During this Thanksgiving month, I'd like to share stories of lessons learned from animals. I am grateful to them.

Buddy is our Umbrella cockatoo who is probably approaching his 30th year on earth. We "won" him in an auction that took place when a large bird breeding facility in Greensboro went out of business. Buddy was not on our list of birds we want to bid on, but we are certainly glad we decided at the last minute to place the bid!

Buddy is probably the most well-known bird in this area. He helps generate interest for us on our social media pages. (Check us out at Danville Area Humane Society Virginia!)

He has a huge personality and does not mind using it to charm shelter visitors. He lives life with zest, to be sure.

Buddy's first rule of life is a lesson that would serve humans well: Say hello to everyone.

It is hard for anyone to sneak into the front lobby because on most days, Buddy will say a quiet "hello." If they don't respond, he will say it a little bit louder. If he is still ignored, he will say it loudly. At that point, he just gives up if he gets no response. Buddy does not care about your gender, ethnicity, age,

Empire Style

Antique collectors know that styles repeat, pieces can be replicated and design periods can be revived. This stool was made in the 20th century, but its style is from the Empire period, which lasted from about 1815 to 1840 in America.

Empire style originated with the French Empire in the early 1800s and was inspired by antiquities. Napoleon Bonaparte led an invasion of Egypt in 1798. Although his troops were defeated, a scientific expedition began. Napoleon sent scholars back to Egypt to study monuments and antiquities. This was the beginning of archaeology, inspiring a fashion for antiquity.

Decorative arts in the Empire style featured designs from ancient Egyptian, Greek and Roman art and architecture. The influence of ancient art is clearly seen in this Empire-style stool, which sold for \$1,250 at New Orleans Auction Galleries. It is an example of Empire style, even if it is not from the Empire period. The winged animal's head supports, paw feet, gilt rosettes and Greek key trim are all borrowed from the ancient world, but the materials, construction and maker's label identify it as modern.

Q:My parents gave away all my toys when I went to college. One toy that I can't forget about was a Fisher-Price Tick Tock clock. I finally found one recently in an antiques mall. I paid \$8 for it, even though the music mechanism sounds damaged. Is this a good price?

A Sorry about your parents throwing your toys out. I hear that a lot from collectors wanting some of their childhood back, even if it is through items from antiques stores. Your Fisher-Price Tick Tock Teaching Clock was very popular, introduced in the early 1960s. The most popular models, with slight visual differences, came out in 1962 and 1964. It is colorful, with stickers and a clock face

with big numbers and arms. Images of night and day are revealed as the arms move. When wound up, it plays the song "Grandfather's Clock" and has a background metronome ticking sound. You got a bargain! Most of those clocks sell online for up to \$60, depending on condition. They are still being made and sold.



Project Imagine honors its largest class yet at ceremony

Project Imagine, a community violence intervention collaborative to steer youths away from gang activity, last week honored 12 teenagers – its largest class yet – for completing life skills training and goal-setting exercises. Graduating were Carlos Brooks, Javion Chriscoe,



Malia Goods, Justice Gunter, De'shanique Johnson, Jacob Luck, Zakareyea Miller, Treyvan Nickens, Tyron Pounds, Autumn Sanders, Robert Tatum, and Tymeek Torain, Robert David, violence prevention manager for Project Imagine, commended the graduates for making the decision to change the direction of their lives. "You took the opportunity to say, 'You know what, I might have made some mistakes (in my life), but this is the last day. I am going to move forward. And do some great things," David said. "That is why we want to celebrate with you because we understand what it took for you to get to this point. We have much respect for you." Curtis Artis, assistant violence prevention manager, added, "Today is another great day because we have young people making a change in their lives. I want to thank all the young men and young women for trusting in Project Imagine to help you reach your goals. I see a bright future for this group here. The majority of you have been through some trying times." The program steers youths away from gang activity by developing and maintaining relationships with mentors, and by focusing on goals such as having no contact with law enforcement, improving their grades, completing school, and becoming employed. As part of the program, the youths receive strength-based assessments using the Casey Life Skills and Clifton Strengths tools. These tools are used to place youths on a path toward developing healthy, productive lives.

Also, a Project Imagine outreach worker is assigned to mentor each youth for a minimum of one year. Project Imagine staff tag the phrase "your new aunts and uncles," meaning that they will serve as a support system for the youths. Deputy City Manager Earl Reynolds encouraged the youths to believe in themselves and that they can succeed in life. "I cannot give you that (belief), it has to come from you," Reynolds said. "It comes from your experience in interacting with other



people in situations where you have had some success. That success does not have to be monumental but use it to build upon." He added, "I made many mistakes in my life. But I had to get up from that. You can do the same thing." Since the program's inception, 21 classes, totaling more than 120 teens, have graduated. Project Imagine is based on the evidence-based theory of Cognitive Behavior Therapy in that if the youth can implement new information and standards, then he or she can change their behavior. The idea is that the program creates a positive "image" in the mind of a youth so that they he or she can "imagine" a life without gangs or crime. The teens in Project Imagine are chosen from

As the Danville Otterbots look to make a championship run during the 2024 Appalachian League season, the club announced today that Mickey Tettleton will take the helm in his first season as Otterbots manager. The 14-year MLB veteran and two-time All-Star brings his experience on the field and in the dugout to the Otterbots as they seek to win their first Appy League championship since rebranding.

After retiring from his playing career in 1997, Tettleton entered the world of collegiate coaching at Oklahoma Christian University, a member of NCAA Division II in the Lone Star Conference. Tettleton is no stranger to collegiate summer ball, as he spent the 2018-2019 seasons with the Chatham Anglers of the Cape Cod Baseball League, and spent the 2023 season as the hitting coach of the Appalachian League's Greeneville Fly Boys.

"As a visitor last summer I was very impressed with the beauty of the ballpark and the atmosphere that the fans and the BOTS organization created," said Tettleton. "I'm looking forward to our players, coaches, support staff and their families to get to have that same experience. I'm also looking forward to getting to know the city of Danville and the folks in the Otterbots organization."

Before starting his coaching career, Tettleton led the Oklahoma State Cowboys to a 1981 College World Series title prior to being drafted by the Oakland Athletics in the 5th round of the 1981 MLB Amateur Draft. Tettleton spent 14 years in the big leagues spending time with A's, Baltimore Orioles, Detroit Tigers, and Texas Rangers. He was awarded the Silver Slugger award three times (1989, 1991, 1992) and was selected to the 1989 and 1994 American League All-Star teams. By the end of his career, the decorated catcher boasted a .241 career batting average and a strong display of power (.818 OPS, 245 career home runs, five seasons as MLB top-10 HR hitter). Tettleton was the epitome of consistency at the plate throughout his career, but also shined behind the plate throwing out 29% of runners with a .991 fielding percentage.

While playing under bright ballpark lights, Tettleton was also under the bright lights of Hollywood being credited in three baseball movies: Little Big League (1994), My Oh My! (1996) and Sunday Night Baseball (1990).





How Much Exercise Do We Need?

What does "vigorous physical activity" mean? Per the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, it means the hard stuff, like playing basketball or singles tennis, or swimming laps or running, ideally for 75 minutes per week. "Moderate intensive activity," such as playing doubles tennis or pushing a lawn mower, requires that we double the number to 150 minutes per week. Those are the kinds of numbers that will keep the sedentary among us from even trying. The first step would be to check in with our doctor, certainly, to make sure we can start vigorous exercise. And the second step would be to find a basketball court. At the very least, for moderate exercise, we would need a walking partner or a lawn to mow.

Ingredients

1 bag (16 oz) frozen mixed vegetables 2 cups cubed cooked chicken 1 can (10 3/4 oz) condensed reduced-fat reduced-sodium cream of chicken soup 1 can (10 3/4 oz) condensed reduced-fat reduced-sodium cream of mushroom soup 1 can (8 oz) refrigerated Pillsbury[™] Original Crescent Rolls (8 Count)

Steps 1

In large bowl, mix vegetables, chicken and soups. Pour into greased or sprayed 13x9inch (3-quart) glass baking dish.

Leave it to the Brits to come up with a study that we can get behind. This study concluded that a mere 15 to 20 minutes of vigorous physical activity per week was associated with a 16-40% lower mortality. Bump that up to 50 or 57 minutes per week, and the numbers are even better. What this says to us is that small amounts of exercise per week can add up to reduced mortality and chronic disease.

Even the CDC agrees that at least some amount of physical activity is better than none.

Get out of the chair, walk around ... take an exercise class for seniors.

SilverSneakers, a seniors exercise program, is available online if you have a membership. If you have a Medicare Advantage plan, see if the SilverSneakers membership is part of your plan. If so, you can attend in person in your area or sign in and watch online.

The National Institute on Aging has a section with exercise information videos for seniors (www.youtube.com/@NIHAging). Included are videos on balance, endurance, flexibility, strength and standing on one foot.

While you're on YouTube, do a search for "exercise for seniors" and see if anything appeals to you.

It only takes a few minutes.


