





Minko, which translates Bench Chief. He born in 1759 in the Chickasaw Nation later and was an important leader of the Chickasaws. He and his brother, George Colbert, were avid negotiators and interpreters. bilingual leaders, they were trusted by their people and the American government. Levi spent much of his time working with Andrew Jackson's appointed negotiators regarding the Treaty of Pontotoc and the Indian Removal Act. He died at the age of 74 before most negotiations were completed. Today, Levi's legacy lives on with his family name, Colbert, representing towns and locations in the states of Alabama and Mississippi.







Our Missing Birth Centers

Letter to the editor:

According to a recent March of Dimes study, almost 70% of our Alabama population is living in areas without a hospital or birth center. On top of this scarcity of care, Alabama has the third highest rate of maternal mortality and the fifth highest rate of infant mortality in the country. State officials should be doing everything in their power to fix this.

Last Alabama Department Public Health (ADPH) (ADPH) resurrected antiquated regulations from 1985 to control who is able to provide care at freestanding birth centers in the state. Without inviting anv midwives the table, a group of hospital-connected,non-obstetric nurses, physicians non-OB and non-midwifery professionals amended the proposed birth center regulations to their own interpretations. These regulations are not in

line with any current standard of pregnancy and birth care in North America.

In Alabama, the ADPH's regulations were historically rooted in racism and oppression. Black women in particular have a disproportionately higher rate of birth complications and maternal mortality. Alabama has an opportunity right now

to expand culturally competent care in the attempt to save more lives

TECHNOLOGICAL SINGULARITY

requires that I revisit this subject. I'll write a sequel to this one next time.

I hope both my readers will excuse the diversion from technical stuff to explore this fascinating and potentially life-changing event that may not ever happen but is fun, scary, and mind-boggling to ponder. The event is called the Technological Singularity.

A SHORT HISTÖRY: Back in 1965, Gordon E. Moore, the founder of Intel Corporation, predicted that computer processing power would double every two years. This statement became known as "Moore's

Law." This law has been mostly accurate for about 60 years.

During the same year that Moore made his prediction, a famed statistician named Jack Good stated, "Let an ultra-intelligent machine be defined as a machine that can far surpass all the intellectual activities of any man however clever." He goes on to say that "an ultra-intelligent machine could design even better machines; there would then unquestionably be an 'intelligence explosion,' and the intelligence of man would be left far behind. Thus, the first ultra-intelligent machine is the

last invention that man need ever make."

In 1983, in a magazine called "Omni," a professor of mathematics and famed science fiction author Vernor Vinge, predicted, "Within thirty years, we will have the technological means to create superhuman intelligence. Shortly thereafter, the human era will be ended." He called this event Technological Singularity.

In the early part of this century, my hero Ray Kurzweil, popularized the Singularity via speaking engagements, books, and even a movie starring Johnny Depp. Years later. Kurzweil is sticking to his guns and predicts that the Singularity will happen no earlier than 2030, but no later than 2050. He claims that "the dawning of a new civilization that will enable us to transcend our biological limitations and amplify our creativity.'

There are some respected thinkers who reject the entire notion of a Singularity and those who accept it as inevitable. There are those who think it is a good thing and those that think it will be bad. There are those who are already developing safeguards against it and those who are working to bring it on. I remain skeptical, excited, and a bit concerned about a computer developing consciousness, but excited to live on the verge of the possibility.



My friend's wife was jerked out of a car and beat with a weapon. What can she do about that?

The Friend.

A lot actually, but some of it is disappointing. As a legal issue, it is interesting because it has both a criminal aspect and a civil aspect which require different levels of proof. Everyone remembers the OJ Simpson case where the prosecution failed to convince a jury beyond a reasonable doubt in the criminal case. However, the next jury quickly found that more likely than not he committed murder and found him liable for 33.5 Million Dollars in damages.

The first step in this type of case is a criminal prosecution. There's a reason for that and it has to do

with the burdens of proof. The criminal burden of proof is "beyond a reason doubt" (think jail) and the civil burden is "more likely than not" or "probably" (think money).

The British definition of assault is straight forward. The first is common assault where if another person inflicts violence, however slight or makes another person think they are about to be attacked, they are guilty of simple assault. A raised fist could lead the victim to believe they are going to be attacked and that could be enough to be guilty. The next level is actual bodily harm (ABH) and the third is grievous bodily harm (GBH). In the United States we would think of a stick or a pipe as being an assault with a deadly weapon. Each class carries ever more severe criminal penalties by statute.

The civil side of assault is the idea that if you cause harm to someone you are financially responsible for the harm you cause. This would include medical bills, pain and suffering, so on and so forth. A jury would award damages based on the facts of the case and the severity of the injuries. Juries are pretty practical, and I would think that if two grown men started to fight voluntarily and one lost and the fight stopped, the jury wouldn't get particularly excited. However, if after the winner saw the other was down, he began kicking him unmercifully, a jury would see that differently. I would think that if a large man decided to beat up a small woman jury would not take kindly to that.

The reality is that people who can write big checks avoid doing things like intentionally harming other people. Two further concepts are worth consideration. No insurance applies for an intentional act. Second, monetary awards for intentional acts are typically not dischargeable in bankruptcy.

An example of coinsurance would be the percentage you pay for durable medical equipment.

EVENTUALLY. YOU BECOME SELF-INSURED

Dear Dave.

My wife and I are both 36 years old, and we have two children. Our son is six, and our daughter will be four next month. We've been walking through the Baby Steps, and we should have our home paid off sometime next summer. We realized the other day the one thing missing from our financial picture is life insurance. We both work outside the home. She makes \$60,000 a year, while I make \$80,000 a year. At our age, and in our current situation, do you think we should we get



20-vear or 30-vear level term life insurance policies? Clav

Dear Clay,

You guys are doing a great job of getting control of your finances and planning for the future. Speaking of the future, do you plan on having more kids? If you do, you might want to go with 30-year policies. If you've decided two are enough, then based on your present situation I think 20-year policies would work out fine.

I recommend folks have 10 to 12 times their annual income in life insurance

coverage. That means you'd need between \$800,000 and \$960,000 in coverage, while your wife needs a policy in the \$600,000 to \$720,000 range. But let's take a deeper dive into all this.

Your kids will be in their mid-twenties in 20 years. Ideally, they both should have finished college by that time, or at the very least, be working and living on their own. If you continue to follow my plan, you and your wife will have paid off your home in a few months and be completely debtfree. And, you'll have been saving 15% of your income for retirement over those 20 years. On average, that alone should give you more than a half-million dollars for retirement.

Do you see where I'm going with this, Clay? Eventually, you two will become selfinsured by getting out of debt, staying out of debt and piling up cash. So, if you've got \$500,000 or more in a retirement fund, no debt and your children are grown and out of the house, even if you or your wife were to die unexpectedly at that point, the other would still be taken care of and in great shape financially.

Keep up the good work!
