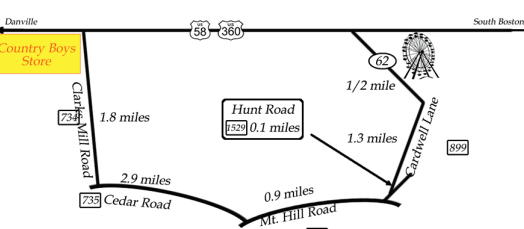

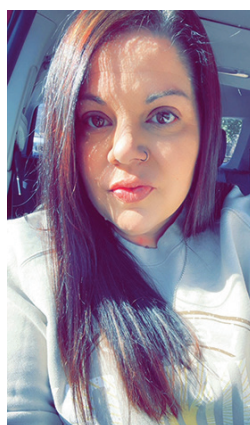

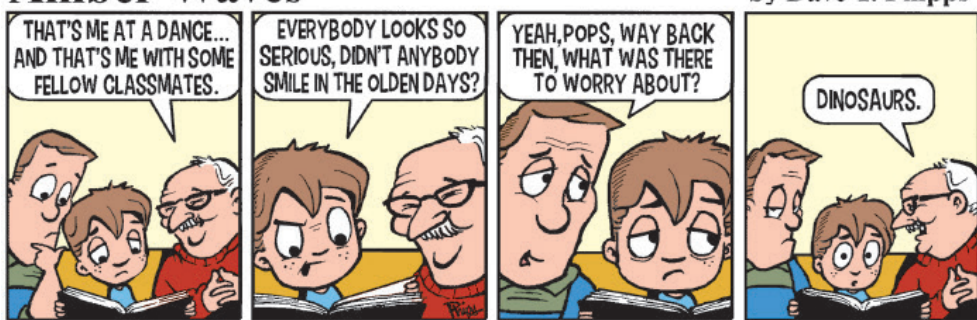

We are thrilled to announce the return of the PETA mobile spay/neuter clinic. This year, on October 19th and 20th, 120 surgeries will be performed through the courtesy of the E. Stuart James Grant Charitable Trust. That is correct – the surgeries will be free for residents of Danville and Pittsylvania County.

We hope that we can reach people who truly need the extra assistance and do not have a regular local veterinarian.

Spaying and neutering remains the ONLY way to reduce pet overpopulation and end euthanasia of adoptable dogs and cats. Bigger shelters will not solve the problem; neither will adoption and transfer programs.

There will be two check-in times per day. The morning check-in will be from 7-7:30 a.m. with pick-up time between 12-2 p.m. Afternoon check-in is 2:30-3 p.m. with pick-up time between 6-8 p.m. Owners will need to make arrangements to honor the check-in and pick-up times. We will do our best to accommodate individual needs, but it may not be possible.

The PETA information indicates that "not every companion animal is a good surgical candidate for our clinics. (e.g., seniors). Those with specific medical conditions are better served by being spayed or neutered in a full-service veterinary facility that can better meet their individual needs."

Some of the guidelines are:
Dogs must be at least five months old and under the age of five years.
Cats must be at least three months and under five years old.

Dogs must weigh at least six pounds and no more than 60 pounds.
Cats must weigh three pounds.

Rottweilers, Dobermans, and Great Danes will not be accepted, due to certain breed predispositions.
No brachiocephalic breeds will be accepted. (These are the dogs and cats generally known as those with "squished noses.")
Dogs or cats who behave aggressively toward people or other animals cannot be accepted.

Other services (e.g. heartworm tests, pre-surgical bloodwork, rabies vaccinations, etc.) will also be available; however, those services will be paid by the owner.

Southside Soccer U17 Boys Excel in Fall Openers



Blairs, VA - Southside Soccer Club's U17 NC Fusion team, NCF 17U Southside Red, had a strong showing in two fall season openers.

18 young men, all former Southside Soccer Club recreational soccer players, have created the genesis of a highly successful team. To create the team, Southside Soccer Club leveraged its affiliation with NC Fusion, a Greensboro based sports league, to provide local players an opportunity to bring their play to a regional level.

During the August 19-20 weekend, Southside Red engaged Valley United's 2023 Fall Kickoff Classic in Roanoke, Virginia. This tournament had a three game bracket format. Four teams participated in Southside Red's age division. Southside Red lost their first game to a Roanoke team, NPL Classic 1, 5-1, who eventually won the tournament.

"There definitely were some first game jitters," Coach Kevin White, head coach of NCF 17U Southside Red, said. The contest between NPL Classic 1 and 17U Southside Red was the team's first time playing together in competition. In the team's second game, they defeated NPL Classic 2, 3-1. Their final game was against Martinsville's Piedmont Youth Soccer League (PYSL), which they tied 3-3.

"We came back with five minutes left in the second half, and tied the PYSL game up," White said. "We played strong teams in Roanoke, but as a coach it is good to know we can put together a team that can compete at that level."

In the September 1-3, 2023, Labor Day Shootout sponsored by Truist, Southside Red found themselves in a much larger Greensboro, North Carolina, tournament with 40+ different soccer clubs participating from five different states. In the Southside Red's age division, there were six teams competing.

"These teams were even better than Roanoke," Coach White said.

In their first game, Southside Red drew a match with the age group's eventual winners, a Charlotte, North Carolina, based team. They lost 3-1. In the second game, they tied 2-2 with a Roanoke team. Finally, they defeated local club Danville Blast 4-1 in their 3rd and final game.

"The team played even better in Greensboro, and we keep getting better every game," Coach White said. "We are working on building an outstanding travel team from our area. We do have the talent in this area."

Prior to Fall 2023, Southside Soccer Club teams playing as an affiliate club with NC Fusion struggled to capture wins. Despite the mixed win/loss record from the tournaments, Coach White and his team of 14, 15, and 16 year olds are extremely positive. Everyone sees the team coming together quickly. "We play a hard, clean game," Coach White said.

Several opposing coaches had positive feedback for the team. Coach White stresses good sportsmanship and fun, which was not lost with their opponents.

"All my players are stepping up to the challenge of playing at a higher level, especially in coming from Rec. (recreational soccer)," Coach White said.

"I want people to consider Southside/Fusion first before they go look at outside teams. We really have a good thing going."

Southside Red's next in-season tournament is the Appalachian Fall Classic in Kingsport, Tennessee, September 30 to October 1, 2023.

Southside Soccer is a non-profit 509(a)(2), a sub designation under 501(c)(3), community organization providing recreational soccer for Pittsylvania County and Danville, Virginia. The club maintains access to fields, manages competitive leagues, and provides soccer instruction. The Club is managed by unpaid volunteers of parents and coaches. The Club has faithfully grown and served the Danville and Pittsylvania communities since 2003. It is an NC Fusion affiliate club.

Project Imagine partners with CIS program

Project Imagine will be participating in the Community in Schools (CIS) of Virginia program at Danville Public Schools by providing instruction that addresses the self-efficacy of students. Robert David, violence prevention manager for Project Imagine, said he is excited about the partnership. "This is another opportunity to do some great work by extending what we do into the school system," David said. "Project Imagine is already deeply embedded into the community. What this does is bridge the gap."

Project Imagine is a community violence intervention collaborative for ages 21 and under that provides at-risk and gang affiliated individuals opportunities for success through multi-resource interventions. The idea is to create a positive "image" in the mind of a youth so that they he or she can "imagine" a life without gangs or crime. Willie Gillus Jr., director of embedded operations for the CIS of Virginia program, said CIS programs operate nationally. They work by forging partnerships with schools and bringing in community resources such as Project Imagine to provide additional support to students in need.

The goal is to keep students in schools and have them graduate. "We want to wrap our arms around students not only during the school day but after school as well," Gillus said. "We want to extend the learning process. Learning does not stop at 3 o'clock. Some students deal with conflict resolution issues, so this is a great opportunity to work with professionals who work with kids and provide awesome support to these students." Brenda David is the CIS of Virginia student support coordinator for Danville Public Schools. She will be working with up to 60 students from grades 9-12 at George Washington High School. The students in the program will come from referrals from teachers and parents.

Barker, Buffett, Richardson and Extraordinary Lives

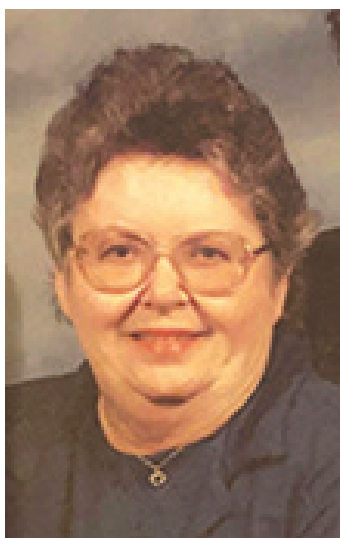
The best we can do is the best we can do. We should trust God and live our lives in as meaningful a way as possible.

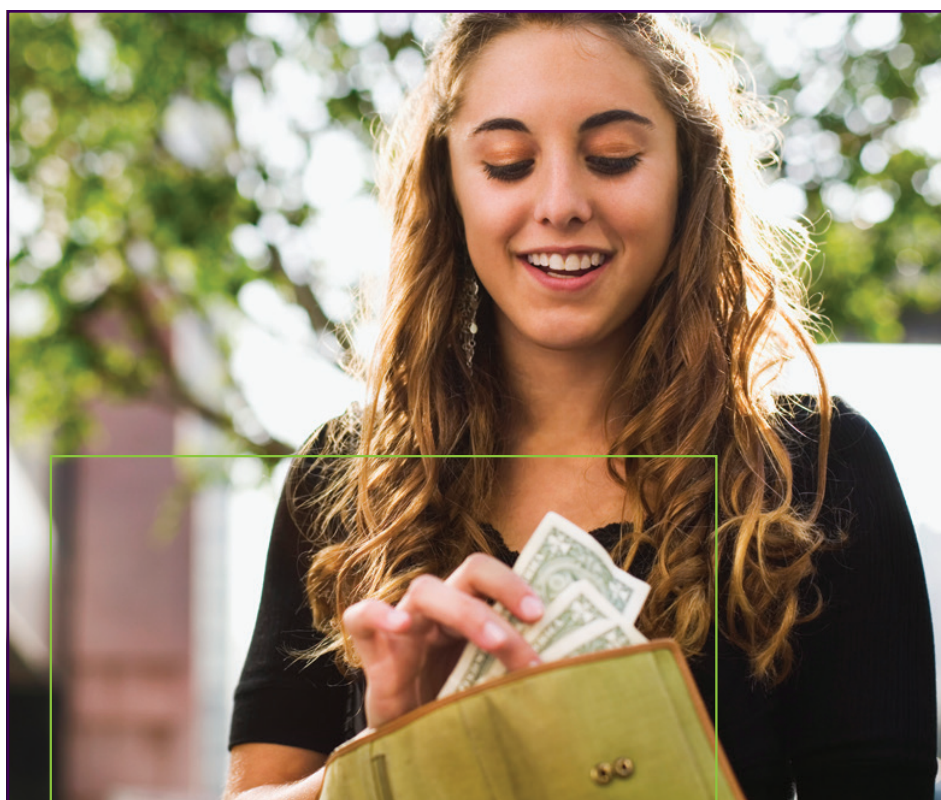

* Solve the case of the tricky screw: Coat problem screws with clear fingernail polish right before you insert them. They will hold tightly after that.

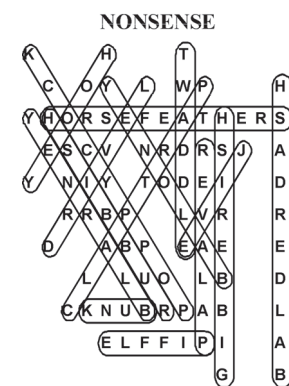
