

eclipse viewing October 14 with solar projectors, telescopes, and eclipse glasses from 10:30am–2pm. "An annular eclipse takes place when the moon is a little further away from the Earth than average so that it is smaller in the sky and does not completely cover the sun," said Blake.

"The result is that there remains a ring of the sun not covered by the moon. This is why the annular eclipses are sometimes called a 'ring of fire.' The southwestern United States is favored for this eclipse and will see the ring of fire."

Most of the country will see a partial solar eclipse of varying amounts depending on how far from the eclipse path that you happen to be located. Florence will experience 66 percent of the sun blocked by the moon at maximum eclipse. The eclipse will begin at 10:36am, reach maximum eclipse at about 12:05pm, and end at approximately 1:38pm.

The easiest way to view the eclipse is to take a piece of cardboard and cut a hole in it; then take apiece of aluminum foil over it. Take a needle and put a little hole in it. The pinhole will show the shape of the eclipse on the ground or on a piece of paper. You can also use eclipse glasses, which are designed for viewing the sun.

Never try to look directly at an eclipse. You won't be able to see the shape clearly, and the rays can damage your eyes.

With this extremely dry weather, any fire can quickly spread out of control threatening lives and livelihood, not to mention destroying our forests.

According to AFC Fire Analyst Ethan Barrett, "Another thing to consider during drought conditions is that fires may persist or smolder for days in piles of debris. If anyone has burned in the past few days, they should closely monitor the burned area to prevent re-ignition of embers. In light fuels such as grass and leaves, there is potential for escape of fires. Large diameter fuels (limbs 3' or greater in size), may continue to burn for days, if not weeks."







1In those circumstances where we can find a non-employee

or third-party at fault as in a traffic accident, or a defective product, such as a saw or forklift, we can get more money for an injury. The worker's comp statute by its very purpose limits what an employee can recover. It has no effect on non-employee injuries or injuries caused by third parties.

However, worker's comp for an on-the-job injury is defined by our Legislature and what an injured worker receives does not depend at all on whose fault it was.

Worker's comp does not pay for loss of enjoyment of life. Think of playing with kids or sports or a good night's sleep - things we enjoy. Worker's comp pays no matter who's at fault, but it does not pay for enjoyment of life (hedonistic) damages.

If a driver runs a stop sign, they are responsible for medical bills, lost wages, pain and suffering and loss of enjoyment of life.

The law provides for those damages (and more) in fault based cases. The law does not allow for those damages for injuries that occur on the job.





True. McCarthy was excessively pro-Ukraine when most Americans are sick of being used as the monetary pawn for a corrupt government that appears to have had a pre-existing arrangement with our current president.

McCarthy was far too soft on the January 6 prosecutorial sham, and he allowed the January 6 Committee to get away with destroying all the supposed evidence it had against Donald Trump without so much as a public reprimand.

However, with Democrats controlling the White House and the Senate and the House under slim Republican control, Gaetz's hardline position and reckless action could backfire on his own party.

Democrats enjoyed every minute of the Republican's self-ignited We stupidity. know Democrats support any upheaval in society, and they were allowed the privilege joining in on the overthrow of a Republican House speaker, en masse. Gaetz's coupled his selfserving demonstration with a social media fundraising opportunity since he envisions himself in the Florida Governor's mansion next term.

Some have accused the likes of Jim Jorden and Byron Donalds as being RINO's for supporting McCarthy. Why should those who supported McCarthy during the internal coup have to explain themselves?

Many of them can play rough when the opportunity is right, and I would support THAT.

However, rebelling after a 45-day holdover vote was poor timing. Complete Democrat involvement was invigorating for them and a setback for Republicans at time when they should be gearing up for a productive period ahead. However, too many Republicans are naive and shoot themselves in the foot too often with no plan for recovery.

McCarthy's ouster now is all about personal exposure for Matt Gaetz in his attempt to ascend the political ladder.
