





MOUNT MORRIS RESIDENTS: Around the early 1980s New York State came up with a plan to control local county courts by paying judges' salaries. County Court and State Supreme Courts basically became the same, with the same judges, different in name only. Judges could be shifted around to get the "right" political decisions. In the early 20th century, Mount Morris had its own municipal natural gas system and municipal electric power company (the river alternator). Profits were used to provide services and keep taxes low (like Fairport Electric). The town prospered. Then the town board voted to divest the town of those assets. In the 19th Century, the Mills Family built then donated the water system from Silver Lake to Mount Morris. Recently "somehow" a semi-autonomous "County Water Authority" got control of the system and expanded it throughout the county. Did water really cost less in Leicester than Mount Morris? The Town Council is presently comprised of only two members. Until recently, many towns in our area had elected chiefs of police. They are now appointed. The Town Council is presently reviewing a plan to make the Town Clerk position an appointed position not subject to citizen vote. These have been obviously bad local decisions historically. Another example being removing Murray Hill from the village and other taxable areas from the town. A right ignored is always a freedom lost. Please make your views known to the Town Council. Thank you.
