





Iron Tusk is Raising The Bar on the Tattoo Experience.

Will and Emmet Upton enhanced the tattooing experience in Warren County.

ron Tusk Art Co. is more than a tattoo shop. It is a "local hub" for local artists within the tri-county area, providing mentorship and promotion for local artists and "artistically curious" or inspiring artists. In addition to providing body art, it triples as an art gallery and men's retail store. Owner Emmet Upton was living in Michigan when he and his brother, Will Upton, decided to raise the bar on tattoos and the experience behind getting a tattoo and bringing this innovation to Warren County. Iron Tusk is a big, welcoming, inviting, and well-lit space where everyone who enters will leave feeling inspired to express themselves in all art forms. Will said he and his brother wanted to offer a great environment to the community and reverse the stereotypes behind tattoos. Like many other art forms, tattoos have evolved over the years, and the brothers pride themselves on staying innovative.

"You look at the very first tattoos from the 90s to now, where there are 3D tattoos."

The name "Iron Tusk" was well-thought-out and part of a larger project to support a cause the company is passionate about.

Upton said, "Iron is hard and immovable, and the tusk represents anti-poaching foundations." The company's philanthropic branch donates a portion of the proceeds to the International Anti-Poaching Foundation. The Anti-poaching initiative serves to train local militias to end animal poaching. Naming the company after such an initiative is their contribution to ending the illegal ivory trade. The Engineers uniquely crafted the shop to help the Upton brothers focus on client experience and the quality of tattoos. The artists are innovative, but the quality of their art speaks for itself. The shop was open for five months before it was voted "Best of the Best Tattoo Shops" in Warren County.

Will Upton is not a tattoo artist, but he guides clients from receiving good to great tattoos; he's the bridge between artist and client.

"What's exciting to me is sparking their idea into a flame. While it might not be on my body, my input is still on their arm."

Artist Cristopher Stephens, also known as "Critter," said art has been a unique part of his life since he was a kid.

"I wasn't too academically passionate, and that was because I knew what I wanted to do. I knew I was going to draw as a very young child."

Critter said his wife inspired him to become a tattoo artist. He said, "We challenge ourselves to look at everything through a unique perspective." Critter said breaking people out of their shells is one of the most exciting parts about being an artist. "Doing that every day puts things into a new perspective of life."

The company would like the community to know they're open to people coming, no matter their level, and displaying goods and art.

Upton said, "If someone has artistic expression, we want to hear it. We want to be a place where other artists can come in, network and build, grow, and learn just as we're doing simultaneously."

Recently, Special Games purchased a building at 225 Garfield Street that they will use as an Enrichment Center. With just over 100 participants, they offer a variety of thrilling opportunities for the special needs community, including their annual Spring Fling, olympic-type events,



basketball games and tournaments, year-round sports events, parties, and scheduled get-togethers that encourage camaraderie and lasting friendships. They also offer art classes, water play days in the summer, hygiene products to their participants, and a food pantry for struggling families within the special needs community. "The incredible thing about us is that we are one big family," said co-founder Donna Wanamaker. "We love each other, and we enjoy being together. We are blessed with an amazing team of volunteers, and without them, none of this would be possible."

"MSG has added many opportunities for growth for my daughter, Olivia," said Julie Sullivan. "She has met many new friends and tried new things: from being around horses, and creating art projects to running the 50 yard dash. We are so excited at the growth of community support and cannot wait for the McMinnville Enrichment Center to fully open."

Special Games also offers an equestrian therapy program called Horsin' Around. They meet the first Saturday of each

month (weather permitting) at a beautiful 9-acre farm at 1680 Harrison Ferry Rd. Scientists have proven that equestrian therapy improves posture, balance, and mobility while calming anxiety and reducing stress in riders. This program is available to men, women, and children with special needs. Funded 100% by donations and sponsorships, this program makes a difference in the lives of all involved.

"We are always looking for volunteers, and donations are always welcome," said McBride. "We are so blessed by the love and support of the citizens and businesses of McMinnville."



very season has something unique to offer the Rock Island visitors, but the park manager, Damon Graham's, favorite season is spring. The profusion of wildflowers, including some rare orchids as well as migrating birds, make Rock Island feel magical.

Have you ever seen an osprey, with its six-foot wingspan, pulling its sushi dinner out of the river right in front of you? That is a sight to behold and something to put on your bucket list. In addition to osprey, eagles call the park home year-round, and visitors can see a wide variety of songbirds, some rare, at the park. Birds are most likely to be seen during spring and fall during migration when the park has fewer visitors. The quiet surroundings make bird sightings more common.

Summer

Summer brings an influx of visitors for the variety of outdoor activities available. Weekends are often overflowing, so be sure to arrive early or plan to visit mid-week to enjoy the park. Families enjoy swimming at the sandy beach on Center Hill Lake and taking advantage of the three boat launches. Fishing is

always popular at Rock Island; be sure you have your license if you are 13 years or older. Camping and picnicking help to extend the outdoor experience. Eating outdoors gives you a million-dollar view and enhances the flavor of your food.

Seasonal ranger-led activities include kayaking, nature walks, and animal presentations, among others. Check the park's website for schedule information.

Fall

The coolness of fall brings fewer visitors and a return of migrating birds. It is a wonderful time to lose yourself in the oasis of Rock Island. Enjoy the crunchy leaves as you hike or the beauty of the fall colors as you kayak around Center Hill Lake.

People who have mobility challenges love seeing an amazing waterfall from the parking lot. At Rock Island, beauty is available to people with all levels of health and fitness.

Immerse yourself at Rock Island by staying for a few days. RV hookup sites are available year-round, while tent camping can be done March 15 -October. Camping is a wonderful way to get back in touch with nature, but if a few more luxuries are your preference, there are lovely rental cabins available.

Winter

Winter at Rock Island can have a magic of its own. The leaves have fallen, so you can see the views more clearly with the fewest visitors. A vigorous walk in a beautiful place warms body and soul.

As John Burroughs said, "I go to nature to be soothed and healed, and to have my senses put in order." Rock Island State Park is nearby in every season to assist with our mental and physical health.

Spring

Spring rains make the park water levels change drastically. The roar of the water and awe-inspiring churning help one to appreciate the power and strength in all of those individual droplets merging in the rivers. While not all trails and areas are accessible with high water, it is a sight to behold.

Be aware of potential water release by the TVA. If you hear sirens or notice rising water, retreat immediately to higher ground.

The centerpiece of the 883-acre
Rock Island State Park is the beautiful
Center Hill Lake, along with three rivers:
Caney Fork, Collins, and Rocky River.

findings. While this is not unheard of, it is extremely rare.

rograms to prepare students for education, advanced placement coursework, dual enrollment with the local community college, and the Career and Technical Education program all showcase that education is important to the people of Warren County.

Warren County currently consists of 36 schools: 15 preschools, 17 elementary schools, eight middle schools, and nine high schools, all of which are consistently being adapted in order to fit the needs of the current students. This creates an environment of growth and development in the Warren County school system.

Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT), in particular, has undergone impactful change within recent years in order to account for the high demand it has seen. According to Brooks Young, the coordinator for workforce development and institutional affairs, enrollment into TCAT is the highest it has been in over five years.

TCAT is a two-year school designed to prepare students for a career. TCAT McMinnville offers nine programs in the technical and skilled trade industries. These programs currently range from automotive technology to cosmetology.

Though already offering many opportunities to students, TCAT will continue to grow and change in order to meet the needs of students. Within the coming years, there is hope to expand some of the current programs to include evening course offerings. The local high

schools are working to offer dual enrollment options for students who want to get a head start. In December 2021, TCAT McMinnville was awarded the GIVE 2.0 grant that will aid in achieving the goal of new dual enrollment programs. There are also plans for the funds to go toward providing career exploration opportunities to the middle schoolers in the area.

"Our ultimate goal is to provide early postsecondary opportunities in every high school within our eight-county service area," Young said. This is just one of the many ways TCAT is extending the hand of education to the entire community.

TCAT is also playing a role in correctional education, and now offers specialized training to those in the county jail. This will help in providing jobs after their time is served. The hope of this program is that it will lower the rates of recidivism in the McMinnville area.

Education is a top priority for Warren County. This shows in the many ways that the officials push for opportunities to be available to all. The county centers its time, money, and energy on expanding and advancing the McMinnville education system. TCAT education is used to advance the community and benefits a multitude of age groups. Many people in the McMinnville area are already positively affected by the educational efforts that have been put forth. TCAT has spearheaded this growth. The program plans to continue to be a beacon of hope for education and the ways it can grow individuals.

arren County Youth Leadership (WCYL) is a leadership development program designed to provide local emerging and existing youth leaders with the tools to develop individual leadership skills, influence their schools, and contribute to their community. The purpose of WCYL is to train students in leadership techniques and community awareness so that they may become familiar with current issues, community resources, opportunities, and other factors influencing the direction of Warren County's future. You do not have to be the president of your class or the team captain. This is for all students who have leadership potential or have a desire to learn more about leadership

and opportunities in the community.

Our Youth Leadership class is open to upcoming high school juniors who apply by the set date on the application each year. The class starts in September and concludes in April. The class spends one day a month with local businesses and learns about different program topics. The program topics in the past have included Agriculture, Communication, Tourism, Education, Business & Industry, Warren County History, Life Skills, Health & Social Services, Law, Local Government, and State Government. The class concludes in April with a unique class project to give back to our community.

So far this year, our class has traveled to the Warren County A&L Fair to learn about tourism and agriculture, and to Cedarwood Pumpkin Patch to learn about the nursery business in our county. The class also did a historical walking tour with Jimmy Haley, learned about Mainstreet McMinnville, the Tourism Development Board, and did various team-building activities. In March, the class will go to the Capital for Bologna Day (Day on the Hill) to meet with legislators, tour the capitol building, and attend a committee meeting. The class is currently working on their class project and will present it to their community partner by the end of April.

Educational Opportunities in Warren County

Warren County makes all forms of education a top priority.

Warren County makes education a priority for all students by providing programs like TN Promise, and TN Achieves, and Higher Ed opportunities through the Foundation of Educational Progress. TN Promise

The Tennessee Promise is a scholarship and mentoring program that began in the fall of 2015. The scholarships they offer students cover tuition and fees not covered by the Pell Grant, the HOPE scholarship, or TSAA. For this program, removing the financial burden is key, but an important component of Tennessee Promise is the mentorship each participant will receive as they prepare for their higher education. Students must also complete 8 hours of community service per term, maintaining satisfactory academic progress (2.0 GPA).

TN ACHIEVES

tnAchieves is an organization that partners with the TN Promise Scholarship in 83 of the 95 counties in Tennessee. They aim to increase higher education opportunities for Tennessee high school students by providing mentorship and scholarships.

The organization serves about 90% of Tennessee's high school seniors each year, working with 98% of all TN Promise scholarship applicants.

The organization also provides student advising and support, increasing retention and completion. This ensures consistency in many areas.

tnAchieves guides students from high school through college and into their careers. Foundation of Educational Progress

The Foundation of Educational Progress is a non-profit that helps provide resources for students pursuing an education. It improves educational progress by enhancing academic scholarships and programs. The foundation offers educational assistance to students in the Warren

The organization's website also provides information on organizations similar to the Foundation of Educational Progress for students who are not located in Warren County.

It is essential to ensure that our future leaders are prepared for the next step, and the Foundation of Educational Progress is a great starting point for Warren County students.

ROBOTICS

It is no surprise that Warren County makes STEM a top priority in enhancing students' quality of education. The county has an Automation Robotics Training Center (ARTC), part of the workforce group of Motlow College. They are one of two facilities within 250 miles that have three competing robot companies in the facility. The center's mechatronics program helps students learn the technical skills needed for the workforce while providing hands-on experience.

The Tennessee College of Applied Technology (TCAT), next door to the center, provides young men and women with many hands-on opportunities.

TCAT is a 2-year program designed to prepare students for their careers. There are nine programs in the technical and skilled trade industries at TCAT McMinnville. The program constantly finds new ways to expand and help students pursue their dreams.

Students earning the Mechatronics diploma will be trained in manufacturing, focusing on accuracy and productivity using various skills like pneumatics, hydraulics, robotics, computer controls, and preventive maintenance.
