaining marinade.

2. Drain and discard marinade. Moisten a paper towel with cooking oil; using long-handled tongs, lightly coat the grill rack. Grill chicken, covered, over medium heat or broil 4 in. from the grill for 5-7 minutes on each side or until a thermometer reads 170°, basting frequently with reserved marinade.

BAKED ALMOND CHICKEN BREASTS

Yeild 6 servings

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
 1/3 cup plus 1 tablespoon
- butter, melted, divided1 teaspoon celery salt
- 1 teaspoon celery sai
 1 teaspoon paprika
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon sun
 1/2 teaspoon curry powder
- 1/2 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 6 boneless skinless chicken breast halves
- 1-1/2 cups heavy whipping cream
- 1/3 cup dry bread crumbs
- 3/4 cup sliced almonds, toasted
- Hot cooked pasta

Directions

1. Place flour in a shallow bowl. Combine 1/3 cup butter and seasonings in another bowl. Coat chicken with flour, then dip in butter mixture. Arrange in a greased shallow 3-qt. baking dish. Pour cream around chicken.

2. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 45 minutes. Combine bread crumbs and remaining butter; sprinkle over chicken. Top with almonds. Bake, uncovered, for 5-8 minutes or until golden brown. Serve over pasta.

CHICKEN IN BASIL CREAM

Yeild 4 servings

Ingredients

- 1/4 cup whole milk
- 1/4 cup dry bread crumbs
- 4 boneless skinless chicken breast halves (4 ounces each)



- 3 tablespoons butter
- 1/2 cup chicken broth
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1 jar (4 ounces) sliced pimientos, drained
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1/4 cup minced fresh basil
- 1/8 teaspoon pepper

Directions

1. Place milk and bread crumbs in separate shallow bowls. Dip chicken in milk, then coat with crumbs. 2. In a large skillet over medium-high heat, cook chicken in butter until a thermometer inserted in chicken reads 165°, about 5 minutes on each side. Remove and keep warm.

3. Add broth to the skillet. Bring to a boil over medium heat; stir to loosen browned bits. Stir in the cream and pimientos; boil and stir for 1 minute. Reduce heat. Add the cheese, basil and pepper; cook and stir until heated through. Serve with chicken.

ONION CHICKEN

Yeild 4 servings

Inaredients

- 1/2 cup butter, melted
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 teaspoon ground mustard
- 1 can (2.8 ounces) french-fried onions, crushed
- 4 boneless skinless chicken breast halves (4 ounces each)

Directions

1. In a shallow bowl, combine butter, Worcestershire sauce and mustard. Place onions in another shallow bowl. Dip chicken in butter mixture, then coat with onions.

2. Place in a greased 11x7-in. Baking dish; drizzle with remaining butter mixture. Bake, uncovered, at 400° for 20-25 minutes or until a thermometer reads 165°.

SPINACH-STUFFED CHICKEN BREASTS

Yeild 4 servings

Ingredients

- 4 cups fresh baby spinach 2 teaspoons plus 1/4 cup olive oil, divided
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- 1/2 cup garlic-herb spreadable cheese
- 2/3 cup plus 1/4 cup seasoned bread crumbs, divided
- 1/2 teaspoon salt, divided
- 4 boneless skinless chicken breast halves (6 ounces each)
- 1 large egg, lightly beaten
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper

Directions

1. In a large skillet, saute spinach in 2 teaspoons oil until spinach is wilted. Add garlic; cook 1 minute longer. Remove from the heat. Stir in the spreadable cheese, 2/3 cup bread crumbs and 1/4 teaspoon salt. Cut a pocket in the thickest part of each chicken breast; fill with spinach mixture. Secure with toothpicks.

2. Place egg in a shallow bowl. In another shallow bowl, combine the pepper and remaining bread crumbs and salt. Dip chicken in egg, then coat with bread crumb mixture.

3. In a large skillet over medium heat, cook chicken in remaining oil for 8-10 minutes on each side or until a thermometer reads 170°. Discard toothpicks before serving.







CLAYBANK MASTER GARDENERS Greetings Gardener Friends,

I write this after the weeks-long storms that so far have provided

over 8" of rain in our yard. Following several weeks of no rain at all, the abundant rainfall is most appreciated and welcome! Of course if you have a veggie garden you might find that while rain provides many nutrients to plants, too much rain at one time can leach out the nutrients and cause disease



and insect pressure. Here are a few tips to help:*Fertilize your plants to restore a healthy balance. I use **compost** from under the compost pile or soil from wooded areas, or even some Black Kow composted manure: a shovelful in a bucket of water for 24 hours will drown unwanted plant-eating insects. **But don't drown the worms!** Throw them back in the compost pile, to do their job breaking down the solid matter into fertile soil. **Chicken or rabbit manure** works great without composting.

*Finely crushed cleaned **eggshells** around the base of your plants will foil the **slugs** that show up at night to gobble up the leaves of your plants.

*Ants that have taken up residence in pots will leave after you drench the soil with water or with a Neem oil solution (1 tablespoon per gallon of water).

*Fish emulsion, or fish fertilizer, will be a safe organic way to boost the nutrients in your soil. Mix a tablespoon or two in a gallon of water and apply to the roots of your fruit or flower-bearing plants.

*Look up **companion planting** to find out what plants are happy growing with which other plants. You probably know about planting basil and onions with tomatoes. Nitrogen fixing plants such as peas and beans add nitrogen to the soil, essential for plants such as lettuce & corn.

The Extension **SOW app says** you can plant these seeds now: basil, collards, corn, Mexican tarragon, okra, oregano, pumpkins, rosemary, southern peas, thyme, and watermelons.

Do you want to learn how to be a **Master Gardener**? This fall **Coffee County** will sponsor the class, part online, and part inperson labs. **Call the Extension Office at New Brockton for times and dates at (334) 894-5596.**






