



In 2005, my shelter graduate dog, Katey, was found to have congestive heart failure. She had had other significant health issues. Katey was 12 years old and had been brought to the shelter as an unwanted Christmas gift when she was only one.

For eleven years, that little brown, short-legged down had been my faithful companion. I was amazed that her heart failed her because it never failed me, not even for one second.

Mostly because of a change in pet policies where I lived, it took seven years for me to adopt again. Admittedly, though, Katey was an easy dog to share my life with and I grieved for her, thinking having any other dog would be difficult. She understood my words, was obedient, and seemed to automatically know how to behave.

On January 1, 2012, I took my new little shelter graduate, Wally, home. I told my mother that I would miss him knowing what I was saying like Katey did. Her answer should serve as a lesson for anyone who adopts an animal from a shelter. She said, "Just give him time. He will learn." And he did. He tragically died of cancer nine years later.

In January 2022, I adopted a four month old kitten, Danny. My wonderful cat, Becky, had died in October. Becky was the cat version of Katey. I applied Mother's advice to Danny.

They will need time to "decompress." You can help by providing them a quiet space that they know is safe.

If you have other pets, introducing them slowly is recommended. Most of the time, introducing new pets slowly by keeping the new one in a room and letting them sniff each other under the door is a

good way of introducing them.

Losing patience with any pet is never a good idea and the same is especially true if the pet is brand new in your home. The old-fashioned way of putting a puppy's nose in the urine or feces if they are not housebroken or swatting them with a newspaper (hard to believe that used to be accepted, but we still have people who believe in that method of housebreaking) will not teach them a thing about going outside to potty. Instead, it will teach them that their new home is a scary place.

The same is true if a pet is ever hit. They will not learn to come when called if they are struck when they obey. All they will learn is that it hurts to approach humans.

Patience is always required in helping a new animal adjust to your home. With time and kindness, your new companion will eventually become a treasured part of your family. As it turned out, Wally was just as intuitive a friend as Katey was. And Danny is my perfect cat companion. All it took was patience and time.

Playing Cards

Playing cards provide innocent amusement: a game with friends, a magic trick to entertain a child, a round of solitaire to pass some time alone. So what's a devil doing here?

This novelty pitcher made by Royal Bayreuth about 1930 has a body that looks like it's made of playing cards and has a smiling devil figure for a handle. It sold for \$250 at a Potter & Potter auction.

In the past, playing cards were seen as sinful, whether they were associated with gambling, divination or merely idle frivolity. (Do those friendly games, magic tricks or solitaire sessions sound less innocent now?)

In 1890, Mrs. John King Van Rensselaer published a book on the history of playing cards called "The Devil's Picture-Books," after a Puritan name for cards. According to one anecdote in the book, Columbus's sailors brought decks of cards with them on their voyage across the Atlantic Ocean, but threw them overboard out of superstitious fear during bad weather. After the ships landed safely, the crew made themselves new cards out of tree leaves. Later, even the Puritans approved of some card games if they had educational themes. Seeing playing cards as a sin doesn't eliminate their appeal. In some cases, it may even contribute.

Q: I have seen different types of maple furniture, like "bird's-eye maple," "tiger maple" and others. What are the differences? Do they come from different varieties of trees? Do they affect the value or quality of the furniture?

A: Maple is a strong, sturdy wood that is popular for furniture. Figured maple has naturally occurring variations in its grain pattern. The cause for these variations is not known, but environmental factors like climate, soil type, disease and injury to the tree may contribute. Bird's-eye maple and tiger maple are two types of these patterns. Others include spaltd and quilted maple. Tiger maple is also known as

curly maple. Figuring does not mean a lower quality wood; in fact, figured maple is especially desirable for decorative pieces like furniture, crafts and musical instruments. Since the 19th century, inexpensive woods and other materials have been painted to imitate grain patterns, and naturally patterned wood adds to the value of a piece.

TIP: Don't use the popular aluminum foil and baking soda system to clean antique silver. It leaves the silver with an undesirable tin-looking color.

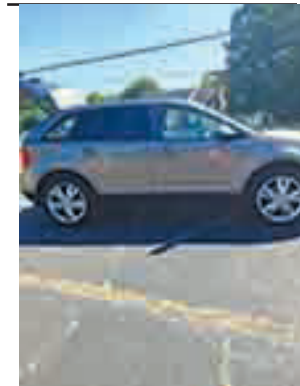

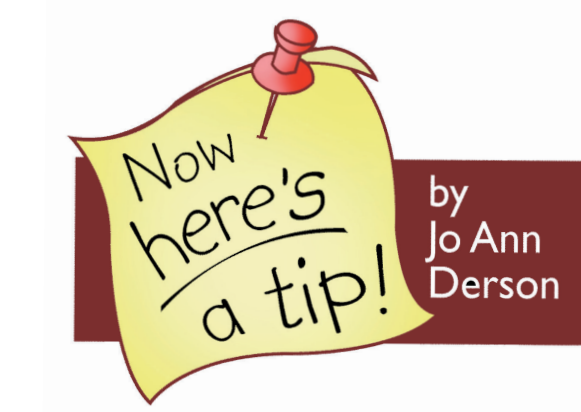

It's All in the Fine Print

This is certainly a new one. A famous (and expensive) university and a professor were caught not paying the Department of Veterans Affairs what was owed for patents, to the tune of \$1.5 million.

The professor in question worked at the university in various research positions, including as the Chair of one department. His list of titles and positions is quite impressive, not to mention his long list of honors and awards. In other words, the guy is no slouch. He's clearly bright and is working in an important medical field. At the same time he held a part-time position at the VA.

Both the professor and the university were under disclosure agreements, which meant that any discoveries or inventions the professor made at the university would be reported to the VA. While at the university, having created three inventions, the professor applied for three patents with the VA's part clearly noted.

Notified about the lapse, the professor refiled and the VA pounced, wanting to claim an ownership interest in the inventions ... and the royalties.

The Department of Justice got involved with the end result that the university and the professor have to pay \$1.5 million under the False Claims Act for failure to share the patent royalties.

I was prepared to hate the guy, truly. I found dozens of professional videos online wherein he talked about the research, and I was prepared to label him a swindler, a low-life, a thief. Instead, I'm left pointing the finger of blame at the university itself. They should have had someone to watch over the details and to handle paperwork matters such as correctly filing patents so the professor could keep doing his work.

Recipes

Breakfast Sausage Casserole



INGREDIENTS

- 1/2 cup butter, (1 stick)
- 1 (30-oz) package hash brown potatoes, (diced OR Shredded)
- salt and pepper
- 1 pound breakfast sausage, bulk
- 1/2 green pepper, chopped
- 1/2 red pepper, chopped
- 1/2 small onion, diced
- 1 & 1/2 cups shredded Monterey Jack cheese, packed
- 1 & 1/2 cups shredded sharp cheddar cheese, packed
- 8 large eggs
- 1 & 1/3 cups half and half, cream, evaporated milk, or whole milk*
- 1 teaspoon seasoned salt
- 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, 1/4 teaspoon if using table salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon dry mustard, optional

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat the oven to 400 degrees F. Make the potato layer. While it's heating up, add 1/2 cup butter to a 9x13 inch casserole dish. Place in the oven so that it melts. When the butter is melted, take it out and tilt the pan around so that the edges of the pan are greased. Add a 30 ounce package of frozen (diced or shredded is fine) hash browns. You don't have to thaw them first. Mix it together with the butter so everything is coated. Sprinkle with salt and pepper. Place the pan back in the oven and bake at 400 for 30-35 minutes, until the potatoes are mostly cooked and some are starting to lightly brown. Remove from the oven. Lower the oven temperature to 350.

Prepare the sausage layer. Meanwhile, chop up 1/2 a green pepper and 1/2 a red pepper. Chop half of a small onion (no more than 3/4 cup or less). Make sure all the veggies are chopped small. (If you want, you can skip all the vegetables entirely! No need to make any adjustments.)

Add 1 pound breakfast sausage (I used Jimmy Dean Regular, the bulk kind) and all the veggies to a skillet set over medium high heat. Break up the sausage and saute for 5-7 minutes, until the sausage is browned and the onion is getting soft. Drain the grease if there is any.

Add the cooked sausage mixture on top of the baked hash browns. You can spread it out so that it is a layer on top of the potatoes, or you can stir it in so everything is evenly distributed. (I like to stir.) Add cheese. Sprinkle 1 and 1/2 cups Monterey Jack and 1 and 1/2 cups cheddar cheese over the top. Make the egg mixture. In a large bowl or stand mixer (or you can use a blender!), use a whisk to stir together 8 eggs, 1 and 1/3 cups half and half,* 1 teaspoon seasoned salt, 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, 1/2 teaspoon pepper, and 1/4 teaspoon dry mustard. Pour the egg mixture over the casserole, making sure to distribute evenly. (See notes for overnight instructions!)

Bake at 350 (remember to lower the oven temperature) for about 35-45 minutes, until the edges are browned and bubbly, and the center doesn't jiggle a lot when you shake the pan. Take out of the oven and let set for 5 minutes before serving. Store leftovers in the fridge. They will keep for about 5 days.

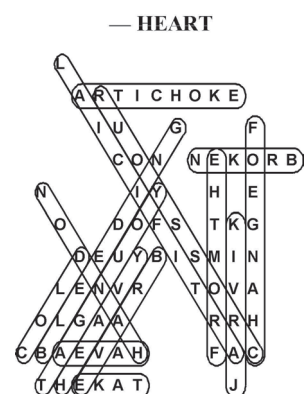
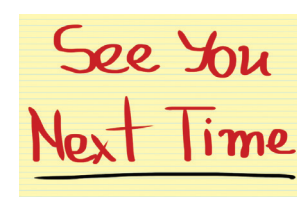

This recipe is great for freezing! I like to freeze individual portions of the baked casserole so that I can pop them out one at a time and microwave for a lovely mid morning breakfast of casserole champions.

Notes
Overnight Instructions:
After you pour the egg mixture over the casserole in step 11, cover the casserole tightly and refrigerate overnight. The next morning, get the casserole out of the fridge and let it hang out on the counter for a bit while you preheat the oven to 350. When the oven is nice and hot, bake at 350 for 40-45 minutes until the edges are browned and bubbly, and the center doesn't jiggle too much when you shake the pan. Let set for 5 minutes before serving.
