

#### Highlights of the latest exercise guidelines

Since 2008, the Physical Activity Guidelines have been a vital resource for health professionals and policy makers, serving as a foundation for physical activity and education programs. These guidelines, established and periodically adjusted by the Office of Disease Prevention and Health Promotion, include recommendations for individuals ages three and over. A full breakdown of the latest guidelines can be found at Health. gov, but the following are some highlights pertaining to various groups.

• Preschool-aged children: The ODPHP notes that children between the ages of three and five should be physically active throughout the day to enhance their growth and development. Caregivers are urged to encourage active play that includes activities of various types.

• Children and adolescents: Children between the ages of six and 17 should engage in 60 minutes or more per day of moderate-to-vigorous aer-

obic physical activity. Kids in this age group also should engage in vigorous-intensity physical activity at least three days per week. Regimens also should include muscle-strengthening activities and bone-strengthening activities at least three days per week.

• Adults: The ODPHP urges adults to sit less and move more. The most substantial health benefits can be gained by engaging in at least 150 minutes to 300 minutes a week of moderate-intensity or between 75 minutes and 150 minutes of vigorous-intensity aerobic activity each week. Any equivalent combination of the two can suffice as well. Musclestrengthening activities also should

#### The Most Important Thing You Need to Know When Selling a Deceased Parent's Home

A parent passing away is one of the most difficult times in a child's life. The emotional toll it can take on you can be a lot longer than you expected. In addition to the emotional challenges, vou may also need to deal with managing their belongings and assets, including their home. If you are handling the disposition of your parent's home, it is not the same as a typical sale. The most important thing you need to know to help with the process of selling is the status of the home.

Know the status of the home. - If a parent passes away and leaves you their home, you may need to manage the transfer before selling it. However, you need to know the details about the transfer.

In Ohio a parent can leave their home to a child by a transfer on death designation. If a transfer on death deed exists, then the title automatically passes when the decedent has passed. Usually, all the beneficiary needs to do is file an affidavit and the death certificate in order to sell the home.

A living trust is an easier way to transfer assets and property because it avoids the probate process. It is governed by the terms of the trust document versus probate court.

If they do not, then the property could be part of their estate and is subject to the jurisdiction of probate court. Sometimes the transfer can happen quickly if the paperwork is in order, and you can sell the house as soon as it is yours. Otherwise, you may need to wait for probate.

There can be multiple steps that need to be taken prior to being able to sell the house. It depends upon what was written in the will and the probate process. This could delay the



sale of the home, so it is imperative to know the status prior to selling

If your parents are living, now maybe a good time to check with them to make sure that their will or trust has your inheritance instructions spelled out clearly so the probate process can be made as easy as possible or even

avoided

Probate can be one of the biggest hold ups with selling a loved one's home and can prevent you from putting closure on the process both emotionally and financially. If your parents are making end of life plans, now may be the best time to meet


