GRANDMA'S GROUND BEEF CASSEROLE

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- 2 (15 ounce) cans tomato sauce
- 1 teaspoon white sugar
- 1 teaspoon garlic salt
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 (8 ounce) package egg noodles
- 1 cup sour cream
- 3 ounces cream cheese, softened
- 1 large white onion, diced
- ½ cup shredded sharp Cheddar cheese, or more to taste

Directions

- 1. Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat. Cook and stir ground beef in the hot skillet until browned and crumbly, 5 to 7 minutes; drain and discard grease.
- 2. Mix tomato sauce, sugar, garlic salt, and salt into the ground beef; simmer until flavors blend, about 20 minutes. Remove from the heat, cover the skillet, and cool to room temperature.
- 3. While the sauce is cooking, bring a large pot of lightly salted water to a boil. Cook egg noodles in the boiling water, stirring occasionally until cooked through but firm to the bite, 7 to 9 minutes. Drain.
- 4. While the egg noodles are cooking, preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Grease a 9x13-inch casserole dish.

Ground Beef Casseroles

- 5. Mix sour cream, cream cheese, and onion together in a bowl.
- Layer 1/2 of the egg noodles into the prepared casserole dish. Top with 1/2 of the sour cream mixture, then 1/2 of the ground beef mixture. Repeat layers once more. Sprinkle Cheddar cheese over top.
- 7. Bake in the preheated oven until cheese is melted and golden brown, 25 to 30 minutes.

CHESSY BEEF AND TOMATO CASSEROLE

Ingredients

Yield 6 servings

- 1lb lean (at least 80%) ground beef
- 1 medium onion, chopped (1/2 cup)



- 1/8 teaspoon pepper
- ¾ cup uncooked medium-grain white rice
- 1 cup water
- 1 medium zucchini, cut into 1/4-inch-thick slices (2 cups)
- 1 large tomato, chopped (1 cup)
- 1 can (19 oz) Progresso[™] Vegetable Classics tomato basil soup
- 2 cups shredded mozzarella cheese (8 oz)

Directions

- 1. Heat oven to 375°F. Spray 13x9-inch (3-quart) glass baking dish with cooking spray. In 10-inch skillet, cook beef and onion over medium-high heat, stirring frequently, until beef is thoroughly cooked; drain. Sprinkle with salt and pepper.
- 2. Place rice and water in baking dish; stir to mix. Layer cooked beef, zucchini and tomato over rice. Pour soup over top. Cut 16x12-inch sheet of foil; spray with cooking spray. Cover dish with foil, sprayed side down.
- 3. Bake 40 minutes. Uncover dish; sprinkle cheese over top. Bake uncovered 10 to 15 minutes longer or until edges are bubbly and cheese is lightly browned.

HAMBURGER POTATO CASSEROLE

Ingredients

- 1 pound lean ground beef
- 1 (10.5 oz) can condensed cream of mushroom soup
- ¾ cup milk
- ½ cup chopped onion

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F
- 2. Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat. Cook and stir ground beef in the hot skillet until browned and crumbly, • 5 to 7 minutes. Drain and discard grease.
- 3. Mix condensed soup, milk, onion, salt, and pepper in a medium bowl until combined. Alternately layer the potatoes, soup mixture, and browned ground beef in a 2- 1. First, turn on your oven and set it to 350°F (175°C) quart baking dish.
- 4. Bake in the preheated oven until potatoes are tender, about 1 to 1 1/2 hours. Top with Cheddar cheese, and continue baking until cheese is melted.

CHESSY BEEF & MACARONI CASSEROLE

Ingredients

- 1 pound dry macaroni noodles
- 1 pound lean ground beef
- 2 cloves garlic minced
- 1 cup diced onion
- 1 cup diced green pepper
- 1 can crushed tomatoes 28 oz
- ½ cup tomato sauce
- 3-4 tablespoons tomato paste
- ½ teaspoon dry basil
- salt & pepper to taste
- 3 cups shredded cheddar cheese divided
- ¼ cup freshly shredded Parmesan cheese
- 3 tablespoons chopped fresh parsley divided

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F.
- 2. Cook noodles for ¾ of time according to package. (My noodles said 9 minutes so I cooked them for 6). Drain and rinse under cold water.
- 3. Meanwhile, brown beef, garlic & onion in a frying pan.
- 4. Combine green peppers, beef, noodles, tomatoes, tomato sauce & paste, basil, salt & pepper, 1 cup of cheddar cheese, 2 tablespoons fresh parsley. Pour into a 9×13 casserole dish.
- 5. Combine remaining cheeses & 1 tablespoon of parsley. Sprinkle on top of casserole. Bake uncovered for 35-40 minutes or until bubbly and cheese is browned!

KETO GROUND BEEF CASSEROLE WITH GREEN BEANS

Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- 3 ounces cream cheese
- 1/2 cup beef broth

- 1/2 cup heavy whipping cream
- 2 tsp Bragg's Aminos
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- 2 cans green beans, drained
- 3/4 cup cheddar cheese
- 3/4 cup mozzarella cheese
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper

Instructions

- degrees.
- 2. Next, grab a cast-iron skillet (a sturdy pan) and cook the ground beef in it. When it's done, strain to remove any extra grease.
- 3. Add the cream cheese to the cooked beef in the skillet. Stir it until the cheese melts and mixes with the beef.
- Pour in the beef broth, heavy whipping cream, Bragg's Aminos, garlic powder, onion powder, and a pinch of salt and pepper. Stir everything together well.
- 5. Bring the mixture to a boil by turning up the heat a bit. Keep an eye on it and let it cook on medium heat until it starts to thicken up a little.
- 6. Reduce the heat to low and let it simmer.
- 7. Place the green beans on top of the beef mixture in the skillet.
- 8. Sprinkle some cheddar cheese and mozzarella cheese on top of the green beans.
- 9. Pop the skillet into the preheated oven and bake it all together for 25 minutes.







"Wise Words" By: Hayes Wise Your Lot In Life

What is a "lot"? Haven't you heard someone say, "roll the dice" or "luck of the draw"? Arbitrary selection to determine a result goes way back. In the Bible they used a system of dice rolling that is referred to as "casting lots". (Mat 27:35). Did you ever have to make a decision about who gets something? "Heads I win". I remember as kids we would use a system called "Eenie, Meenie, Miney, Moe" to determine what happened. Remember your first "crush" when you used plucking flower petals to decide if you would be loved?

Sometimes what we perceive as our "lot" in life is really the result of the decisions that we made. We might try to explain it away as a random misfortune, but in reality it is our own fault. This is exactly what happened to a man named Abraham in the Bible. One day he heard the voice of God. The LORD said to Abram, "Leave your native country, your relatives, and your father's family, and go to the land that I will show you." (Gen 12:1). Notice that God has specifically asked him to leave his home, leave his relatives, and leave his immediate family. He was almost successful, but he took his nephew, Lot, with him. He was supposed to make a clean break from statue worship and the past, but he compromised in one area, his nephew, Lot. Read Genesis through chapter 23. What might look like a series of random misfortunes in the life of Abraham actually were the result of a premeditated choice on his part to disobey the word of God. CLAYBANK MASTER GARDENERS

Greetings Gardener Friends,

Last month the Claybank Master Gardeners were treated to a presentation from owner **Stan West of D & J Nurseries** in Dothan. He gave us much useful information about

growing citrus trees, which they sell in multiple varieties. Many of us were hit by the hard freeze last December, killing many of our citrus trees. Some can be revived by carefully



pruning branches growing below knee height. Trees with long thorns may have reverted to the original stock below the graft point. Citrus trees need to be fertilized every couple months with a balanced fertilizer like 8-8-8 or 10-10-10. Just sprinkle by handfuls around the drip line of your tree. He said to cover trees with heavy cloth, NOT bed sheets or plastic. Remove the covers in daytime to let the accumulated moisture air out. Don't let fruit remain on young trees until about the third year. This will give the root system longer to develop in the ground. There are new varieties were will soon be available that can tolerate even colder temperatures.

Be sure to look in on **Dothan Area Botanical Gardens**. There will be a **plant sale there the 29**th **and 30**th **of September, 9 to 4 pm** if you see this before then. Their Scarecrows in the Gardens event starts October 1st through the 31st.

What to plant now? The **SOW** app tells us that we can now plant **broccoli**, **carrots**, **kale**, **lettuce**, **mustard**, **onions**, **radishes**, **spinach**, **turnips**. (Those in italics were not on the list but may be okay as started plants).

The Claybank Master Gardeners meet at Hoppergrass Restaurant in Ozark on the 2nd Wednesday of each month at 11:00-12 noon.
