

According to a press release issued by the Crow Wing County Attorney's Office, Officer Rustad found the unit to be locked. Looking through the window he could see people down in the residence. Rustad broke a window adjacent to the front entry door of the residence, reached inside and opened the locked door. Three bodies were found inside the home with apparent gunshot wounds. Jansen's son said his family had been renting the home since Sept. 1.

After autopsies conducted the Ramsey County Medical Examiner's Office, it was reported that Jansen and Parmenter suffered multiple gunshot wounds, with the manner of death listed as homicide. Toner was found dead from a single gunshot wound to the head, in a suspected suicide.

Based on the observations and investigation so far, it's believed Toner shot the two women before shooting him-

The investigation remains ongoing, but there is no evidence of any threat to the public.

program will help teachers repay up to \$3,000 per year, with a maximum of \$15,000 total. To qualify for this program, an applicant must:

- Have completed an undergraduate or graduate program in agricultural education at a college or university approved by the State of Minnesota to prepare persons for teacher licensure
- Be employed by a Minnesota school district, charter school, private school, or tribal contract school (eligible to receive aid) to provide agricultural education in any grade from grades 5 through 12
- Have outstanding qualified educational loan debt

Applications are due September 30, 2023.

#### **MENT SUMMARY CITY OF CUYUNA** On September 11, 2023

the City of Cuyuna adopted Ordinance Number 01-2023, amending Section No. 903.13 "General Requirements" Sub. 3, "Accessory Buildings," of the Cuyuna Zoning Ordinance. The amendment allows one accessory structure to be placed or constructed on vacant lots without the establishment of a principal use and creates performance standards for accessory structures on lots that do not contain a principal use.




