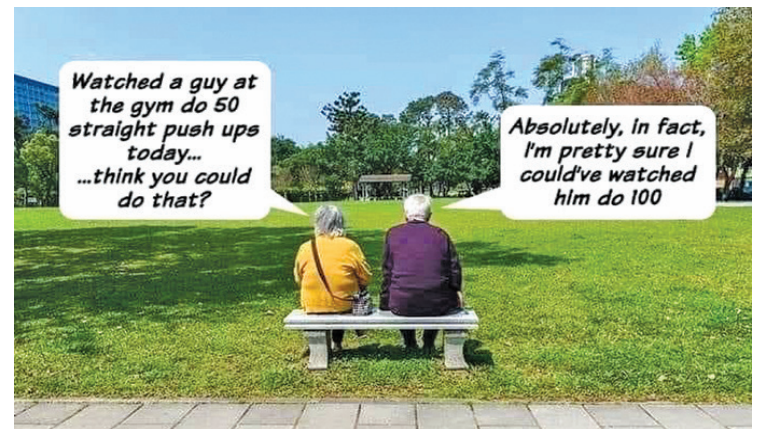

Look at this device with toothed wheels and a hand crank that sold for \$266 at Conestoga Auction Company in Pennsylvania. Is it a kitchen gadget — perhaps a fruit or vegetable peeler? Some kind of grinder or chopper? In fact, it's a mechanical rope twister.

In the early 1900s, farmers made their own rope. Most people buy it ready-made today. The buyer probably intended to keep this rope twister as an antique instead of using it as a tool. But someone crafty, curious or very dedicated to "do-it-yourself" can buy modern, usable rope twisters or kits online.

Q: I bought a vase shaped like a goose at a garage sale 20 years ago for 25 cents. It's about 12 inches tall and the back is open like a vase. It's marked "HB Quimper." It looks hand painted. What can you tell me about it and what, if anything, is it worth?

A: It's worth more than 25 cents. Pottery was made by three different factories in Quimper, France, beginning in the late 17th century. Pierre Bousquet founded the first factory in 1708. It became the HB Factory (Hubaudiere-Bousquet) in 1782, after Antoine de la Hubaudiere became the factory manager. HB merged with two other factories in 1968. After more changes in ownership, the factory became Henriot-Quimper in 2011. Variations of the HB Quimper mark were used from 1895 to 1984. Your goose vase with an open back is a planter. One sold recently for \$40, although some sellers are asking higher prices.

TIP: Don't use rubber gloves when washing figurines with protruding arms and legs. The gloves may snag and cause damage.

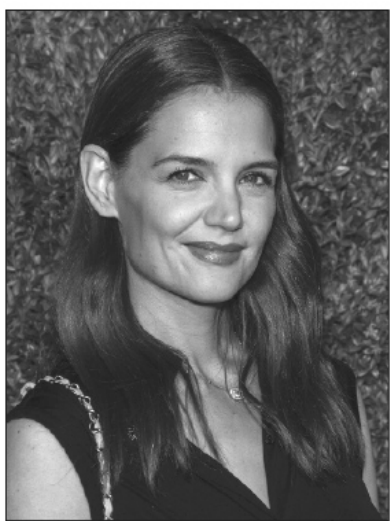
Q. I recently started rewatching the Netflix show "Suits," the one Meghan Markle acted in before she married Prince Harry. Are they going to have new episodes or just reruns? — K.L.

A. "Suits" is the latest series to amass a huge audience after Netflix began making the original episodes available to its subscribers. It ran for nine seasons on the USA Network, ending in 2019, and was then made available to subscribers of Peacock and Amazon Prime Video. Meanwhile, in 1998, Holmes debuted as Joey on another series, "Dawson's Creek," and went on to become a big star in Hollywood.

Reynolds had just come out of high school in real life and said it was "awful!" The part ended up being perfectly cast with actor Nicholas Brendon.

Q. How is Madonna doing after she nearly died a few months ago? Was she in a coma? — H.H.

A. Madonna was rushed to the hospital after being found unresponsive at her home on June 24. Fortunately, the singer-actress lived to see another day, but had to postpone her tour, which was set to launch a few weeks later. She spent several days in intensive care, where she was intubated for a serious bacterial infection, but she appears to have made a full recovery. She plans to reschedule her U.S. tour dates to follow the European leg of her tour, which begins in October.

Homemade Peach Ice Cream

No Ice Cream Machine is needed for this simple recipe. Just puree the peaches in a food processor and then combine with the other ingredients. Then freeze to turn this amazing flavor peach mixture into ice cream.



INGREDIENTS

- 5 ripe Peaches can use frozen
- 2 cups whipping cream heavy cream (chilled)
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- pinch salt
- 1 can sweetened condensed milk

INSTRUCTIONS

Wash peaches, quarter them and remove pits, and puree in a food processor until fairly smooth. Set aside. If using frozen, allow them to thaw in a bowl and then puree in a food processor.

Whip chilled whipping cream, vanilla and salt until stiff peaks form. Add sweetened condensed milk and mix well to combine. Add peach puree and mix well to combine. Pour into a chilled freezer safe container (see Recipe Notes for suggestions) and freeze 3-6 hours - until desired level of firmness is reached.

Homemade Peach Ice Cream Tips:

Freeze the bowl and beaters – I place my mixing bowl and beaters in the freezer for 10-15 minutes before whipping the cream to help whip it quicker.
Quality ingredients – This recipe requires minimum ingredients, it is best to use high quality ingredients. Vanilla is a key ingredient. Make sure you use quality vanilla extract.
Do not overmix- Be careful to not overmix the heavy cream. You want to only combine until you start to see peaks form.
Heavy cream is best – While it can be tempting to swap this for milk, it will not taste the same. Heavy whipping cream makes the ice cream base rich and creamy. Serve between two cookies – Just scoop some of the ice cream between two cookies or graham crackers. Place back in the freezer and store. It is another tasty way to enjoy this ice cream.

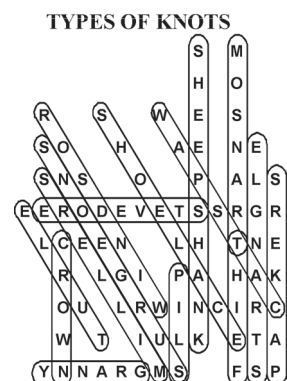

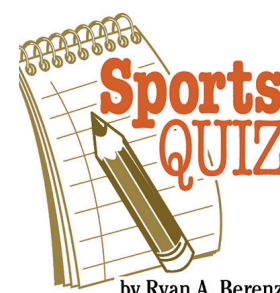
