Timberline Inn: New Owner Builds on 84-Year Legacy

Dan Para wasn't looking to buy a restaurant. Para is a successful Chicagobased financial adviser and merger/acquisition specialist who has a home in Marco Island, Florida and has spent summers since the 70s in Sister Lakes.

And that's how the story begins that made Dan Para the proud new owner of the Timberline Inn at Indian Lake, just North of M-62 between Eau Claire and Dowagiac.

The Timberline is one of the region's oldest fine-dining restaurants, with 84 years under its belt. Para did some research and found that Timberline opened about 30 days after Emil Tosi founded the little resort that's now Tosi's Restaurant in Stevensville. However, in recent years you may not have heard much about Timberline, as it quietly served mostly the several thousand 'summer families' within a few miles of Sister Lakes.

Para says he and his wife usually had dinner at Timberline about once a week, Friday, or Saturday, during their summers in Michigan. Last year, he learned from Executive Chef and 33-year owner Ed Kanwischer that Ed and wife Pattie wanted to sell Timberline and retire.

Fast forward a year... there were NO takers. The place appeared headed for the auction block, much to the disappointment of Para and many other regular customers of Timberline, who feared they'd lose their favorite 'neighborhood supper club'. The speculation was that someone would buy it, then shut it down and transfer the liquor license.

"Someone needed to step up," says Dan. That someone turned out to be him!

No stranger to putting mutually beneficial business deals together, Para worked things out with the Kanwischer's and took over Timberline on October 16th. Dan says the staff, friends, and many customers turned

For educators, the program offers valuable resources, including a teacher guide, to introduce the opportunity to their students. A wide variety of resources are available for interested parties. teachers, and organizations to join us for the competition.

Participants in the National Civics Bee will have the chance to gain recognition for their civics knowledge and skills, and compete for prestigious prizes, including a \$1,000 cash prize for the state champion. The competition enables students to explore issues that matter to their communities, furthering their understanding of civic engagement and fostering responsible citizenship.

This year, the National Civics Bee is expanding its reach to students in 28 states, with plans for a national competition scheduled for 2024. A three-year, \$4.5 million grant from the Daniels Fund will allow the U.S. Chamber Foundation to scale these Bees to all 50 states by 2026.

It's a Gift to Your Family

Dear Dave.

I'm 67, and I've been wondering what your position is on preplanning for a funeral versus prepaying. Is one a better idea than the other, or should you do both? Shannon

Dear Shannon,

This is a great question. I wish more folks would think about these kinds of things ahead of time.

Preplanning a funeral is truly a gift to your family. But if you prepay, it's a gift to the funeral home. Doing the legwork and setting things up ahead of time so your family doesn't have to make a lot of financial decisions in the middle of an emotional situation shows them respect and consideration.

When you buy a prepaid plan, you could be years or decades away from needing it. Plus the inflation rate on funerals is about 4%, so in essence, you'd be making 4% on your money. And, of course, you're locked into everything at that point. If you

took the cost of a funeral and invested it at age 30, instead of 4% on your money, you'd get an actual investment return. By the time you're 80, you'd have about \$600,000. So prepaying in your 30s or 40s is mathematically ridiculous. Now, if you're in your 60s, like you and me, there aren't as many years for that money to grow. You wouldn't see a huge return on investment, but it would still provide for a nice service.

Believe it or not, it took me a while to figure out that the funeral world is an industry-an extremely profitable industry. And like with many things, when you add on stuff like financing or prepayment to a purchase, you're adding to their profits. Most funeral providers make as much money on prepayment plans as they do in actual margin on the goods and services that go along with this kind of thing.

That being said, I've got no problem with a business or industry making money. If they treat their customers well, no one's taken advantage of, and a quality product or service is provided, it's all good. But when it comes to funerals, I tell people to preplan. Don't prepay.



out for a huge 'Going Away Party' for Ed and Pattie. Now he looks to the future of Timberline Inn

The best news, Para says, is that the Timberline staff is 'on board'. His 20 employees, headed by newly appointed Executive Chef Matt Lowe are excited about the future. Eight staffers are younger-under 35-however three servers have been with Timberline for over 30 years each. It's that heritage that Para feels is the 'secret sauce' that keeps so many regular customers coming back to

www.MailMaxOnline.com Timberline-and he hopes it will ring true with new customers from a wider radius in Michigan's Great Southwest.

Para acknowledges the restaurant hasn't been promoted in recent years. But he's confident that once people all over Berrien, Cass and Van Buren counties realize Timberline is open and offering the same great menu it has for decades that he'll be seeing some new faces as he greets customers as the new owner.

Timberline is not somewhere you will go for a snack or a sandwich. Its menu shouts 'fine dining' and its atmosphere screams 'sup-







per club.' If you're a fan of restaurants that give you a trip back to the 70s or 80s dining experience, Timberline should be on your list.

For example, the first thing you'll notice when you walk in is the white tablecloths. They are disappearing in most places. At Timberline, they just got a brand-new shipment! Para says by the spring, he will also replace all the glassware and tableware in the house. Not because there's anything wrong with them, but because he wants his guests to have the best dining experience while maintaining the unique 'supper club' atmosphere that helps set Timberline apart.

Para points out that most of the major items on the Timberline menu are specialty recipes that have been developed in house and passed down over the 84-year run. Special coatings and batters for chicken, walleye and perch dinners would be examples. The first item on the seafood menu is Baked Shrimp De Jonghe, a house specialty along with Coconut Shrimp. Lobster and scallops are also featured items at Timberline.

Para has assured regular customers that their favorite items will stay on the menu. "We'll add some things and have some specials, but we won't screw it up," he says with a smile. Specifically, he mentioned occasionally adding Prime Rib nights. He also plans to add a patio tent outside the bar next summer as the bar area is small. A private dining area is available next to the bar for up to 24 guests. The entire restaurant may be reserved for large private events.



The Housing Market in Southwestern Michigan

This September, the SWMI housing sales level continued to stay below the sales level in September for the last ten years. September was the ninth consecutive month for sales to fall behind in the same month of 2022. Selling prices set records for reaching the highest price in September, comparing back to beyond the peak years to 2006.

es for sale fell 7 percent below the level available a year ago (830 vs. 895). With the lower sales volume, the months-supply level increased slightly to 5.0 from 4.1-months supply from a year ago for homebuyers. For comparison, in September 2010, there were 3574 houses for sale for a 17.3-months supply of houses.

restrain sales. The Freddie Mac mortgage rate in September was 7.30, up from 7.18 in August for a 30-year conventional mortgage. In September 2022, the rate was 6.7; in September 2021, the rate was 3.01.

percent from August 2023 (259 vs. 315). This September, house sales crashed 24 percent from September 2022 (259 vs. 339).

Year-to-date, 2119 houses sold in September, compared to 2524 houses in September 2022, for a 16 percent decline in sales.

The average selling price in September 2023 increased 7 percent to \$365,279 compared to \$340,600 in September 2022. Year-to-date, in September 2023, the average selling price rose 6 percent to \$357,233 from \$336,150 in September 2022.

The median selling price in September 2023 at \$282,950 rose 12 percent from \$252,000 in September 2022. The median selling price, year-to-date, increased by nearly \$15,000 (\$259,450 vs. \$245,000).

The median price is the price at which 50% of the homes sold were above that price and 50% were below.

The total dollar volume in September 2023 dropped 18 percent compared to September 2022 (\$94,454,730 vs. \$115,463,412). The year-to-date total dollar volume fell 11 percent (\$756,720,984 vs. \$848,468,979).

The number of bank-owned or foreclosed homes as a percentage of all transactions stayed at 3 percent, the same as in August. It was at 0 percent in September 2022. The highest percentage in September previously was 37 percent in 2009.
