2023 POLICIES

As approved at the meeting: Berks County Farm Bureau September 29, 2023

- 1. We recommend legislation to make it the hunter's responsibility to have permission to hunt, not the farmer's responsibility to post his land.
- 2. We recommend there be third party testing of biosolids and limits to number of successive applications that are allowed.
- 3. We recommend repealing the protections on the "Black Vulture" which allegedly feed on live animals.
- 4. We recommend schools be required to offer curriculum on personal finances.
- 5. We recommend all fluid milk options including whole milk and flavored milk, not be included in the Federally mandated school meals diet calorie count calculation, but be served additionally as a wholesome nutritional beverage.
