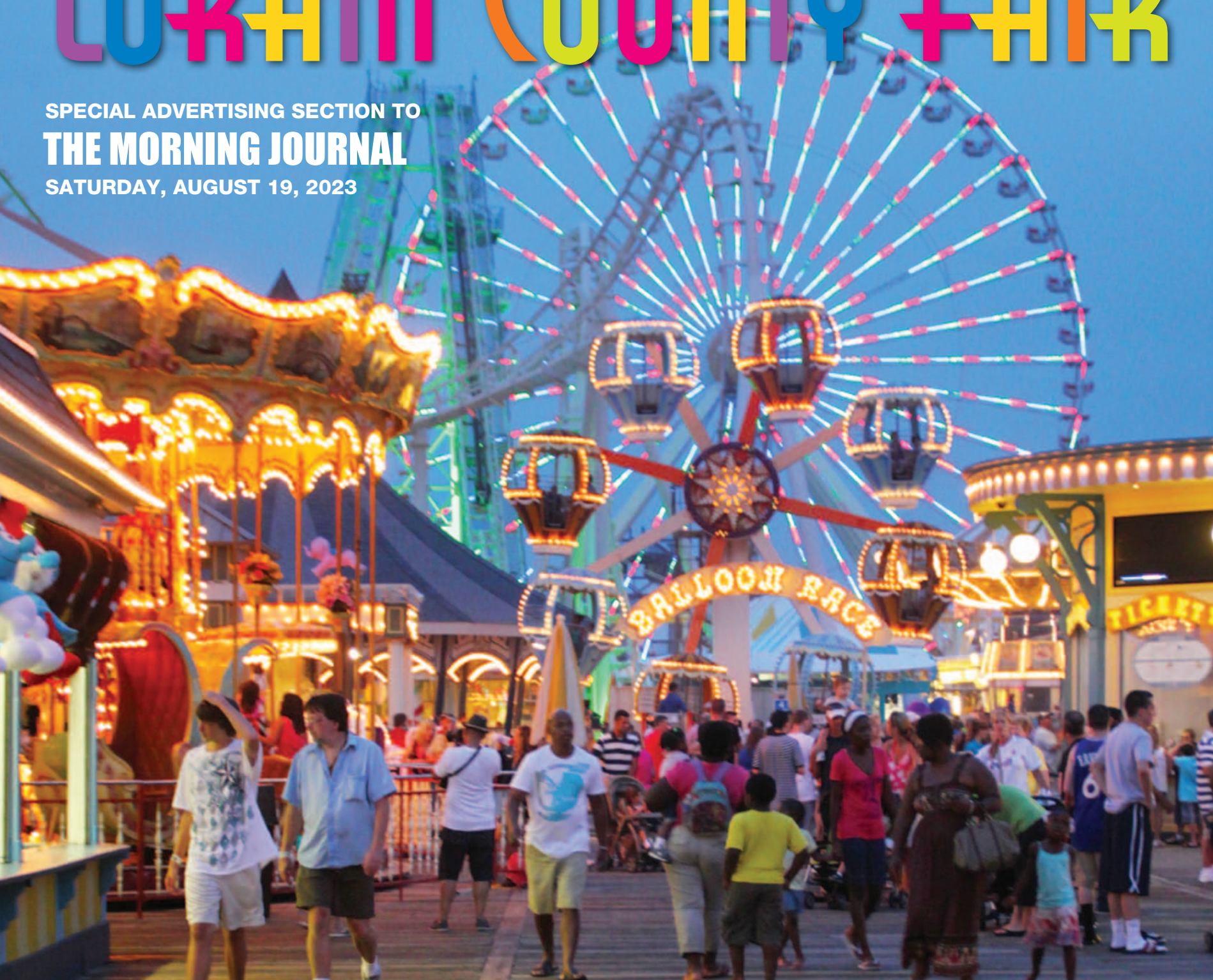

Preparations are underway at the Lorain County Fairgrounds, 23000 Fairgrounds Road in Wellington, for the 177th annual Lorain County Fair which runs from Aug. 20-27.

Kicking off with a free entrance day Aug. 20, the fair will host a variety of activities.

At 3 p.m., that day, the HTCS Harness racing starts.

An official flag raising ceremony and crowning of the Junior Fair King and Queen will begin at 5:30 p.m. at the Pavilion 1 Stage.

Throughout the week, visitors can look forward to a variety of shows and judging for the county's 4-H groups as well as more harness racing, tractor pulls and demolition derby.

At 8 p.m., Aug. 21, special guest The Guess Who will perform at the grandstands.

At 8 p.m., Aug. 22, "Roots and Boots" — Sammy Kershaw, Collin Raye and Aaron Tippin — will take to the stage.

The much anticipated demolition derby will close out the week at 4 p.m., Aug. 27, at the grandstand.

Also, the Lorain County Fair celebrated 24 members who received over \$46,900 in scholarship awards Aug. 1 thanks to the Jr. Fair Scholarship Program.

According to Jacki Baca, Extension educator in 4-H youth development, the recipients come from all over the county.

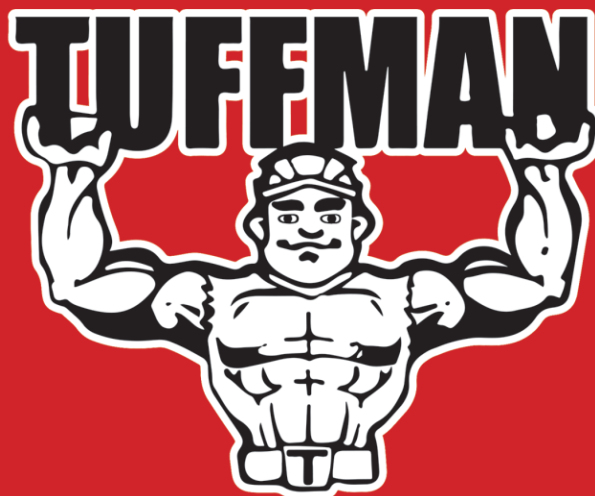

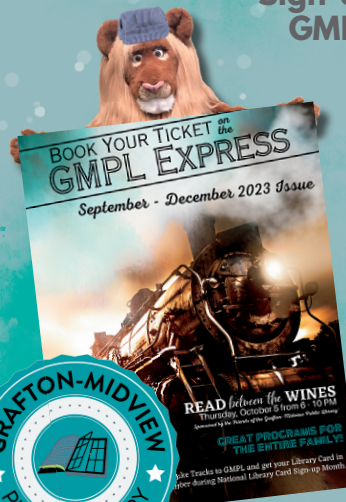
Tickets for the Lorain County Fair can be purchased at the gate all days and are \$8 per person.

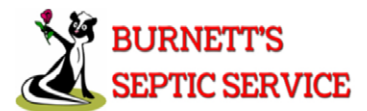
