We are receiving an increasing number of telephone calls from people who are concerned about coyotes in their neighborhood. According to the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries, the coyote population in Virginia continues to grow and is distributed throughout the state, even though it is thought that more coyotes live in the area west of the Blue Ridge Mountains.

The Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources suggests that "Small dogs and cats should be kept in an enclosure when kept outdoors in order to prevent coyotes from attacking and killing a pet animal. Even though a fence may dissuade coyotes from attacking your pet, be aware that coyotes can jump over fences less than 7-feet high and can climb over taller fencing that does not have an outward slanting overhang." (From www.dwr. virginia.gov.)

This certainly is not an issue that should cause undue concern or cause people to panic; we do not have hordes of coyotes in each neighborhood that are waiting to attack humans and their pets. However, it is not a bad idea to exercise caution. It is better to take a pro-active approach to staying away from coyotes and encouraging them to leave inhabited areas.

First and foremost, cats are safer inside. Small dogs should also not be left outside by themselves. All dogs and cats should have rabies vaccinations that are kept current. Dogs that are chained outside are also at risk of being attacked by coyotes.

If a food source is provided (even unintentionally through feeding pets outside), a coyote may become more comfortable in staying around your house. That is not a good thing, because the coyote may become more aggressive. Take steps to secure garbage cans, and prevent small prey from staying around your house; they can attract hungry coyotes.

The Department of Wildlife Resources also offers some good advice about how to make coyotes feel unwelcome. They suggest you find a place that keeps you safe from the animal, and then yell while throwing non-food items in the direction of the coyote.

It is always safer to stay away from wild animals, and it is safer for your pets to take steps to keep them away from them also.



Strates Shows Celebrates 57 Years Of Midway Magic In Southside Virginia

The James E. Strates Shows, exclusive midway provider for the Danville-Pittsylvania County Fair, is celebrating the 100th anniversary of its founding during 2023. It's a historic milestone in the outdoor amusement industry that has deep roots in South-Central Virginia. Strates Shows local connections first began at the Great Danville Fair in 1938, were revived in 2004 and will continue when the Danville-Pittsylvania County Fair opens on September 15th.

Strates Shows began in 1923 when James E. Strates, a Greek immigrant, began his first show. Strates came to America in 1909 and, like many immigrants, worked hard at many small jobs to find success in his new country. In 1919, he joined a carnival athletic show as a wrestler named "Young Strangler Lewis" who would take on all challengers. In 1923, James E. Strates cofounded Southern Tier Shows in Elmira, New York that consisted of a three-abreast merrygo-round, a Ferris wheel, an athletic show, 15 concessions and three side shows. In a short period of time, Strates reputation for running a clean, honest and entertaining show allowed him


to turn the ragtag hodgepodge of wagons and rigs into a thunderous railroad caravan of shows. In 1932 the carnival was renamed the James E. Strates Show and in 1934 began traveling by rail for the first time. The use of the train allowed the carnival to travel further distances including adding Southside Virginia to its route.

Strates first brought his railroad traveling carnival to the Great Danville Fair in 1938. The show consisted of 10 rides, 20 shows and 50 food and game concessions. He quickly made friends with Danville's Greek Community who centered around St. Peter's Orthodox Church. It's here that he first met Danville native Sam Sakellaris, who in addition to being the Secretary and Treasurer of the Great Danville Fair, would later join Strates Shows as its General Manager.

For years, James E. Strates had a great interest in the Danville Fair. He played a major part in the selection of the former Fairgrounds when the Fair was moved from its Forest Hills location. It was Strates who assisted Fair officials in planning and laying out the new grounds on Riverside Drive.

Postwar prosperity and "free-spending crowds" resulted in record Fair and midway attendance during the mid-1950s. Strates Shows grew to 65 railway cars, 650 employees, 30 rides and 20 shows. Many people remember Terrell Jacobs' Wild Animal Circus, the Hollywood Revue burlesque show, the motorcycle Thrill Arena and appearance by Johann Petursson, the 8 feet, 8 inches tall "Viking Giant." By the end of the 1950s, Strates Shows was one of the largest traveling amusement companies in North America.

Danville would forever be linked to Strates Shows history when, following the conclusion of the five-day 1959 Fair (where it rained for 4-days), James E. Strates would be stricken ill after experiencing a stroke. Strates passed away at Memorial Hospital on October 11, 1959.





According to a September 1960 article in the Danville Register & Bee, the night before Strates was taken ill he told Fair Manager C. C. Finch that although Danville was one of the carnival's smallest show-dates, it was the show-date that he valued most highly. Strates felt like he was coming home whenever the show returned to Danville because he had made some any close friends.

Following his passing, Strates' 29-year-old son E. James (Jim) Strates took over the family business. Under his leadership, Jim Strates would continue to transform the Show with innovation and creativity. His goal from the start was not to be the biggest, but to be the best midway in America. From marketing to customer service, he helped to lead not only his midway but the entire carnival industry, into the big-business, high-tech world of modern family entertainment.

During the 1960s and 1970s, new rides like the Sky Wheel, Sky Diver and Sky Ride dominated the midway. As the "show" aspect of the midway began to lose favorite with a new generation



of guests, imported rides from Europe became larger and more spectacular. In 1972, advanced midway ticket sales were introduced at the Danville Fair. An innovative centralized ticketing system was introduced in the mid-1970s allowing for accurate financial accountability and greater profits for fair partners. Strates Shows would provide the carnival to the Danville area for 38 seasons before the Greater Danville Fair was formally dissolved. During those years, the Fairgrounds moved several times and profits fluctuated due to hurricane season storms and flooding.

Without an authentic county fair in Danville for several years, Larry Burnett and his family brought back the tradition with the inaugural Danville-Pittsylvania County Fair in 1991. In 2004, Strates Show would return to Southside Virginia to provide the midway. 2023 will mark the 19th consecutive year for Strates Shows at the Danville-Pittsylvania County Fair and the 57th time since 1938 that the Strates Family has been part of the community's various celebrations.

As the Strates Shows celebrates its centennial year of operations the family business is led by the 3rd generation of Strates members including Jimmy, Jay, John, and Susan. Nick Strates, who officially joined the show full-time during the 2015 season, is the 4th generation of the Strates family to continue the tradition. Overseeing it all, as he has for the past six decades, is E. James Strates who is still actively involved in daily operations from the Strates Shows offices in Orlando.

About the Strates Shows – Celebrating its centennial year operations in 2023, Strates Shows is a family-owned and operated outdoor amusement and carnival business with headquarters in Orlando, Florida. Founded in 1923 by Greek immigrant James E. Strates as the Southern Tier Shows in Elmira, New York, the Strates Shows is one of America's premiere providers of carnival midways.






