Mental Health affects children as well as adults

Mental health affects everyone regardless of age. In 2019 it was estimated that, "1 in every 5 U.S. children ages 3-17 has a mental, emotional, behavioral, or developmental disorder" (U.S. Department of Health and Human Services). Risk factors can include genetic predispositions and environmental influences such as family environment, stressors relating to school, or peers. Another risk factor is lack of community support, this can include the stigma of seeking mental health treatment. Hurdles to getting mental health treatment for children can include issues with health insurance or parental support.

How can you get your children the care they need?

At Oak Orchard Health we recognize that seeking pediatric behavioral health care can feel like a daunting challenge. Finding a therapist for mental health care for children and teens, especially in rural communities, can be few and far between. We also know that seeking treatment in a familiar place such as the child's primary care doctor's office can bring feelings of comfort and trust as it is a familiar setting.

Oak Orchard Health's behavioral health therapists work with the child's primary care provider ensuring collaboration of care for the child. Therapists can also engage with the child's caregivers and school to ensure the child is being supported in the influential areas of their life. Collaboration with these important parties is essential to finding strategies and applying coping skills for our pediatric patients.

The key to success for most kids is a combination of protective factors such as good coping skills and self-esteem to help foster resiliency in overcoming mental health obstacles. Supportive people in the family and/

or role models outside of the family structure are important. Other protective factors are academic achievement, engagement with school, and positive hobbies with peers. (Youth.

How play therapy helps children

Parents and caregivers might wonder how their child would open up to a therapist in counseling. Children learn and express themselves through explorative play often creating narratives of how they perceive their world; this is simply referred to as "play therapy." Traditional talk therapy might work well with some children who enjoy verbalizing their thoughts and feelings; however, for most children expression happens through play in the therapy session.

The pediatric therapists at OOH often have coloring utensils, Legos, and therapeutic games to aid children in telling their stories and expressing their emotions and in turn learning how to regulate these emotions. During sessions with kids, I spend most of our time seated on the floor playing with Legos or card games, or at the coloring table drawing or painting. One of the best compliments I have received was, "Wow this room looks just like a living room!" when a child entered my office for the first time. The time spent in sessions is one of the few times children have the freedom to express and engage in their own self-directed way to sort out challenging emotions. This in and of itself can be very therapeutic and healing for a child to know they have a space free of judgment to engage in self-expression of many big emotions.

Is tea or coffee the healthier choice?

Millions of people consume coffee or tea, with some even enjoying multiple cups of these caffeinated beverages daily. Coffee is known to perk a person up in the morning, while tea is touted as a relaxing drink that can ease away stress. Some may wonder if one of these popular beverages is more beneficial for



overall health than the other. Both, it turns out, have distinctive benefits.

Coffee and certain teas contain caffeine, a powerful stimulant for the central nervous system. Caffeine may improve endurance exercise outcomes and improve mental alertness. Healthline says that caffeine may reduce type 2 diabetes risk by improving insulin sensitivity. In addition, moderate caffeine intake has been linked to protective effects against dementias, metabolic syndrome and non-alcoholic fatty liver disease. Since coffee tends to have higher concentrations of caffeine than black tea (95 mg vs. 47 mg in an eight-ounce serving), it can provide more caffeine-related benefits than tea.

Both tea and coffee have high levels of antioxidants that can help people reduce their risk for certain illnesses. The National Cancer Institute reports that antioxidants in both tea and coffee have been shown to slow the growth of cancerous tumors. Tea may help lower cholesterol and the polyphenols in tea could boost good bacteria in the gut, according to Eat This, Not That! People may be more inclined to drink more coffee and tea so they can consume more antioxidants. However, excess coffee consumption can make people jittery from too much caffeine. Since tea has less caffeine, it might make for a better choice.

But tea and coffee provide similar health benefits, and one isn't necessarily better than the other.





Let's go on an adventure together....to The Mississippi River!


Who hasn't heard of the Mississippi River? If you've ever read Mark Twain's Tom Sawyer stories, you know it well. In grade school, you probably learned how to spell it by saying "M-i-crooked letter-crooked letter-i-crooked letter-crooked letter-i-hump back-hump back-i". It passes through ten states: Minnesota, Wisconsin, Iowa, Illinois, Missouri, Kentucky, Tennessee, Arkansas, Mississippi, and Louisiana, so if you have visited any of these states, you likely saw it in person. The Mighty Mississippi River is the second longest river in North America and the fourth longest river in the world. It is, in deed, mighty and famous from stories of the old south and steam boats and being a major link for commerce to ship goods across the country.

I've seen the Mississippi River up close several times. I was so excited to get to visit the Head Waters on the cross country trip I took with my brother and sister-in-law in their motorhome in 2016. The Mississippi River begins at Lake Itasca, Minnesota (the word Itasca means True Head).

The location of the Mississippi Head Waters is the only place anywhere along the Mississippi River where you can actually walk across it - it is the narrowest, shallowest, and slowest flow, allowing easy wading and playing in the waters.

The location of the Head Waters is a beautiful area. There is a wonderful Visitor's Center with lots of amazing information and Native American artifacts and several walking trails. There is a spot where they installed steps so you can walk down to the absolute narrowest point of the river and walk across to another set of steps on the other side. Lake Itasca is stunning and the spot where it flows to feed the start of the Mississippi is a wonderful place to get in and wade and play in the water. And YES of course I got in at both the narrowest spot and the actual Head Waters and did walk across the Mississippi. It was so much fun. There were many times on that trip that I declared "This is the BEST thing, yet!", but this is one that sticks out as one of the coolest things we did. It is an experience I'll never forget.

We drove along and crossed the Mississippi many times on that trip as we traveled through several





The Mississippi River in New Orleans, Louisiana. This is the deepest point of the river at 200 feet deep and is the last part of the river before the delta flows into the


states - including when we got to see the Gateway Arch in St. Louis, Missouri. But, the next major experience we had on the Mississippi was in New Orleans, Louisiana. We were visiting family there my nephew and his family lived in Houma, LA at the time – and we all took a river boat cruise out of the French Quarter in New Orleans. We took the Natchez - one of only two true steam boats still active on the Mississippi River, today. The Natchez cruised from the heart of the French Quarter along the crescent of the Mississippi River, which is the deepest point of the river at 200 feet deep – giving us the honor of being able to say we were at the start and end, as well as, the shallowest and the deepest points of the Mighty Mississippi all in one trip! It was so beautiful and gave us a view of New Orleans that can't be seen from the streets. On this cruise, we saw everything from sandy beaches with people out for a stroll or fishing, to major industry like a Domino Sugar Refinery and oil refineries, to shipping operations, to the beautiful New Orleans skyline.....what a diverse section of the river just amazing! I thoroughly enjoyed checking this major bucket list item off my list - Take a River Boat Cruise on the Mississippi!

On my trip to Iowa in 2017, I had another memorable experience with the Mississippi River. I stayed in Dubuque and discovered a wonderful River Walk park along the Mississippi. I spent a lot of time strolling along the river looking at the amazing sculptures by local artists and enjoying the beautiful weather. That River Walk happens to have views of the first railroad bridge built across the Mississippi in 1867-68. Andrew Carnegie supplied the iron for the \$800,000 railroad bridge spanning 1,535 feet, which provided an alternative to ferry crossings across the river. The bridge is still in use, today - I watched a train cross it! There is also the remains of an old shot tower constructed in 1856 to produce lead shot ammunition. Molten lead was poured into the top of the tower and passed through a series of sieves to form the proper shot size. The shots then fell into a tank of cold water at the bottom of the tower. It was so cool to see and learn about these historic points of interest along the Mississippi River.

More recently, I got to spend some time on another River Boat cruise on the Mississippi when I visited Memphis, TN in 2021. Wonder when and where I will experience her the next time we meet.
