
Youth Corner

Dickinson County Treasurer's News

The Dickinson County Driver's License Station will begin charging a \$10 convenience fee for issuance of a driver's license or identification card to anyone who is not a resident of Dickinson County unless the resident pays property taxes here. This goes into effect on July 1, 2023, per an Iowa Code change.

On May 4, 2023, the Governor signed House File 718 into law to reduce property taxes. This bill allows counties that issue driver's licenses to charge a \$10 convenience fee in addition to the other fees for the issuance or renewal of a driver's license or nonoperator's identification card to a person who is not a resident of the county unless that person pays property taxes to the county. Proof of payment such as a receipt or another form of proof determined by the county is required.

Dickinson County Treasurer Kris Rowley says, "HF718 was a property tax reduction bill.

Because county driver's license stations are subsidized by property taxes, the \$10 convenience fee for driver's licenses and identification cards was put into the bill to help counties better cashflow when out-of-county residents use their services. These county services are supported by county property taxes."

Treasurer Rowley says, "We're glad to help both our county residents and those coming from outside the county with their driver's license and identification card needs. Our driver's license station is open by appointment only. To make an appointment call our office at 712-336-6333 (option 3)."

Rowley also says, "For those who are planning to travel by air in the future, the REAL ID deadline is now May 7, 2025. When the REAL ID enforcement date goes into effect, all U.S. travelers must have a REAL ID or a U.S. Passport to board domestic flights and access certain federal buildings. Our office can help you with this as well. We also take U.S. Passport photos.'

An Animal Welfare Perspective" Webinar on July 19

The Iowa State University Extension and Outreach Dairy Team's 2023 Dairy Webinar Series continues Wednesday, July 19, from 12 noon to 1 p.m. CDT, with a focus on managing heat stress. Dr. Jennifer Van Os will discuss heat stress in dairy cows and calves from an animal welfare perspective, including recognizing how cattle tell us they need help beating the heat.


"Dr. Van Os will promote best practices in management and housing to help the dairy industry adapt as our scientific knowledge about animal welfare continues to grow," said Fred Hall, dairy specialist with ISU Extension and Outreach.

Additionally, Van Os will review options for heat abatement strategies for lactating cows and pre-weaned calves in the Midwest. She will share some of the latest research coming out of UW-Madison on keeping cows and calves cool and comfortable.

The research in her lab at UW-Madison focuses on understanding, evaluating, and improving the welfare of dairy animals from biological- and social-science perspectives.

the morning field day. At the completion of the morning field day, a complimentary noon lunch will be served.



Nonstick cooking spray 142 cups all-purpose flour 1 teaspoon cornstarch 1/2 teaspoon baking powder 1/4 teaspoon salt 1 stick unsalted butter, softened 3/4 cup granulated sugar

1 large egg, at room temperature

1 teaspoon vanilla extract Red, white and blue sprinkles

Vanilla Buttercream Frosting 1 stick unsalted butter, softened 11/2 cups powdered sugar

1 tablespoon heavy whipping cream 1 teaspoon pure vanilla extract

Preheat oven to 350°F. Spray a 24-count mini muffin pan with cooking spray. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together the flour, cornstarch, baking powder, and salt. In a mixing bowl, beat the butter and granulated sugar together for 1 to 2 minutes. Mix in the egg and vanilla extract, scraping down the sides of the bowl. Mix in the dry ingredients until just combined. Divide the dough into 24 pieces and press each ball into the mini muffin pan. Bake for 11

to 13 minutes, or until the edges of the cookie cups are lightly browned. Remove from the oven, and make an indentation in each cookie using the back of a measuring spoon. Allow to cool in the muffin pan. To make the frosting: in a large mixing bowl, beat the butter for 1 to 2 minutes. Add the powdered sugar, a little at a time until combined. Add the heavy whipping cream and vanilla extract, scraping down the sides. Pipe the frosting into the cooled cookie cups and top with the sprinkles.

The Iowa State University Extension and Outreach Dairy Team, along with the Quad State Dairy Goat Classic and Iowa 4-H will host the first ever youth dairy goat judging contest on Friday, July 14, at the Clay County Fairgrounds located at 800 W 18th St. in Spencer, Iowa. The event will be in conjunction with the Quad State Classic Dairy Goat Show.

Individuals and teams are eligible to compete. Teams will be comprised of up to four individuals in each division (novice and senior) with the top scoring three individuals being tallied for the team score. A novice will be 5 to 14 years old on the day of the contest. A senior will be 15 to 21 years of age on the day of the contest. If an individual is not associated with a team, he/ she can be grouped with other individuals to form a team or will be eligible to compete for individual awards.

On-line registration will close on Friday, July 7, while in-person registration will be available at the show between 3:00 and 3.30 pm. Individuals can register for \$5/person. Teams will be registered for \$10/team plus \$5 for each individual. Individuals with no team affiliation are eligible to compete. Bing Crosby's 1935 rendition of Red Sails in the Sunset garnered the top spot on Research Director RD's list of top songs to celebrate Independence Day 2023. Later versions of the song were recorded by Les Brown and his Band of Renown, in 1951, and The Beatles in Live at The Cavern Club in Hamburg, Germany, in 1962.

Red Rubber Ball, a Top Five Hit by The Cyrkle, sold over one million copies, and was awarded a Gold Record. The Cyrkle's Tom Daws is also famous for creating the Alka Seltzer jingle, Plop Plop, Fizz, Fizz.

A White Sport Coat, written and recorded by Marty Robbins in

1947, topped the Country charts and also secured the Number Two slot on the pop charts!

White on White was a Top Ten Hit for British singer Danny William, with cover versions by Nelson Riddle and The Johnny Mann Singers, also released at about the same time. The ever popular *Blue Moon*, written by Rodgers and Hart in 1934, was one of the most successful songs ever written, That popularity peaked when the Doo Wop group, The Marcels, recorded it in 1957. It became an international chart-topper in 1961. While *Blue Velvet* was originally released by Tony Bennett in 1951, it was Bobby Vinton's 1963 recording...

Yes RD also came up with a most appropriate song selection, Watch What Happens, for which Tony Bennett had one of the earliest recordings. It was part of his 1965 Columbia album, If I Ruled the World: Songs for the Jet Set. And that's no joke! Live music abounds at just about every turn during holiday weekends in Okoboji. To start you in the right direction, RD has a short list that includes a stop at the Little Swan Lake Winery, where food, fun and live music can be enjoyed in a beautiful barn that is over 100 years old!
