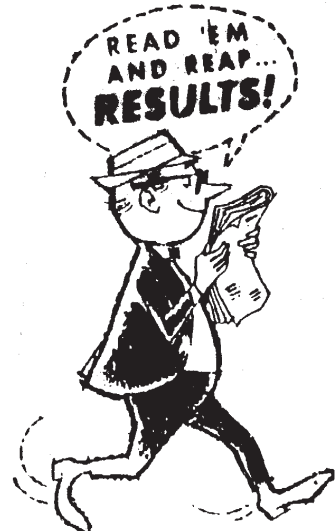

Taxes may be paid on or before October 2, 2023 without penalty. On all taxes received from October 3 through October 31, 2023, there shall be added a 2% penalty. No taxes will be accepted by the District after October 31, 2023. Livingston County will accept payments from November 15 through November 30, 2023 with a 3% penalty. Unpaid school taxes will be relieved with the town and county taxes in January, 2024 with an increased rate of interest.
