



Mille Lacs Community Trust Board awards grants to area non-profits

Inmate dies in jail

On Saturday, Sept. 23 at 8:49 a.m., deputies responded to a medical in the Crow Wing County Jail.

A female inmate, Shannon Lee Cook, 54, was found unresponsive in her bunk. Life-saving measures were attempted by both corrections staff and North Ambulance personnel. The inmate was announced deceased at 9:19 a.m.

The Morrison County Sheriff's Office responded and is investigating the matter. This is routine protocol in all in-custody deaths. The Ramsev County Medical Examiner performed an autopsy. The results of the autopsy are pending toxicology results.

The inmate was a boarder from Beltrami County. No foul play is suspected at this time.






