# Alpacas In North Texas

"We get a lot of shock and awe at how peaceful and serene this little spot is."

Russell Foster changed out of his threepiece suit and put on his overalls. He and his wife both took retirement packages from their high-paying international jobs to settle down on a twenty-three acre farm near Aubrey in Denton County.

"We had this place and decided to do something with it," says Russell. "We bought a couple of alpacas and my wife wanted a little bit of lavender. I went down to a wholesaler and came back with

three thousand lavender plants. The man who sold them to me said 'you're going to have the largest lavender farm in north Texas." Russell's place has lavender, pumpkins and Christmas trees. You can also do alpaca yoga.

"You're outdoors, you hear the birds sing. You've got a lot of nature all around you and as you're in one of your yoga poses you may open your eyes and see an alpaca two inches away from your face staring at you. They don't climb on you like goat yoga. They just look at you."

The place is called TX-TURE farm.

"The goal here is to give people old fashioned experiences that they may have never had before, such as the cutting of the Christmas trees."

I asked Russell why he chose to have alpacas on his place.

"Things just happen and we roll with it and it just ends up being a good thing. We chose alpacas because they are cute. They're kind of the cosmetics for the property. Besides that we fell in love with them."

After the June bloom of the lavender, summer is a quiet time at the farm. Things pick up in the fall. That's pumpkin season.

"I'm a hobby blacksmith so we have the North Texas Blacksmith Association come here and we support veterans. On Veterans Day November eleventh we open the farm to people who want to try their hand at forging. Proceeds go to various veterans groups including the wounded warriors project."

Christmas is a busy time.

"We run the Paca Express, our little train that goes out to the Christmas trees and the alpacas will be running around looking like reindeer."

Although the farm has been open only two years, people are finding out about it.

"They get caught up in their daily lives as I used to, commuting to work, all that stress. What if you could come out for a weekend, take a picnic basket, sit in a grassy spot and have alpacas all around you. That's real peace."



Labor Day became a U.S. federal holiday in 1894, but by that time thirty states already officially celebrated the holiday. Labor Day was created by members of the labor movement, who organized strikes and rallies to fight for better working conditions amid the Industrial Revolution, according to the History Channel.

On September 5, 1882, New York City union leaders organized what is now considered the country's first Labor Day parade, according to National Geographic. On this day, 10,000 workers took unpaid time off to march through the streets of New York City, in an event culminating in a picnic, fireworks, and dancing. Organizers declared the day "a general holiday for the workingmen of this city." Their idea spread across the country, and many states passed legislation recognizing the workers holiday.

It wasn't until 1894, however, that Congress legalized the holiday following the Pullman strike, a nationwide railroad boycott that turned fatal and shined a national spotlight on workers' rights. Amid this massive unrest, Congress sought to make peace with American workers by passing an act making Labor Day a legal holiday. President Grover Cleveland officially signed it into law on June 28, 1894. Strangely enough, The Department of Labor was created after Labor Day became a holiday, and it was the first department to be led by a woman: Francis Perkins.

More than a century later, the true founder of Labor Day remains unknown, although many credit labor union leader Peter J. McGuire for the idea. The world may never know this detail, but now you know enough about Labor Day to truly celebrate

everything it stands for.


