CHEESY SAUSAGE POTATO

Yield 4 servings **INGREDIENTS**

- 1 package 12 ounces smoked sausage, sliced
- 3/4 pound baby red potatoes halved
- 3/4 pound green beans trimmed
- 2 bell peppers sliced
- 1 onion chopped
- 3/4 tablespoon dried oregano
- 3/4 tablespoon dried parsley flakes
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon paprika •
- tablespoons unsalted butter separated
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 cups shredded Cache Valley Sharp Cheddar cheese

Optional: freshly chopped parsley

- INSTRUCTIONS
- 1. Preheat the grill to high heat or the oven to 400 degrees F.
- 2. Prep the sausage and veggies. Slice the sausage, halve the red potatoes, trim the green beans, slice the bell peppers, and chop the onion.
- 3. Toss the sausage and veggies with the dried oregano, dried parsley, garlic powder, and paprika. Season to taste with salt and pepper.
- Separate the mixture evenly among 4 large sheets 4. of foil.
- 5. Add 1 tablespoon of butter in each foil packet on top of the veggies.
- Completely seal the packet and cook on the grill for 6. 25-30 minútes or...
- NOTE: OR Place In the oven on cookie sheet for 7. 35-40 minutes or until veggies are crisp tender.
- Remove from the heat and carefully open. 8.
- Sprinkle the cheddar cheese evenly among the foil 9 packets.
- 10. Top with freshly chopped parsley if desired.







SHRIMP

ield 4 s INGREDIENTS

- 3 ears of corn halved
- 1 pound baby red potatoes
- 1 1/2 pound jumbo shrimp peeled and deveined
- 1 (14 ounce package) smoked sausage, sliced
- 1/4 cup butter melted
- 1 Tablespoon olive oil
- 2 Tablespoons Old Bay Seasoning
- salt and pepper
- parsley chopped for garnish

INSTRUCTIONS

- Bring a large pot of water to a boil. Add in the corn and baby red potatoes and boil for 10 minutes. Drain and add to a large bowl.
- Add in the shrimp, sausage, melted butter, oil and old bay seasoning. Toss until everything is coated and add salt and pepper to taste.
- 3. To assemble tear four pieces of foil and lay flat. Evenly distribute into the center of the foil and fold each side up into packets.
- 4. Preheat grill to 400 degrees. Add the packets to the grill and cook for 10-12 minutes flipping halfway through until shrimp is cooked throughout.
- NOTE: OR cook in the oven at 400 degrees for 5. 10-12 minutes or until the shrimp is cooked throughout.

HOBO Yield 4 serving

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound lean ground beef
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- salt and pepper
- 1 pound baby potatoes cut in half
- 3 large carrots sliced into one inch cubes
- 1/2 onion sliced
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1 Tablespoon Italian seasoning
- 1 cup colby jack cheese shredded **INSTRUCTIONS**

- Cut four sheets of heavy duty aluminum foil. 1. Combine ground beef, garlic powder, onion powder, and salt and pepper. Shape into four patties and place in the center of the aluminum foil.
- In a medium sized bowl toss potatoes, carrots, 2. onion olive oil and Italian seasoning. Divide evenly between the four packets. Fold the foil over and seal each packet.
- 3. Place the packets on the grill or over the coals of a fire. Cook for about 45-60 minutes or until the potatoes are tender. Carefully open the foil packets and top with cheese.

NOTE: OR To Cook Hobo Dinner in the Oven: Preheat the oven to 375 degrees Fahrenheit. Place foil packs on a cookie sheet and cook for 40 to 45 minutes.

BUTTER GARLIC HERB STEAK

INGREDIENTS

- 1 pound small red potatoes cut into fourths
- 2 medium carrots sliced
- 1 red bell pepper cubed
- 1 green bell pepper cubed
- 1/2 red onion cut into cubes •
- salt and pepper •
- 1 Tablespoon olive oil •
- 1 1/2 pound top sirloin steak cut into one inch cubes **Garlic Herb Butter:**
- 1/2 cup butter room temperature •
- 1/4 cup freshly chopped parsley
- 4 garlic cloves minced
- 1 teaspoon fresh rosemary chopped
- 1 teaspoon fresh thyme chopped
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper •

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. In a medium sized bowl add the red potatoes, carrots, bell peppers, and red onion. Add salt and pepper and toss with olive oil.
- 2. Place four 18x12-inch pieces of heavy aluminum foil on the counter. Evenly place the vegetable mixture on 7. each piece of foil. Top vegetables with steak.
- 3. To make the garlic herb butter: In a small bowl add the butter, parsley, garlic, rosemary, thyme, salt, and pepper. Divide evenly and place on top of the steak. Double fold the top and ends of each piece of foil, leaving space for steam to gather.

To Grill:

Place packets on the grill and cover. Grill 15 minutes or until steak is cooked through and veggies are tender. Carefully open packets and serve.

To Bake:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Bake for 25-30 minutes. Unwrap and broil right at the end to give the steak a slight char.

HONEY GARLIC CHICKE

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup minute rice
- 1 and 1/2 cups water
- 4 (4 ounce chicken breast, 1 piece per packet)
- Salt and pepper, to taste •
- 2 tablespoons white flour •
- 3/4 cup baby carrots, halved
- 1 large red pepper, cut into small strips ٠ 1 stalk broccoli, cut into small florets
- Sauce
- 1/4 cup reduced sodium soy sauce •
- 1/4 cup honey
- 1 teaspoon minced garlic •
- 3 tablespoons fresh lime juice ٠
- 1 teaspoons sriracha
- 1/4 teaspoon ground ginger •
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch (+1 tablespoon water)

Optional garnish: finely chopped cilantro INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Set out 4 large sheets of foil. Fold up sides to create sides. In a bowl mix the minute rice and water. Stir and let sit for 5 minutes.
- 2. Preheat the grill to high or the oven to 425 degrees F. You'll want 16 ounces TOTAL for this recipe which is about 2 large breasts. Try to get 2 large breasts that are each 8 ounces and then slice the 2 breasts horizontally into two even pieces that are each 4 ounces. Pound the chicken and ensure that the 4 pieces of chicken you have are each an even 4 ounces. 3.
 - Prep the veggies: Thinly slice the red bell pepper, halve or quarter baby carrots (small and thin pieces), cut the broccoli into small florets. Season the chicken with salt and pepper on both sides and then dredge in flour (helps keep it from drying out). Add a pinch more of salt and pepper on top.
- 5. Divide the rice evenly between the packets. Place the chicken breasts on top of the rice. Add the
- veggies equally to both sides. In a small bowl, whisk together all of the sauce 6. ingredients except for the cornstarch and water. In another bowl, whisk together the cornstarch and water until smooth. Add to the sauce and whisk until smooth. Drizzle evenly over the chicken pieces in the foil packets. Fold up and seal completely. Grill on high heat for 15-25 minutes (large variance
- based on different grills/heat; my grill had these finished at 20 minutes) or in the oven for 30-45 **minutes** (again; large variance based on your oven temperature and how ingredients are prepared) or until the chicken is completely cooked through (registers 165 degrees F).
- 8. Remove the foil packets from grill or oven and open carefully allowing for the steam to escape. Season additionally with salt and pepper if desired and enjoy immediately. If desired garnish with cilantro.
