Many years ago, our cat adoption policy was changed to require cats adopted from us to be kept strictly inside. We received criticism about it, but now most shelters require the same thing.

It is vital to keep cats inside. Outside cats face many dangers, and their life expectancy is 1-5 years. A cat kept strictly inside has an average life expectancy of 12-18 years.

Contact with other cats outside leads to the risk of disease transmission. Feline leukemia and feline immunodeficiency are transmitted from cat to cat and, once contracted, result in the eventual death of the animal.

Dogs and other wild animals pose a threat to cats; the very real danger is one of exposure to rabies. Outdoor cats can suffer torn ears, cut eyes, abscesses, and other injuries requiring veterinary treatment.

Indoor cats are not generally exposed to fleas, ticks, ear mites, or other parasites that can cause anemia, skin irritations, allergic reactions, and even death.

Outdoor cats are at risk to be poisoned. Neighbors may deliberately poison cats they view as nuisances, but accidental poisonings also occur. Chemically treated lawns, bait left out to kill rats or mice, and antifreeze can all be deadly dangers.

It is a myth that cats are "streetwise." Cats are intelligent and alert, but they stand very little chance against traffic. We can tell horror stories, and even have the pictures, of outside cats that have been beheaded, scalped, electrocuted, burned, tortured, or starved. dogfighting investigation seminar I

Trees also present hazards for the outside cat. Dogs or loud noises can scare a cat to climb so high, they cannot get down. I have heard repeatedly that a cat can climb down a tree. The reality is, cats cannot easily climb down facing the ground, and they usually do not back down out of a tree. We have had to intervene countless times to get them out of trees.

We have also had to rescue countless cats (kittens, mostly) from the engines of cars. Some survive, and some do not.

The list of hazards for outside cats goes on and on.

Outside cats are at the mercy of the people they encounter, as well as weather conditions and other animals. We encourage everyone to keep their cats inside. It truly is the best life for a cat.

"Make-do" mirror

"Use it up, wear it out, make it do, or do without." These were words to live by in the days before mass production, online shopping and overnight ship-

This leaf-shaped hand mirror in an irregular wooden frame is a "makedo" mirror, made by setting a broken mirror in a frame so it could still be used. It sold for \$438 at Cowan's Auctions. The shape of the mirror and the chip carving on its frame and handle show it was made with care — a piece of folk art as well as a utilitarian object.

* * * Q: I recently saw some dishes with red, green and yellow flowers labeled "Delft." I always thought Delft was blue and white. Was I mistaken, or were the dishes mislabeled?

A: Delft, or delftware, is a type of tin-glazed pottery like faience and majolica. It was first made in the city of Delft in Holland in the 17th century, and later in England and other countries. It is often white with blue decorations but sometimes can be multicolored, known as polychrome. Pieces are usually everyday-ware like dishes and tiles. Delft marked "Holland" was made in 1891 or later. If it is marked "Delft," it is probably from the 20th or 21st century. Today, blue-and-white porcelain may be marked and sold as Delft. Authentic Delft is pottery and softer than porcelain, so antique pieces often show signs of wear. Prices depend on age and condition.

Q: I have a set of three wooden nesting tables. They've been in our family for as a long as I can remember. They are lightweight and small. The top on the largest one is only 20 inches by 14 inches. Who invented nesting tables and are antique ones valuable?

A: Nesting tables were made in England in the 18th century. The cabinet maker Thomas Sheraton is credited with being the first to make them. They were designed to be functional

while taking up very little space in small English houses. Sets of antique nesting tables similar to yours have recently sold for \$90 to \$240.

TIP: To get rid of mildew on wooden furniture, wipe the wood with a cloth dipped in a mixture of 1 cup of water, 1 tablespoon of bleach and 1 tablespoon of liquid dishwashing detergent. Then wipe the wood dry.





Do an online search for "museums with virtual tours," and you'll find several dozen choices. Zoos, national parks and aquariums have done the same thing.

The opportunities for staycation are many. Want to learn to paint or draw? Order supplies and spend some days hooked up to online art tutorials. Want to write a book? You can get a lot done in an unplugged week. Want to bake a pie? Spend an afternoon first at a pick-your-own fruit farm.

A big rule of staycation: Housework and cleaning are not allowed.

Fresh Peach Cobbler



For the filling:
8 large fresh peaches, peeled, pitted and sliced
1/3 cup organic brown sugar
1/3 cup organic sugar
1 tsp lemon juice
2 tsp corn starch
1/2 tsp cinnamon

For the topping:
1 1/2 cups all purpose flour
1/3 cup organic brown sugar
1/3 cup organic sugar

Instructions

1/4 tsp nutmeg

Preheat oven to 425°

4 tsp organic sugar

Peel, remove pits and slice peaches. Add to large mixing bowl.

Sprinkle brown sugar, sugar, cinnamon, corn starch, lemon juice and nutmeg over peaches. Stir until peaches are coated.

Pour into an ungreased 9 x 13 baking dish. Bake for 10 minutes, then remove from oven. In a medium mixing bowl, whisk flour, sugar, brown sugar, baking powder and salt together. Using a pastry blender, mix butter into flour mixture and blend until mixture becomes crumbly.

Pour in boiling water and stir until combined. Spoon mixture over peaches and spread gently making sure to cover the peaches.

In a small bowl, mix organic sugar and cinnamon together and sprinkle on top of the cobbler.


