Cyclone Football Preview

Last week I took my shot at predicting how the 2023 Iowa Hawkeyes would fare this year, and this week I'll take aim at the Iowa State Cyclones. It's hard to believe that this will be Matt Campbell's eighth year as the head coach at ISU, and while some national pundits believe he's on the hot seat after back-toback disappointing seasons, most Cyclone fans remember what the program was before he got there and are still very thankful to have him leading the program. I was way off last year on my Cyclone prediction, as I picked them to go 8-5 with a bowl victory. Instead, ISU lost seven of their last eight games to limp to a 4-8 finish. Most of these losses were excruciatingly close losses where the Cyclones either turned the ball over too much or missed some clutch field goals. With expectations much lower this year, especially after five starters will be gone due to the gambling probe, I'll take my shot at predicting the Cyclones'

ISU's offense was the worst in the Big 12, turning it over too many times, missing field goals, and facing issues running the ball. If the Cyclones just had an average offense (sound familiar, Iowa fans?), they would have probably gone 7-5 in the regular season. This year's offense will look completely different with Hunter Dekkers gone due to the aforementioned gambling probe and a new offensive coordinator in Nate Scheelhaase. As of press day, ISU still hasn't named a starter as it appears to be a battle between redshirt freshman Rocco Becht and true freshman and four-star prospect JJ Kohl. It sounds like both have had great spring and fall camps and it wouldn't surprise me at all to see both of them play key snaps this season. Who the unknown QB hands off to is also an unknown as returning starter Jihrel Brock is also gone due to the gambling probe. Redshirt freshman Cartavious Norton was limited last year due to a hamstring injury but showed brief glimpses of power and explosiveness in 2022. Also returning is Eli Sanders and it sounds like transfer Arlan Harris (Stanford) and true freshmen Abu Sama and Carson Hansen have all had impressive fall camps. Returning starters Jaylin Noel and Dimitri Stanley lead a talented wide receiver room that also includes transfer Jaydin Higgens (Eastern Kentucky), who has had rave reviews during fall camp. It seems like offensive line is always a question mark with ISU, but hopefully new line coach Ryan Clanton can have this group playing, as he likes to say, "violently" this year, and it sounds like he has simplified blocking schemes for this veteran group.

The defense in 2022 was amazing, leading the Big 12 in points per game and ranking in the Top 5 of yards per play nationally. They did lose All-American and NFL First Round Draft pick Will McDonald as well as some other key players, but it sounds like this group will once again be the strength of the team. Domonique Orange returns to anchor the line and veteran Gerry Vaughan will anchor a young but talented linebacker group. The strength of ISU's defense is a backfield that is among the best in the Big 12. Cornerback T.J. Tampa is one of the best in the nation at his position, and safeties Beau Freyler and Malik Verdon will be among the top of the Big 12. Kicking was a HUGE issue for ISU last year, as it probably cost them at least two wins. It sounds like Nebraska transfer Chase Contreraz has had a great fall camp and maybe has a "leg" up on returner Jace Gilbert.

Iowa State's schedule is one of the toughest in the nation, with some experts ranking it in the Top 5. Despite the lack of veterans, there is a quiet confidence coming from Ames about the depth of talent on the two-deep roster this season. I believe the culture of "winning in the margins" will return this season and the leadership will be much stronger than it was in 2022. The entire key lies in the offense improving from last year, which shouldn't be that hard when they ranked dead last in the Big 12 in points per game at 20.2, a whopping 10 points behind the next team. I do think this year's team will be much improved from last year, but the schedule will make it difficult to see too much improvement. Look for ISU to win some of those close games they lost last year and finish the year at 7-6 with a bowl victory to cap off the season. Are you ready for some football, I sure am!

The YIP initiative was created in 2010 to empower and challenge area youth to identify community needs and build a sense of social responsibility while teaching the next generation the importance of community giving.



The recent Board of Supervisors' Meetings was a reminder of the use and expectation of technology. Unable to attend in person, I (and many others) watched via youtube the unfolding of 3 hours of sharing by concerned citizens along with two full rooms of observers who were present. And I wondered... Who would knowingly utilize technology and data from 2009? As a nurse, I've had the privilege to walk along patients and their families during their health crises and journeys thru cancer, heart disease, surgery, and multiple other areas. Would any person or their family ask to use technology or a standard of care from 14 years ago? I think we'd all agree that would be ridiculous and not in the best interest of anyone. And yet it appears that is what our county will do unless our BOS enact a moratorium to give time to revise the 2009 ordinance on wind energy.

The developer's representative stated that they'd been working with our county for years in preparation. Why wasn't the ordinance revised? How many years does it take to revise an ordinance? Was it intentional? As our requests are ignored, it makes you wonder. We are only asking for the time to revise it and ensure that our county has all persons' interest and health protected...the landowners who chose to participate and those who have not. Whose rights are more important?

In a conversation with Kim Wermersen in June, he stated that he 'had trust in the system and the system works'. The definition of trust is 'the firm belief in the reliability, truth, ability or strength of something'. Will the system work? I'd rather have it in black and white and available online.... a revised ordinance incorporating the most recent data. Why don't the developers want the ordinance updated? Are they afraid of the data? Are they afraid that people will learn the truth?

Be informed. Investigate. Would a cardiologist from Iowa with 30+ years in medicine put his reputation on the line if there wasn't data to support the increase of setbacks from wind turbines and to develop specific limits for noise, shadow flicker, and infrasound? His investigation and his research data are available on the DC3Iowa facebook page and the dc3. squarespace.com website.

I pray that our county won't learn the facts the hard way.... And be affected for the next 60 years!

CLARK MUSEUM OF OKOBOJI AREA & IOWA HISTORY



BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUGUST 22 MEETING MINUTES

The August 22nd agenda of the Dickinson County BOARD OF SUPERVISORS included a "Wind Energy Discussion."

Members of the public waited HOURS to be heard. Concerned Citizens asked the Board to TAKE ACTION by enacting a moratorium on all new wind turbine applications while the Planning & Zoning Commission (P&Z) reviews the outdated ordinance. A summary of DC3's legal counsel's comments to the Board of Supervisors are as follows:

- 1. The P&Z does not have the power to enact a moratorium, only the BOS has that power.
- 2. Forming a committee to study the outdated ordinance and make recommendations takes time. Only a moratorium can provide this time.
- 3. To form a committee and make a recommendation after the start of a 591feet tall industrial turbine complex would waste the volunteer committee's time and taxpayer money, and would allow the industrial turbine companies to exploit the antiquated ordinances.
- 4. To claim that a moratorium is against lowa law is unfounded. For example, Hardin County enacted a moratorium. Invenergy filed a lawsuit, only to drop it a year later with no turbines being built.
- 5. A letter from a Chicago attorney in an attempt to intimidate the elected officials should not be given greater weight than the voice of our local
- 6. Other counties have stood up for their citizens and enacted moratoriums over the past few years: Grundy, Clarke, Montgomery, Kossuth, Butler, Iowa, Page, Madison, Union, Sioux, and Worth.
- 7. Dickinson County is unique for its treasured natural resources of the Iowa Great Lakes, prairie potholes, native wetlands, the natural waterfowl migration, and the establishment of nesting Bald Eagles.
- 8. Industrial turbine complexes do not pay property taxes for the first five years of operation. In contrast, Invenergy announced a recent deal with Bank of America where they are selling \$580 million dollars of tax credits.
- 9. A moratorium is not forever. It's a temporary pause.

Iowa Code § 331.301 allows a County Board of Supervisors to: "exercise any power and perform any function it deems appropriate to protect and preserve the rights, privileges, and property of the county or of its residents and to preserve and improve the peace, safety, health, welfare, comfort, and convenience of its residents."

TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS: Your duty is to your citizens, not to out-ofstate corporations trying to profit from our land.

Contact your Supervisors and tell them to TAKE ACTION on a moratorium.

WHY ARE WE CONCERNED?

- •The current wind turbine ordinance hasn't been updated or revised since 2009
- •Wind turbine heights will be 499 and 591 feet, which is nearly the height of the St. Louis Arch
- Wind development applications are expected to be submitted within the next 15 to 60 days and will be evaluated by the 2009 ordinance

WHAT WE'RE ASKING FOR?

- •The Planning and Zoning Board to update the wind energy ordinance with increased setbacks from the current 1200 to 2640 feet to protect residents from thrown ice or broken blades and to include parameters for noise and shadow flicker
- •The Board of Supervisors to pass a moratorium to prohibit receiving, reviewing, considering, or approving any application for a wind energy development to allow adequate time for the Planning & **Zoning Board to revise the 2009 ordinance**

You don't necessarily need to head to the Library of Congress to feel overwhelmed by the written word. The McAllen Public Library in McAllen, Texas, is housed in a converted Walmart location and might be the largest single-story library location in the country. The 123,000 square foot space has a computer lab, a cafe, and a 180-seat auditorium.

2. Vermont is home to a library that stretches across the U.S. border to Canada. The Haskell Free Library and Opera House sits directly on the border between the United States and Canada. You can walk in from Stanstead, Quebec, and walk out into Derby Line, Vermont. You don't need a passport to cross the (literal) line running through the building, but you do have to return to your country of origin or risk fines.

3. Bats dig libraries, too. The Joanina Library at the University of Coimbra in Portugal has a number of bats in residency, but no one is calling for an exterminator. The bats prey on insects that could damage book pages. Staff drape tables with coverings overnight and clean up the guano in the morning.







Farmland Leasing, Crop & Economic Outlooks

by Gary Wright, Farm Management Specialist

Farmland Leasing – Just short of 150 landowners and tenants attended the recent northwest Iowa farmland leasing meetings. If you were able to attend, thank you! A brief summary would include the following Iowa State University survey results: • Land Values – Average land values across the state of Iowa

(\$11,411) exceeded the previous inflation-adjusted record set in 2013. The value increased over 20 percent in most northwest Iowa counties, led by the 22.3 percent increase in Sioux County.

• Lease Rates – The average state of Iowa land rent (\$279/acre) represented a \$23/acre (9 percent) increase. The northwest Iowa Corn Reporting District had the second-highest of the nine districts (\$302/acre; 11.8 percent increase).

It is very important for the reader to look at the complete reports outlining the research and statistics. The meeting agenda and

supporting information can largely be found on the Ag Decision Maker website (https://www. extension.iastate.edu/agdm/). Survey results are not meant to replace an individual's accurate/ reliable farm records. Best farm management decisions can be complemented by making comparisons and using the surveys as a guide.

2023/24 Outlook - Ag markets are best described as a roller-coaster. Daily double-digit market price swings are more the norm than the exception. The August 12, 2023, USDA (WASDE) report, the first one this season to adjust statewide

yields, had mixed results:

• Corn – Old crop (2022), adjustments resulted in an increase to ending stocks, yet USDA kept their season-average price projection at \$6.60/bushel. The new crop (2023) bigger news was the lowering of average yields, partly offset with lower domestic use and exports, resulting in a net lowering of ending stocks. Accordingly, USDA raised the 2023/24 average market price ten cents to a projected \$6.90/bushel. • Soybeans - Similar to corn, average new crop yields were reduced. After all adjustment,

ending stocks are projected very tight for 2022, leaving the average market price the same at \$14.20 per bushel. Overall tight carryover ending stocks, along with the yield reduction, had USDA increasing their 2023 new crop average market price to \$12.70/bushel (up 30 cents from July). Staring ahead 60 days to harvest, the escalation to the Ukraine/Russian conflict serves notice

for continued volatility to market prices, especially corn. Some recent rains, albeit spotty in

northwest Iowa, have contributed to some slight improvement to the drought monitor (https:// droughtmonitor.unl.edu/) where any moisture can be a positive yield (weight) factor. Protein markets can be categorized as mixed, behind generally slower economic activity and inflationary price pressure across the bulk of the world markets. Pork exports are slightly improved, but beef (lower pounds partly offset with higher prices), and poultry volumes are down. Dairy

prices show near-term improved margins, though still well below record milk prices one year ago. Federal Reserve Banks / Chicago and Kansas City - As further complement to the above outlook, two federal reserve banks offered the following as their second quarter information was released (https://farmpolicynews.Illinois.edu):

• Farmland value increases are slowing down. For the first time since 2021/Quarter 1, the increase has been single digits.

• Interest rates have increased to the highest levels since 2007/3rd quarter.

• Overall ag conditions are reported as moderating versus a more robust barometer and record Net Farm Income in Crop Year 2021 and 2022.





This week's article: ABalanced Look at Stock Buybacks - Part 1: How Do Stock Buybacks Work?

Stock buybacks—i.e., a company repurchasing shares of its own stock—have been targets for praise and criticism through the years. So, which are they: good or evil? We agree with The Wall Street Journal columnist Jason Zweig, who once wrote:

"Buybacks are neither bad nor good. They are simply a tool. Just as you can use a hammer either to build a house or knock one down, buybacks are useful in the right corporate hands and dangerous in the wrong ones.'

In other words, a stock buyback can help you, hurt you, or be a neutral event, depending on the particulars. Today, let's embark on a balanced look at stock buybacks.

Big Picture: Diversification Is Still Our Best Friend

Before we dive into any details, let's answer a bigger question: No matter how you may feel about stock buybacks, what should you do about them as an investor? If you're familiar with our general investment strategy, our answer will come as no surprise:

Stock buybacks give investors yet another reason to prefer widely diversifying their investing across myriad asset classes around the world, rather than trying to get ahead by deliberately picking or avoiding particular stocks or industries.

As with any stock bid, even a well-devised buyback can backfire if the future doesn't unfold as hoped for. It can be even worse if the buyback motives were shaky to begin with. Because we can't predict, we advise investing across a globally diversified portfolio of low-cost mutual funds or ETFs, using fund managers who avoid engaging in market-timing or stock-picking. That way, you'll continue to capture long-term market growth—including any returns generated by stock buybacks-without needing to assess each one as it occurs.

In this context, let's look at how buybacks generally work. Even if you're not actively participating in individual stock buybacks, it's worth being informed about them-especially if you're employed at a company that may periodically offer them. How Do Stock Buybacks Work?

In general, you and other traders can buy or sell any publicly traded stock on an open exchange like the NASDAQ or New York Stock Exchange (NYSE). Similarly, a company can participate in these same exchanges, using its retained earnings to buy back or extend a tender offer to repurchase some of its own stock.

However, just because a company wants to buy back shares, does not mean you have to sell any of yours. A stock buyback offer is just like any other trade on the open market. Before a trade occurs, would-be buyers and sellers must agree on a fair price.

There is also one noteworthy difference between a stock buyback versus simply selling stock to another trader. In a "regular" trade, one of you is the seller, and the other is the buyer. End of story. But when you own a company's stock, you own a piece of its capital, making you a co-owner. Thus, in a stock buyback, you may have vested interests on both sides of the trade.

And that's where things get interesting. How do companies use (and occasionally abuse) stock buybacks to deliver sustainable value to its shareholders? We'll explore that in our next piece. If you'd like to know more, please email info@invest-


