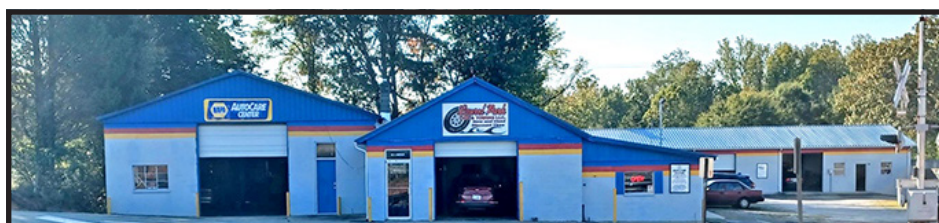



This past Saturday, we awarded the William Schwarz Animal Hero of the Year Award to retired police officer Jerry Riggins for his work in helping free dogs from chains.

Shortly after I began employment with the Danville Area Humane Society, the police received a call from a citizen who said that for several days he had heard a dog whining and yelping in the woods behind his house. He became concerned when the noise stopped. At that time, two Danville police officers functioned as animal control officers and Officer Jerry Riggins was dispatched to the address. He found the body of a dog whose chain had become wrapped around some bushes. As Jerry brought the body into the shelter, he turned to me and said, "You have to find some way to get dogs off chains." That was the first time of many that he would tell me that.

At the same time he served the Danville Police Department as an animal control officer, he also served as a canine officer handler. In that capacity, he helped train canine officers throughout the Commonwealth.

After I became a court-appointed humane investigator in Danville and Pittsylvania County, Jerry accompanied me on many neglect complaints in the City. He probably became exasperated with me at times, but we remained friends!

In 2010, Jerry's plea to "get dogs off chains" became a reality and Danville's anti-tethering ordinance became one of the few in Virginia. It was used as a positive example in the General Assembly. We remain grateful to City Council and all the members of the public who worked to make Danville's ordinance one of the strongest in the state.

Jerry served in the military, in the Danville Police Department, as a civilian contractor in Iraq, and most recently as a school resource officer in Pittsylvania County.

Jerry is a true hero, as proven by his career choices. He is also kindhearted and compassionate. Thanks to his words, thousands of dogs in Danville will never know the horrors of being chained.

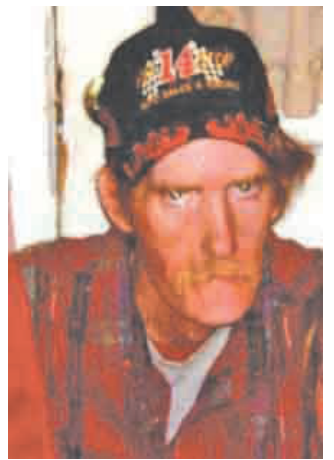

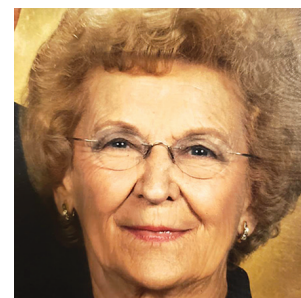

Recipes

Dollywood Cinnamon Bread



Ingredients

- 1 one-pound loaf of frozen bread dough, thawed
- 1/2 c. sugar
- 1 1/2 T. cinnamon
- 4 T. butter, melted
- 1 c. powdered sugar (for glaze)
- 1 T. lemon juice (for glaze)

Directions

Grease two loaf pans with oil or butter. Combine cinnamon and sugar in a wide, shallow dish. Set aside. Cut the bread dough lengthwise into two pieces. In each piece, make four deep slits crosswise, taking care not to cut the bread through. Brush the loaves with butter, then roll each one in the cinnamon sugar. Using your hands, pack the leftover cinnamon sugar into the creases of the bread. Place the loaves in the pans and set aside in a warm place to rise for 30 minutes. Preheat the oven to 300° F. Bake for 35 minutes, rotating the pan once. While bread is baking, make the glaze by stirring the powdered sugar and lemon juice together until smooth. Turn bread onto a cooling rack. While they're still warm, drizzle with the glaze.

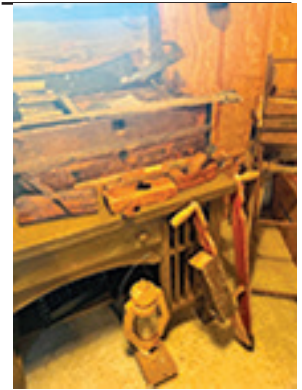

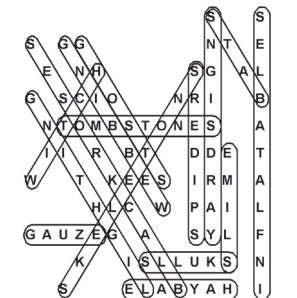
