Overdose deaths on rise in 2023 in Orleans County for first time since 2018

Press Release, Orleans County government

ALBION - The Orleans County Probation Department and the Genesee and Orleans County Health Departments are working together to battle opioid overdoses.

GO Health will install overdose emergency kits, also called NaloxBoxes, in the Probation Department and Public Safety Building. These kits include naloxone and other opioid overdose response tools.

"At Probation, we have dealt with many people that are battling substance use disorder so this is an effort to be prepared in case of an emergency," said Sarah A. Osborne, Probation Director. "So many families across our community have been impacted by substance use disorder that any steps we can take to be better prepared are worth doing."

According to GO Health, in Orleans County, opioid-related deaths peaked in 2018 with 11 fatal opioid overdoses (27.0 per 100,000 population). Since 2019, there have been 26 fatal overdoses in Orleans County, with some deaths still pending review and investigations. The majority of opioid-related deaths were male, white individuals and people in their 20s and 30s.

"Unfortunately, 2023 will likely be the first year with an increasing number of opioid-related deaths since 2018." said Paul Pettit, Public Health Director for GO Health. "The fact is we have seen a decline in use of heroin and commonly prescribed opioids, but the rise of fentanyl in concurrence with stimulant drug use, especially cocaine, is now our biggest area of concern."

GO Health is encouraging businesses and other organizations to follow the lead of the Probation Department and consider installing overdose emergency kits.





Age is just a number!

Americans are living longer. Over the last four decades, life expectancy in the United States has largely risen, although certain groups have experienced slight decreases in their life expectancy (according to the U.S. Census Bureau). Americans are projected to have longer life expectancies in the coming decades. By 2060, life expectancy for the total population is projected to increase by about six years, from 79.7 in 2017 to 85.6 in 2060.

Since we are living longer, the question is how do we live a healthier life? How can we age gracefully? As a primary care physician, I often discuss this topic with my patients. Here are a few tips for you to consider.

Have a good relationship with your primary care provider (PCP)

This is a simple yet important step to take to live a healthy life. To have a good relationship with your provider, you need to see a medical professional annually, get a physical, and have open, frank discussions. If your primary care provider suggests medical advice that you do not want to do or you don't see any utility in doing so, don't just ignore it. Instead, have a conversation about why it is important and try to reach a compromise.

Waiting too long before going to see your primary care provider is not good practice. If you have not been feeling well for a period of time or something has changed, please make an appointment with your primary care provider. Be careful not to seek medical information on the internet. Please reach out to your medical providers for the best advice.

Preventive measures: medications and screenings

As you age, you may be prescribed many different medications and it's important that you understand why you are taking each and what the long-term benefit is. Have you been taking medications for 20+ years? It may be time to have a conversation with your physician about whether it is still having a positive effect on your health.

Screenings such as a colonoscopy are especially important but so is getting a yearly physical. At your physical, discuss with your PCP which screenings are appropriate for you. Be sure they know your family's cancer history.

Nutrition and Sleep

Getting a good night's sleep is a key component to staying healthy so practice good sleep hygiene. There are things that may interfere with your ability to fall asleep and stay asleep. Think about screen time including TV, computers, and your telephone. If watching certain programming upsets you,



please avoid it. Consider turning all your screens off two to three hours before sleep time. If you need entertainment, an enjoyable book or magazine will help relax you. Sleep in a cool dark room with no stimulation on and avoid drinking a lot before you sleep. Also, the timing of your medication is important. Again, be sure to discuss this with your PCP.

Of course, the food you put into your body is another way to age gracefully. Eating real food and not processed food is the key to healthy living. Processed food can have a lot of salt or ingredients that contain salt, and that is not good for you. Everyone needs a little sodium in their diet but avoiding fast foods is a good idea. Eating well also includes drinking well. Be careful not to drink empty calories in soft drinks and flavored coffees. Coffee can be fine, but most creamers do not contain natural ingredients.

I know many people think of cooking as a chore, but mealtimes can be a pleasant way to nurture your body. Spend time thinking about what healthy foods you can cook quickly or consider "batch cooking" where you make three or four meals and freeze them. If you have healthy foods in the house, you are more likely to eat healthily.

Also, the Mediterranean diet is one of the healthiest choices because it emphasizes seafood, fresh fruit and vegetables, plants, and whole grains.

Exercise

I want to close on an important thought about aging. Be sure to exercise. Walking is one of the best exercises but please be sure you are doing it in a safe location. Be careful not to trip or fall. In the winter, the mall, community centers, and schools are better places to go. They are warm and safe.

Good morning! Grab your favorite cup. Fill it up. And let's start this week right... TOGETHER!!!

This past Easter I shared about a trip to The Holy Land that I and a few of my fellow Orleans County pastors had the privilege of making back in 2017. In that article I highlighted a lot of the significant spiritual aspects of our trip but now, in light of recent events, I would like to share about some other people and places I learned about while in Israel.



Major Elliot Chodof is a political and military analyst who literally wrote the handbook for the IDF (Israel Defense Forces) and gave us a tour along the Golan Heights where the 6 Day War of 1967 took place. It was an interesting excursion because even as he shared about the past he made us aware of everything going on in the present. We had to walk cautiously down a



narrow pathway because there will still live mines embedded in the ground left by the Arab armies, we visited an IDF base which had live tanks, and the photos pictured are from the Syrian border by Lebanon alongside the road to Damascus in front of Mount Hermon. For forty miles along this border there are 60 separate terrorist groups which we were told had weapons aimed at us. It made us realize how much we as Americans often think of our enemies as "somewhere far away" while Israel only needs to glance across any of their borders. Unfortunately, the recent attacks from Hamas only serve to highlight this reality.



Another person of interest, whom I had actually met the year prior at a CUFI (Christians United for Israel) Conference in Washington D.C., was Father Gabriel Naddaf. When visiting Nazareth we were told to make sure the location was turned off on our phones so that we could meet Father Gabriel. He had been in hiding because Arab Members of Knesset had placed such a large bounty on him and not long before had kidnapped his teenage son and best him near death. The reason why is because in Israel every Jewish born man and woman must serve time in the IDF but Arab Christians are not obligated. Father Gabriel had led a campaign that caused the number of Christians who voluntarily enlisted to triple which greatly strengthened Israel's defense efforts.

We met others in similar situations as well including a famous Palestinian news correspondent Khaled Abu Toameh who had his life threatened repeatedly after refusing to report false propaganda and Pastor Steve Khoury whose church in Bethlehem has been bombed and set on fire over 40 times because of his refusal to stop teaching out of the Old Testament which had been banned in that area. There were several other people and several other stories but I will share just one more.

The man on the left was our tour guide Yoav Rotem and the older man on the right was his father. One evening after dinner Yoav shared that only recently his father had opened



up about his time hiding from the Nazi's during the Holocaust and that he was willing to share his story with us. Though they were smiling in this photo there were plenty of sad, serious, and scary moments over the next hour as he recalled not only what happened to him and others but also what was going through his mind at the time. It was hard to hear but we listened intently as he made himself vulnerable in order to help us to better understand.

NOTICE OF BRIEF SYNOPSIS OF DETERMINATION AND FINDINGS OF STAMP SEWER WORKS, INC. PURSUANT TO NEW YORK EMINENT DOMAIN PROCEDURE LAW § 204 FOR THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF SHELBY, ORLEANS COUNTY, NEW YORK, AND TOWN OF ALABAMA, GENESEE COUNTY, NEW YORK BY THE EXERCISE OF EMINENT DOMAIN

Pursuant to the New York Transportation Corporations Law (the "TCL"), STAMP Sewer Works, Inc. (the "Corporation") seeks to exercise its powers of eminent domain to acquire:

Three temporary construction easements, over certain parcels of real property, together with the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereto, (the "Acquisition") one of which is situated within the Town of Alabama, County of Genesee, New York and two of which are situated within the Town of Shelby, County of Orleans, New York, respectively, and all of which are adjacent to New York State Route 63, and which are more specifically described as SBL Nos. 6.-129 (Genesee County) and 90.16-2-26 (Orleans County) and 90.16-2-23.1 (Orleans County) (collectively, the "Properties"), for the purpose of: (a) constructing, installing, laying, maintaining, inspecting, operating, extending, replacing, repairing, servicing, upgrading, modifying, and/ or removing a pipe/conduit, commonly called a "force main," and other equipment and appurtenances over, through, across, above, and under the easements, together with the right of unimpaired access to said forced main and equipment, and the right of ingress and egress on, over, and through the Properties, for any and all purposes necessary and incident to the exercise of all rights thereunder, which shall ultimately facilitate the sanitary disposal of treated sanitary wastewater and treated process wastewater in accordance with all local, state, and federal requirements through an established system of pipe lines, treatment plants and other means of disposal, pursuant to Sections 115 and 122 of the Transportation Corporations Act, and which shall service the Western New York Science and Technology Advanced Manufacturing Park ("STAMP") located in the Town of Alabama, County of Genesee, New York; (b) providing critical infrastructure to STAMP, which is a 1,250-acre mega site designed to power advanced manufacturing in upstate New York; and (c) ensuring that STAMP is equipped with an adequate sewage disposal system, thereby facilitating the creation of jobs and economic revenue at STAMP (together, the "Project"). The record owners of the Properties include David F. Schloss and Allison H. Adkison, Donald C. Quackenbush and Dana M. Quackenbush, and Brennen O'Connor and Valerie O'Connor.

A. PUBLIC PROCESS

On July 27, 2023, at 10:00 o'clock in the morning, the Corporation held the duly noticed public hearing at the Town of Alabama Volunteer Fire Department, located at 2230 Judge Road, Oakfield, New York 14125, also commonly known as 2230 Judge Road, Basom, New York 14013 (the "Hearing Room"), in accordance with Article 2 of the EDPL (the "Public Hearing"). At the Public Hearing, the public was informed about the Acquisition, the public uses to be served, and the general effect upon the environment and residents. Testimony and exhibits received at the hearing, and written comments received prior to August 1, 2023, at 5:00 p.m., were reviewed, made a part of the record of the Public Hearing (the "Public Hearing Record"), and accorded full consideration.

access to the Properties in order to stage and place directional drilling equipment temporarily during construction of the Force Main. The Acquisition will serve a public use, benefit, or purpose in allowing for the completion of the Force Main, and providing a means of disposal for treated, sanitary wastewater produced at the STAMP Site. The Force Main will directly result in many public uses, benefits, and purposes, including facilitating the discharge of treated sanitary wastewater and treated process wastewater from the STAMP Site. Other public uses, benefits, and purposes associated with the Force Main include, inter alia: (a) Capacity to handle six (6) million gallons of treated wastewater per day, allowing for the full realization of manufacturing capacity at the STAMP Site; (b) Facilitating the best and most practical discharge of wastewater for the STAMP Site, including appropriate management of discharge water levels and flow; (c) Allowing for the most practical lifespan of the wastewater system, with minor maintenance and repairs as necessary; (d) Providing tenants of the STAMP Site full wastewater capacity for other non-manufacturing related water usage, including, inter alia, employee related water usage; and, (e) Allowing for the less intrusive, and most practical, water discharge route. Without the Acquisition, construction of the Force Main and the realization of its attendant public uses, benefits, and purposes would be jeopardized.

Furthermore, the Acquisition and the Force Main is essential to the full realization of the STAMP Project, which will create an advanced manufacturing technology hub in Genesee County and will attract large-scale, advanced manufacturing companies to the region. The STAMP Project has many public uses, benefits, and purposes. Upon full completion, the STAMP Project is projected to result in approximately 9,330 full-time equivalent jobs, with approximately \$531.9 million in direct annual wages and approximately \$761.3 million in indirect wages. The STAMP Project is expected to result in approximately 1,400 to 2,900 direct and indirect full-time equivalent jobs during the construction phase, with total earnings ranging from \$40.8 million to \$83.8 million. The economic output from the STAMP Project is projected to equal approximately \$4.6 billion, upon completion and full operation. Upon completion, the STAMP Project is expected to result in annual state income taxes of approximately \$33.6 million. Retail operations from the STAMP Project are expected to generate \$2.3 million in annual sales taxes for both Genesee County and the State of New York.

The Acquisition is essential to the construction and installation of the Force Main and completion of the STAMP Project as a whole. As such, the Corporation finds and determines that the Acquisition will result in the many public uses, benefits, and purposes associated with the Force Main. Furthermore, the Corporation finds and determines that the Acquisition is necessary to the development of the STAMP Project, and will allow for the full realization of the many public uses, benefits, and purposes of the STAMP Project detailed above. Absent the Acquisition, the Force Main and the STAMP Project, and the attendant public uses, benefits, and purposes associated with both, would be jeopardized.

III. General Effect of Acquisition on Environment and Residents of Locality

The Corporation finds and determines that, based upon the testimony and evidence entered into the Public Hearing Record, the Acquisition is consistent with social, economic and other essential considerations from among the reasonable alternatives available, and is one that avoids or minimizes adverse environmental impacts to the maximum extent practicable (by incorporating as conditions to the decision those mitigative measures that were identified as practicable).

Accordingly, the Corporation has adopted and issued a Findings Statement pursuant to SEQRA.

Other Relevant Factors

IV.

All of the testimony and evidence entered into the Public Hearing Record has been given due consideration. In particular, but without limitation, the Corporation has considered the objections submitted by Orleans County, submitted through their attorney Lippes Mathias LLP, both in person at the Public Hearing and by letter dated July 27, 2023 (the "Orleans County letter"). The Corporation has also considered the objections submitted by the Orleans County Industrial Development Agency (the "OEDA", together with Orleans County, the "Orleans County Opponents"), submitted through their Chief Executive Officer Michael Dobell, both in person at the hearing and by letter dated July 27, 2023 (the "OEDA letter"). A number of the objections raised by the Orleans County Opponents were based on factual allegations that were unsupported by the Public Hearing Record as reviewed and considered by the Corporation (including the testimony and exhibits submitted into the Public Hearing Record). The Orleans County Opponents also assert objections based on legal arguments, all of which have been reviewed and considered by the Corporation and have been found to lack merit. The Public Hearing Record is clear that there is no prior public use which would frustrate or otherwise prevent the Acquisition. Therefore, upon review of the Public Hearing Record and applicable law, the Corporation finds and determines that the objections submitted by the Orleans County Opponents are wholly without merit and neither those objections, nor any of the other testimony, evidence, and written comments submitted in any way preclude the Acquisition of the Properties by the Corporation or otherwise prevent the Corporation from issuing its Determination and Findings relative to the same.

C. DETERMINATION

Based on due consideration, it is found necessary for the Corporation to acquire temporary construction easements on the Properties, and it is determined that the Corporation should exercise its power of eminent domain in order to implement the Acquisition.


B. BRIEF SYNOPSIS

I. Public Use, Benefit, and Purpose

The Acquisition will serve many public uses, benefits, and purposes. The project involves the development of Western New York Science and Technology Advanced Manufacturing Park ("STAMP" or the "STAMP Project"), an advanced manufacturing technology campus on approximately 1,262 acres in the Town of Alabama, New York (the "STAMP Site"), which is projected to attract large-scale advanced manufacturers and computer chip manufacturers to the region. The STAMP Project requires the construction of a force main to facilitate the sanitary disposal of treated wastewater from the STAMP Site to the discharge point in Oak Orchard Creek in the Town of Shelby (the "Force Main"). Specifically, the Acquisition is required for temporary The testimony and evidence entered into the Public Hearing Record also demonstrated, among other things, that: (a) the location of the Acquisition is necessary to the development of the Force Main and the STAMP Project as a whole; (b) the Acquisition's location, size, and geographic and environmental features make it particularly well suited for the location for the Force Main; (c) the location of the Force Main allows for the provision of needed services necessary for an advanced manufacturing technology campus within the region; and, (d) other alternative locations for both the STAMP Project and the Force Main were reviewed and considered, and were all deemed to be unsuitable or otherwise unacceptable.

After considering the testimony and evidence entered into the Public Hearing Record, and specifically considering that alternative locations are extremely limited, all other alternative locations considered were deemed unsuitable or otherwise unacceptable. As such, the Corporation finds and determines that location of the Acquisition is essential for the full realization of the public uses, benefits, and purposes associated with the Force Main and the STAMP Project as a whole.


