

This week's article is: A Balanced Look at Stock Buybacks -Part 2: Sustaining Current and Future Value.

Striking a Balance: Buy Back or Plow In?

Broadly speaking, stock buybacks are meant to deliver value to a company's shareholders in two potential forms:

1. A bump in share value: Removing shares from the public exchange increases the per-share worth of remaining shares. As one of the world's best-known business owners Warren Buffett described in his shareholder letter: "The math isn't complicated: When the share count goes down, your interest in our many businesses goes up."

2. An opportunity to sell: Those on the sell side of a stock buyback presumably profit from the trade, or at least have some incentive to sell shares.

At the same time, your company (if you're a shareholder and/ or an employee) must spend some of its retained earnings during a buyback, or potentially even take on debt. Clearly, this leaves less cash in the company coffers for other purposes.

As such, a stock buyback represents a trade-off between two opposing forces: enhancing shareholder returns, versus preserving enough capital to continue delivering solid value moving forward.

A company's management, its employees, and its investors should typically want to strike an appropriate balance between sustaining current and future value. Stock buybacks can (but don't always) help make this happen.

Why Do Companies Repurchase Their Own Stock?

How and when does a company decide a stock buyback represents shareholders' best interests, and the best use of its capital? There are a number of reasons a company may embark on a buyback offer.

Distributing "excess" capital: If a company is thriving, with what feels like a cash surplus on its books, its board may decide to reward shareholders with the aforementioned boost in stock value. If the buyback offer is appealing, current shareholders may also take some of their gains off the table by selling shares back to the company.

One argument goes: If a company has more cash than it really needs, a buyback may make more sense than spending the money mindlessly, at the ultimate expense of its shareholders.

Creating tax-efficiency: You may have noticed a similarity between stock buybacks and dividend distributions. For both, the company pays out capital to shareholders ... with a tax twist. Dividend distributions are taxable when they occur. In a stock buyback, your shares increase in value, but you're only taxed on a gain when/if you sell them. Thus, stock buybacks are considered a more tax-friendly way to distribute capital to company shareholders, at least in taxable accounts.

Managing share dilution: If a fast-growing startup (for example) has leaned heavily on stock options to recruit and retain employees, these options can start to dilute the stock's per-share value once employees begin exercising them. If the company has thrived, it may choose to buy back some of its "excess" shares, to maintain good value on the remainder.

Fighting a takeover bid: A stock buyback is expected to increase share value, as described above. Obviously, the higher the share price, the more expensive it becomes to snatch up new shares. Thus, a stock buyback is one way a company may try to prevent a hostile takeover.

Stock Buybacks: Risks Amidst the Rewards

So far, we've summarized the ways stock buybacks can be an effective tool in the right hands, delivering powerful, tax-efficient value to shareholders, without necessarily stunting future growth. 





Registration fee for the workshop is \$25, with registration required by October 1. Those interested can register online at https://go.iastate.edu/M1SR6Y.



Prevent Suicide: Spread Awareness, Break the Stigma, Save a Life

by Dawn Dunnegan, Human Sciences Specialist in Family Life Every year in September, mental health advocates, prevention organizations, survivors, allies and community members unite to

promote suicide prevention awareness. This is also an opportunity to reduce the stigma that often surrounds the topic of suicide and mental health conditions, said Dawn Dunnegan, a human sciences specialist with Iowa State University Extension and Outreach.

Suicide rates were up 36 percent from 2000 to 2021 and suicide is the leading cause of death in the United States. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, in 2021, over 48,000 lives were lost to suicide. That is, on average, one individual every 11 minutes.

"For every one death by suicide, research tells us 275 other people have seriously considered suicide," Dunnegan said.

Although males make up 50 percent of the population, they account for nearly 80 percent of all suicides. According to the CDC, people who are age 85 years or older have the highest suicide rates. Suicide is the second leading cause of death in people age 10-34.

What you can do to help prevent suicide

"Children and youth often struggle with how to cope with stress. Youth can be particularly overwhelmed when their stress is connected to a traumatic event — like a natural disaster, family loss, school shootings or community violence," said Dunnegan, who specializes in family wellbeing.

Parents, caregivers and educators can take steps to provide stability and support that help young people feel better. Adults can try to maintain as much of a normal routine as possible.


"Listen to what your child is telling you about their stress and/or fears and watch and listen for changes in behavior. Reassure your child of their safety and know the resources in your community to reach out to," Dunnegan said.

"Suicide is a preventable kind of death, and one person has the ability to step up and help save a life. Evidence shows that providing support services, reducing access to means of self-harm, talking with the individual about suicidal thoughts, feelings or plans, and following up with the individual we are concerned about can help save a life," Dunnegan said.

Pledge to learn more and do more to help support your family members, friends or colleagues who may be thinking about suicide. Contact your ISU Extension and Outreach county office to sign up for a Mental Health First Aid training or a Question, Persuade, Refer, (QPR) suicide prevention training. These trainings can help you learn some of the warning signs of suicide such as talking about wanting to die or having no reason to live, fear of being a burden to others, giving away possessions, withdrawing from others, increased use of alcohol or drugs, talking about themselves in past tense and extreme mood swings.



To love an addict To many of you, this may be information you already know. Maybe it will be the validation that you need to know that you aren't crazy or that you aren't alone. Now, I want to clarify that I am referring to addicts/alcoholics that are in active addiction, meaning that they are currently using drugs or alcohol. That does not mean that some of this cannot be true for a dry addict (not actively using), or even someone in recovery, but that is

not my focus for this article. Loving an addict, as a family member, friend, or spouse/ significant other is... exhausting. By exhausting, I mean you experience a variety of emotions at various times including: rage, disappointment, betrayal, distrust, devastation, hopelessness, desperation, etc.

Often, by the time we realize that the person we love has a problem with addiction, we have already become the caretaker, enabler, secret keeper, and "co-dependent". Maybe that looks like searching the bars for them at night, calling their boss to tell them that they have the "flu", or hiding from the kids that mom/dad didn't come home last night.

Sometimes, loving an addict means being told that you are the problem, that "if only" you would have done "xyz" then they wouldn't have relapsed, or that you are crazy because that bottle/pipe/pill is NOT theirs and they have NOT used. And sometimes, no matter how badly your heart breaks, you have to let go and let them face their own consequences. If you are one of the people who has experienced a life of loving an addict, you know that what I just said feels like the most impossible suggestion ever. And many of us don't successfully let go. We beg, barter, negotiate, plead, threaten, cry, promise to never give up, and promise we're done forever.

The addict/alcoholic will lie, cheat, steal, beg, cry, promise to change, use/drink again, and lie again while looking you in the eye with the most convincing story ever. The cycle continues. But we don't have to keep going with that cycle. We have a choice, and we can step away while still loving the addict! If you or someone you know is currently trying to get out of the cycle and aren't sure how, there are people who can help. 



View From The Bench

Iowa "Hawkeyes" Iowa State

Iowa took their 7th of the last 8 Cy-Hawk games in all too familiar fashion for Cyclone fans on Saturday, winning in what ISU coach Matt Campbell calls the "margins", doing all the little things better than the Cyclones to pull out a 20-13 victory in Ames. Last week I predicted a 24-14 Iowa victory, so this game was about what I expected. If you haven't seen this happen year after year, you would be surprised that the team who won the first down battle 19-9, had a higher 3rd down efficiency rate, had 55 more total yards (290-235), actually punted for a better average (51.8-46.3), and won time of possession 33:30-26:30 actually lost the game and was down by 17 points at one time. However, as we have seen all during the Matt Campbell era, Iowa does Iowa obviously so much better than anyone else, especially the Cyclones. Campbell would prefer that ISU win the way Iowa does, by doing the little things at an elite level while limiting mistakes and trying to be more physical than the opponent. Unfortunately for Iowa State, Iowa does all those things just a bit better than the Cyclones. Iowa rarely beats themselves and just sits back and waits for their opponent to make a mistake against their outstanding defense. That mistake for ISU came late in the second quarter when Sebastian Castro intercepted freshman Cyclone QB Rocco Becht and returned it for a Hawkeye touchdown and an invincible 17-0 lead. ISU also made key mistakes in this game that cost them dearly, including a blocked field goal after an impressive first drive of the game for ISU and a pass interference penalty on third down that kept alive Iowa's only touchdown drive of the game. Iowa played the entire game without one single penalty, which is astonishing, and they are the first college team to do so this season. Both teams had only one turnover, but the interception thrown by Iowa's Cade McNamara was more like a good punt on a long pass that resulted in no ISU points, while ISU's turnover and other two blunders cost them 17 points. Let's now take a look at my take aways for each team.

Let's start with the victorious Hawkeyes. As stated in the first paragraph, Iowa did what they do best in this game, they had some nice early drives, got a big special teams play in the blocked field goal, got the play of the game with the pick-six and then they were methodical with their ball control and defense to hang on for the win. Iowa's Cade McNamara is definitely not 100% with his quad injury, but he still is an upgrade from what Iowa had in the past with Spencer Petras and Alex Padilla. McNamara didn't do anything flashy, but made some very nice throws, especially early in the game to tight end Luke Lachey, who had three catches for 58 yards. McNamara had relatively pedestrian numbers, going 12/22 for just 123 yards with no TDs and the one interception, but he ran the offense well and made enough plays to help Iowa get the win. Running back Jaziun Patterson had a great 59-yard run early in the game that set up Iowa's first field goal, and finished the day with a game high 86 yards and Iowa's only offensive touchdown. Iowa's defense was once again elite; limiting Iowa State to the one late touchdown and then getting a big fourth down stop with 1:30 left to secure the victory. Iowa's defense controlled the line of scrimmage, limiting the Cyclones to just 87 rushing yards at a meager 2.8 yards per carry. Defensive back Cooper DeJean is truly one of the best players in the nation, never missing a tackle, breaking up passes and even contributing with great special teams play.

The young Cyclones showed some spunk by rallying from 17 points down to have a chance to tie or win the game on the last possession. Freshman QB Rocco Becht played pretty well, except for the huge pick-six that he threw, completing 23/44 passes for 203 yards and one TD. Transfer wide receiver Jayden Higgens was the best receiver on the field, hauling in eight passes for a game high 95 yards that included an impressive TD catch in the fourth quarter. Iowa State's offensive line is still a question mark, as they had issues opening holes for the Cyclone running backs, but they did protect Becht well for most of the game. I would say the losses to the gambling scandal that took five ISU starters was felt the most on Saturday in running back Jihrel Brock, who ran for over 100 yards in last year's Cy-Hawk game as ISU's main two running backs are both freshmen and have a lot of potential but are lacking the game experience Brock had. Like Iowa, the strength of this ISU team is definitely their defense, which held Iowa to just 9 first downs, 13 offensive points and just 235 total yards; normally those numbers would all be good enough to get the win, but not against this Iowa team. Iowa State has also found a solid kicker with Nebraska transfer Chase Contreraz hitting two long field goals after having his first attempt blocked. My thoughts haven't changed much on either team after the

first two weeks of the season. Iowa should move to 3-0 this week as they host a 1-1 Western Michigan team that lost 48-7 to Syracuse last weekend. The huge matchup for Iowa will be on September 23rd when they travel to Happy Valley to take on #7 Penn State. To win that game, Iowa will need to get McNamara healthier so he can avoid the fierce Nittany Lion rush, and will also need improved line play so they can run the ball better than they have the first two weeks of the season. Iowa State travels to Ohio to take on a 2-1 Bobcat team before starting Big 12 play at home vs Oklahoma State. I think Iowa still has a great chance to win 9-10 games, especially with how poor the Big 10 West has looked and how their defense will keep them in every game. I also still think ISU could win enough games to get to a bowl as they have shown some promise with a very young roster, and besides Texas, the Big 12 also hasn't looked too great early. We'll see how the season plays out for both teams, and staying healthy in key positions will be huge for both squads. It's great to have college football back, and even though it was a loss for the Cyclones, it's still great to be a loyal Cyclone!

Feeding for Protein and Profit Webinar

The Iowa State University Extension and Outreach Dairy Team's 2023 Dairy Webinar Series continues Wednesday, September 27 from 12 noon to 1 p.m. CDT, with a focus on feeding for protein and profit.

"The August protein price moved up to 2.08 from the July price of 1.15. This refocuses producer interest on increasing the protein content of their milk," notes Iowa State University and Extension Dairy Specialist Fred Hall.

To help producers and nutritionists understand how to modify dairy rations to encourage more protein we have two presenters on the topic.

Dr. Gail Carpenter, Assistant Professor and state-wide dairy specialist will present on rumen health and improved milk

Dr. David Atwell will discuss what producers can do to increase the yield of milk protein pounds in the tank. At well joined Adisseo in 2016 and serves as Dairy Technical and Business Development Lead for the upper Midwest and Western United States. Atwell holds a Ph.D. in Dairy Nutrition from the University of Illinois. Dr. Atwell has worked in the Dairy Industry for 33 years in a variety of roles, from technical services to nutrition consulting.
