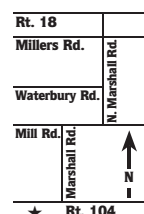

Signs of a HEART ATTACK

Some heart attacks are sudden and intense, but most heart attacks start slowly, with mild pain. Often people affected aren't sure what's wrong and wait too long before getting help. Symptoms include:

CHEST DISCOMFORT. Most heart attacks involve discomfort in the center of the chest that lasts more than a few minutes, or that goes away and comes back. It can feel like uncomfortable pressure, squeezing, fullness or pain.

Stone Soup is a program proposed by Community Action's executive director Renee Hungerford, who got the idea when her husband Mark came home from helping at a food pantry with a box of food no one wanted. The box contained tamarinds and Mark said no one took them because they didn't know what to do with them. Renee did some research and came up with several delicious recipes using the tropical fruit.

Last year, Renee began to wonder how many other people don't take advantage of free food because they don't know how to prepare it or have the necessary utensils. She contacted Cornell Cooperative Extension and with them applied for and received a \$250,000 Highmark Blue Cross/Blue shield grant.

The grant-funded classes were called Stone Soup, and 26 people enrolled. It was taught by Cooperative Extension's nutritionist Marie Gabalski, who taught them how to cook and provided them with utensils they didn't have. In the end 21 people graduated from the class.

That spawned an idea to sponsor a cooking contest at the fair. It will take place July 29 at 12:30 p.m. on the Main Stage. Registration will be limited to 10 entrants, who must register by Thursday (July 20) and pay a fee of \$10 at the fair office. Entrants can register by calling 798-4265, Ext. 139.

Contestants will have a hot plate and skillet to work with and have two hours to show their creative cooking talents. The winner will receive two fair passes and prize money.

Joining Renee in judging will be Lionel Heydel, a former French Culinary School chef.

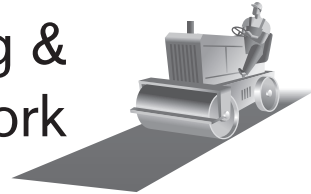

My friend Randy LeBaron wrote his "Refill with Randy" article last week about animals. If you know me, you know I am a HUGE animal lover and I often seek out animal parks or zoos when I travel. So, he inspired me to tell you about some of my favorites.

First - let's talk about a couple local ones that you could easily visit.

When I visited Chittenango, NY in 2017 for the Oz-Stravaganza, I also spent some time at the Wild Animal Park located just outside the Village of Chittenango. It was GREAT!!! Lots of animals - many of which you can get up close and personal with. It is a very well kept park and they also have a bounce house area for kids, snack huts, and a picnic area over-looking a beautiful lake. It is one of the better animal parks I've ever been to and it's only about a 2.5 hour drive from Albion.

Another local place I really enjoyed was Hidden Valley Animal Adventure in Varysburg, NY. You take a trolley ride through the park and all the super

cool animals come right up to the trolley when it stops to beg for treats. It was so much fun feeding them from cups. There is also a small animal area where you can pet and feed some other animals. I love being able to get up close and personal with animals I don't normally get to see.

Now, for some options a little further away.

During my cross country motor home trip with my brother and sister-in-law in 2016, a billboard caught our eye in Rapid City. It was for a place called Bear Country USA. We had to stop and check it out. It was a park that you drive your own vehicle through and we saw loads of bear and wolves, and elk and so much more all just wandering around free! There was also a part of the park that you could walk around and see smaller animals - we really enjoyed watching a bunch of bear cubs playing and climbing trees - great fun! If you're ever in the Rapid City area check it out!

In 2019, I was in Colorado and decided to check out the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo. Definitely a good decision! It was a wonderful zoo on the side of a mountain, so it was on tiers. It had lots of great animals - some I enjoyed making friends with. It also had a special Shrine of the Sun up on top of

the mountain above the zoo that is a tribute to Will Rogers. I highly recommend it!



Another gentle giant I ADORE is the camel - this one stole my heart at the Hidden Valley Animal Adventure in Varysburg, NY.

A few years ago, I was a LulaRoe retailer and in 2018, I had the chance to go to the East Coast Warehouse in Columbia, SC to pick my own order - it was quite a thrill for me. I had some time to kill the first day I was there, so I checked out the Riverbanks Zoo & Botanical Gardens - WOW! It is a lovely zoo - not huge, but very nice and great exhibits. It was the first time I saw a kangaroo up close and pink flamingos other than in photos!

I think my all-time favorite zoo is the NC Zoo in Asheboro, NC. All the years I lived in NC, we only visited there once, but it was a wonderful experience. It is HUGE - 2,500 acres with 500 developed acres and it is world's largest natural habitat zoo. They have over 1,800 animals most on their natural habitats - not just manufactured to replicate natural habitats. They also have tons of activities and special events. Do yourself a favor and take the trolley around - it is a LOT of walking. When in the Asheboro, NC area, do NOT miss the chance to visit the NC Zoo!!! I never wrote a blog post about it, but I included the website link for you.

An honorable mention is the Zoo America in Hershey Park - Hershey, PA. It is a smallish zoo with only animals native to North America - so no giraffes, elephants, monkeys, etc., but it was VERY nice and well worth the time to go through it, if you're in Hershey.

Always take the time to check out zoos and animal parks when you travel - it's a great way to spend a few hours!

- 2 **Make your description CLEAR AND FACTUAL.** State the year, make, model, color & size and tell what condition the item is in. Also, state the special features.
- 3 **STATE THE PRICE.** Successful classified advertisers have learned that the price in an ad helps increase the chances for results.
- 4 **IF THERE IS A GENUINE SENSE OF URGENCY,** say so. The words "We're moving," or "Must sell fast," suggest that readers respond immediately.
- 5 **INCLUDE YOUR PHONE NUMBER.** Classifieds get results fast and often generate immediate sales. If you cannot be available to answer the phone at all times, be sure to specify special calling times such as "after 9pm" or "before 11am."

If you're faced with a medical emergency, what will you do?

If you have an emergency, call 911. This is always advisable. These moments can be some of the scariest and most intimidating for any of us. It's not just whether or not you know safety measures like CPR or the Heimlich maneuver, but do you know when to call your primary care provider and/or where is the closest emergency department?

Now is the time to make your plan, before you're faced with an emergency.

- **Locate your nearest emergency department by time and distance. It's important to know that many trips to the emergency department come from the patient and not an ambulance.**

- **When considering the nearest emergency department, also consider average wait times from arrival to the moment you see a provider.**

- **What happens next?**

- **What's the difference between an emergency room and urgent care/walk-in clinic?**

Choosing an Emergency Department

Once you've identified the emergency departments near you, reach out to them to inquire about average wait times. You can assume that the wait times at rural hospitals are likely less than those in urban areas, in part because of volume. Again, this is the time between when a patient arrives and is seen by a provider. That said, it can always change. Hospitals learn to expect the unexpected and realize things can change at any moment.

What happens next?

Hopefully, you've had very few experiences in emergency departments. If that's the case, you may be asking yourself what occurs once you've seen the provider. The three things that most often occur:

1. You are treated and discharged.
2. You need to be admitted.
3. You're transferred to another hospital for specialized care.

An emergency department's ability to assess each situation is one of its most valuable traits. It helps to deliver immediate attention to both patients being seen and those waiting for care (also known as triage). As you're

conducting your own research on hospitals, you may look at discharge/admittance/transfer rates. At Medina, we render care and discharge 87% of patients seen, 6% of patients are admitted, and 7% are transferred to specialty hospitals.

When you come through the doors of any emergency department they are going to assess your needs and determine the appropriate treatments. As an example, even though our hospital does not have a maternity department, we have delivered babies in case of emergencies. This occurred as recently as this past winter. The point is, we all understand on some occasions you may just go to the nearest hospital for care, and that's OK.

The key for any emergency department is the ability to triage and help.

Urgent Care vs. Emergency Department

Depending on the time of day, your primary care provider may be able to help guide your decision-making process of what you should do next. In addition to making the decision you're personally most comfortable with, if you feel you need immediate care, then you should go to the emergency department and/or call 911. For minor injuries that don't need immediate attention, but need to be addressed over the next 24 hours, an urgent care or walk-in clinic will suffice. This decision is why it's so important to have a plan before you're faced with the scenario.

As the warmer weather nears it's important to take necessary steps to avoid common reasons you may need medical care. These include, but are not limited to, various burns (related to outdoor activities and the sun), poison oak/ivy, summer rashes, and more. Remember, if you believe a situation is an emergency, don't hesitate to take the appropriate next steps.
