My cat, Danny, was adopted from the shelter and is a completely inside cat. Years ago, my mother had a screened-in porch built for me, and Danny loves to go out on it.

I am an early riser and Danny loves to greet the morning by going into the porch while I'm getting ready. He does come in a couple of times to check on my progress; he is making sure his breakfast will not be late.

On Monday, July 24th, we proceeded as we usually do. However, about an hour after I first opened the door, I realized Danny had not come inside the house. I went to the door and my heart actually stopped when I saw that, somehow, a small part of the screen had come loose and Danny was not on the porch. I quickly walked around the yard, looking for him. There was no sign. I called April, the shelter manager, in a panic and she came to look for him.

Eventually, I had to leave to attend a presentation at the police department. I posted a picture of Danny on my Facebook page and offered a \$1,000 reward. I wanted to make sure people knew about him!

What an awful day. I was terrified for Danny; I know all too well the dangers that outside cats face.

Shortly after my post, I received a call from a young woman who said she was on her way to my house to look She was a voice from the past.

Her name is Crystal Matherly. It is amazing how our paths crossed again. I first met her in 2008 when she was a student at Galileo Magnet School. She was the founder and president of the Rotary Interact Club and they did

She went on to graduate from Virginia Tech with a degree in biological sciences. While in college, she adopted a toy poodle mix from the Montgomery County animal shelter. Lulu was Crystal's faithful companion for over 11 years; Lulu died a short while ago.

Crystal walked around the neighborhood and called with news that gave me hope - she had seen Danny in the wooded area behind my house and go underneath the mobile home.

Thankfully, April crawled halfway under the home and was able to eventually grab Danny.

It is because of Crystal's information that Danny was able to be captured. She declined the reward, telling she wanted to do it in memory of her beloved Lulu.

I was impressed with Crystal when she was a teenager and I will be forever grateful that her love for animals remained with her as she grew up.

tend to bring higher prices at auction. This one sold for \$1,625 at Cowan's Auctions for more than twice the estimated value! The buyer might have had an interest in optometry or simply liked the look of the piece.

Income fell in the '90s, and the company was sold in 1995. It was sold again in 2009, and the name became Borden Dairy. Elsie the Cow first appeared in ads in 1936. Her image was also used on milk bottle caps. The first live cow dubbed "Elsie" appeared in Borden's exhibit at the 1939 World's Fair. She outdrew every other exhibit at the Fair. Elsie's image has appeared on bottles, glasses, cups, clocks, lamps, figurines, playing cards and many other items. Glasses and cups sell for about \$7 to

- * "Kitchen stores sell grill brushes, but they can be expensive. I use a good-quality paintbrush from the hardware store for grilling only, and replace it a couple of times throughout grilling season. I find it to be a better brush, and less expensive to boot!" -- B.F. in Illinois
- * Your grilled meats will be more moist and taste better if you let them rest for a few minutes after you take them off the grill. It allows the meat to redistribute the natural juices. If you are worried about temperature, just cover the meat with foil.
- * "It's best to clean a grill just after cooking, but if you weren't able to, that's OK. When faced with a messy grill surface, just preheat, then clean. The heat will burn off drippings and make it easier to scrub." -- R.T. in Florida
- * You should never use a cooking spray on your grill. Instead, soak a paper towel in oil and use your tongs to oil the grill surface.


