

Orleans County Sheriff's Office Launches Enforcement

Participation During 2nd Statewide Speed Awareness Week Campaign

During the summer months unsafe speed crashes increase. In order to make our highways safer during the summer, Orleans County Sheriff Christopher Bourke announced the Sheriff's Office will increase enforcement during Speed Awareness Week (August 14 - 20, 2023). Speed Awareness Week is a statewide enforcement campaign organized by the NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Committee (GTSC) to intensify enforcement effort against speeding drivers and emphasize the severity of the problem, both locally and across the nation.

In 2021, over one-third (35%) of all traffic fatalities in New York were caused by speeding. 389 people lost their lives and 2,256 people suffered serious injuries in these preventable collisions. Speeding endangers not only the life of the speeder, but all people on the road around them. Data also revealed drivers that speed also tend to engage in other risky behaviors, such as not wearing a seat belt and alcohol impaired driving.

During this enforcement, Sheriff's Deputies will be targeting and ticketing speeding drivers with a goal to save lives. When it comes to speeding: "Obey the Sign or Pay the Fine."

Warren R. Blount, MD 78 passed away Saturday July 29, 2023, in Tallahassee, Florida. After a long battle with the effect of Agent Orange contracted during his three tours of duty in The Republic of Vietnam 1966-1969. Warren served with the Third Force Reconnaissance Battalion of the United States Marine Corp. Taking part in some of the fiercest fighting in Vietnam including the Battle of KheSanh and the Tet Offensive. Warren graduated from Medina High School in 1963. Son of the late Vera & Daniel Blount Jr., Brother of Richard (deceased), his wife Lucille Applan Blount. Survived by brother Kenneth Blount and his wife Janet Loiacono Blount, Middleport; Robert Blount & his wife MaryLou Fox Blount, Medina and his sister Dawn Blount Evans (G. Lonnie Evans deceased), Wilson, NY. He is survived by many nieces, nephews, and cousins. Most of Warren's family still live in Western New York. Warren is also survived by the family of his Former deceased wife Myrtle Carolyn Thompson originally of Middleport. Son Christopher and his wife Michele of Cummings, Georgia and Daughter Connie R Mares & her husband Douglas of Tallahassee, Fla. Warren is also survived by his wife Elizabeth D Blount DVM, a Tallahassee, Fla. Veterinarian, and their children- son Trevin W Blount residing in Taiwan with his wife Rosie and daughter Alexandra C Blount, a student at the University of North Florida. He is also survived by 8 grandchildren and 7 great-grandchildren. While in the service of his country, Warren was awarded many medals and commendations for his actions and bravery including the Purple Heart, Naval Commendation Medal, Bronze Star Medal, and Vietnam Cross. Warren actively and successfully went into the medical profession after his military service. He graduated from the University of Alabama in Birmingham becoming a Surgeons Assistant in Cardiac Vascular Surgery, training with and assisting several world class Cardiac Surgeons. In the following years, Warren moved to Michigan and spent 14 years at Butterworth Hospital assisting in over 6,000 open heart surgeries and transplants. In 1995, Warren attended Michigan University College of Human Medicine and completed his Emergency Medicine residency. Moving to Tallahassee, Fla, Warren became an Emergency Physician at the Former Capital Regional Medical Center; where he worked for 17 years. In his later years as an emergency room Physician Warren worked from a scooter due to the loss of one of his legs, a direct result of his military service. His dedication and compassion never stopped no matter the obstacle. Warren had many interests. He had a passion for history as proven by, over 30 years of relentless research on the Blount family Genealogy. He also enjoyed blacksmithing and forging, reloading shells, target practice, photography, gardening, cooking, and working puzzles which he then treated and framed. He always enjoyed working with his hands. His favorite saying was "I'm bumping along". That was always his response when asked how he was. A service of Thanksgiving is being held on August 12th in Tallahassee, Fla. For family, friends, & colleagues. Warren will be interred at Arlington National Cemetery, Washington DC (Virginia) with full military honors at a time and date as yet undetermined. 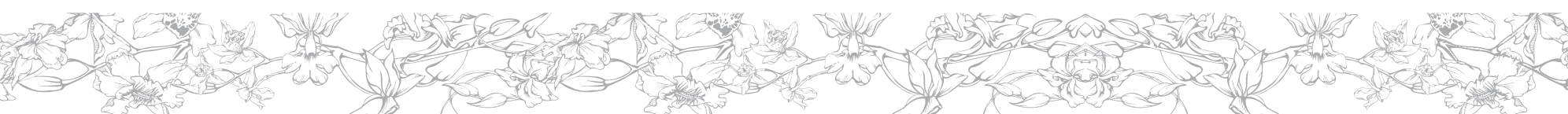



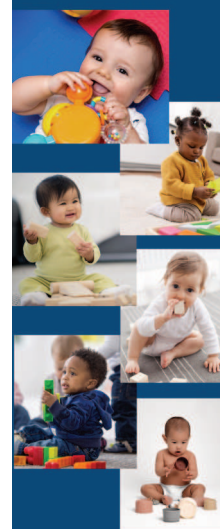

Orleans/Niagara BOCES Skilled Trades Programs Connect Students with Employers

Helping local employers connect with new skilled tradespeople is an important goal for the Orleans/Niagara BOCES Adult Skilled Trades programs.

During the spring semester, the Machining and Welding classes at the Orleans / Niagara BOCES Workforce Development Center in Niagara Falls gave a tour to local employer Jack Watson of HFW Industries and showed off their new skills. In turn, students heard from Watson about opportunities at HFW Industries in Buffalo.

According to the Regional Development Council's 2022 Western New York Progress Report, the advanced manufacturing sector in the region comprised over 1500 firms in 2021, with roughly 62,000 jobs with an average wage of \$70,510 and saw a 43% increase in job postings between 2020 and 2021. The report states that "The sector faces retirement cliffs and hiring gaps ... pointing to a major need for awareness and training in the skilled trades."

The O/N BOCES Adult Skilled Trades programs seek to fill this gap by providing training for area residents toward well-paid positions in regional manufacturing businesses. The Welding program is a 216-hour class that meets four evenings a week for four months with introductory training in MIG, TIG, and STIK Welding. Machining is a 160-hour class that meets three evenings a week with training in mills, lathes, and CNC machine operation.

O/N BOCES Skilled Trades classes for adults include Welding, Machining, and Building Trades in Niagara Falls, Automotive Technology in Sanborn, and Electrical and HVAC in Lockport. Experienced tradespeople act as teachers to train a new generation, providing foundational skills as well as exposure to local businesses.

Fall classes run from September 18, 2023, through December 21. Funding to cover tuition and tools is available through local county WorkSource One offices.

Classic Tiramisu

INGREDIENTS

- 2 cartons (8 ounces each) mascarpone cheese
- 5 large egg yolks
- 1/2 cup plus 2 tablespoons sugar, divided
- 1/3 cup plus 2 tablespoons Marsala wine, Kahlua (coffee liqueur) or rum, divided
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 3/4 cup strong brewed coffee, room temperature
- 2 teaspoons instant espresso powder
- 1 package (7 ounces) crisp ladyfinger cookies
- 1 tablespoon Dutch-processed cocoa



Step 1: Make cream

Stir the mascarpone cheese, then let stand at room temperature for 30 minutes.

In a heat-proof bowl, mix egg yolks, 1/2 cup sugar, 1/3 cup Marsala wine (or liquor) and salt. Place over a double boiler and stir until the mixture has thickened and reaches the ribbon stage (it should flow off a spoon like a ribbon). If using a thermometer, it should read 160°F.

Remove from heat and whisk in the mascarpone until almost smooth. Separately, whip the heavy whipping cream and remaining sugar, and beat until soft peaks form. Fold this into the mascarpone mixture.

Step 2: Dip and layer

Combine coffee, espresso powder and remaining 2 tablespoons Marsala. Quickly dip each ladyfinger into the coffee mixture, then immediately place into the bottom of your pan. You can use a springform pan as directed in the recipe, or a glass baking dish will work just as well.

Top the ladyfinger layer with 1-1/2 cups mascarpone mixture, and even out the top. Repeat 2 more times until all the ladyfingers and cream are used.

Step 3: Refrigerate

Cover and refrigerate for 6 hours or overnight. If using a springform pan, loosen the rim and remove. Finish with a heavy sprinkle of cocoa powder.

FAQs

Can you make tiramisu without alcohol?

You can definitely make tiramisu without alcohol! There are so many wonderful flavors and textures in a tiramisu that it will still be rich and delicious without the alcohol. If you're cooking for anyone who doesn't drink, or you want to make this more kid friendly, simply omit the alcohol.

Can you make tiramisu ahead?

One of the best parts of a tiramisu is that it is indeed better to make ahead. As it sits, the cream and the ladyfingers will settle into their layers, and the texture and flavors will have time to develop. Enjoy it straight from the fridge after it's sat for at least 6 hours, but preferably overnight.

What kinds of ladyfingers should I use?

Ladyfingers are known as Savoiardi in Italy. Most any brand will do as long as they're hard enough to be able to take on the moisture of coffee and cream. If they're very soft ladyfingers, try brushing them with coffee instead of doing a full dip.
