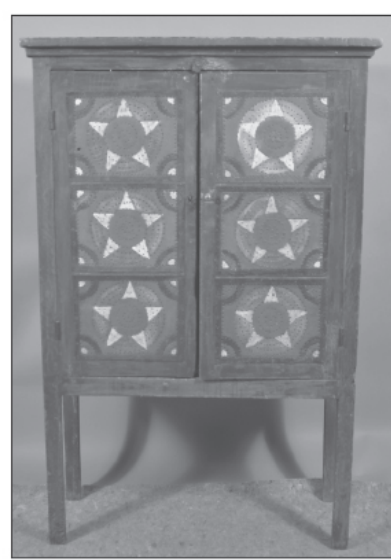

Pie Safes

Part of the fun of antiques is learning about how people lived in the past. You can often find new uses for items whose purposes have become obsolete. This softwood cupboard with painted and punched tin panels sold for \$384 at Conestoga Auctions. It's a pie safe, which is not something you would see in a kitchen today but was common in the 19th century.



Pie safes like this one were a 19th-century form of food storage.

The name "pie safe" may conjure up images of a locked box to keep deserts out of reach and reduce the temptation to overindulge. In reality, they weren't that drastic; they were meant to keep out bugs, vermin and mold rather than prying fingers. Pie safes had tin panels on the doors and sides, so mice couldn't chew their way in for an illicit treat. The panels had holes punched in them, creating ventilation to prevent mold. The holes were too small and the edges too sharp to allow bugs to fly through. Like many features of country furniture, the tin panels were both functional and decorative. Here, each panel has a circular pattern enhanced by a painted geometric design.

Q: When I was little, I played with dolls that originally belonged to my mother and aunt. There were early Barbies, Madame Alexander dolls, and I think a Ginny doll. I have seen similar dolls sell for high prices at auctions. The ones I had showed the kind of wear and tear you might expect from multiple generations of playing. Do dolls in "played with" condition sell? Can they be repaired?

A: If you are planning to sell a doll, don't have it restored. Collectors will want to see its current condition, and dealers can have dolls restored for a lower price than you can. Do not restore a doll yourself if you are not a specialist. Don't repaint a doll's head; it lowers the value. Don't wash or style a vinyl doll's hair. Keep the broken jewelry and old doll clothes; accessories add value to a doll, even

if they are in worn condition. There are many "doll hospitals" where professionals repair and restore antique dolls. You can find some, along with doll clubs and other resources, in the Kovels.com business directory.

 TIP: When clearing the table, don't stack dirty silver and dirty dishes together. The weight of the dishes may bend the silverware.

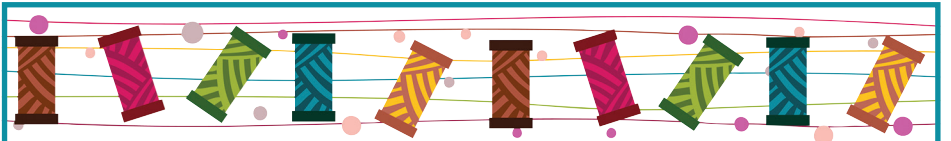

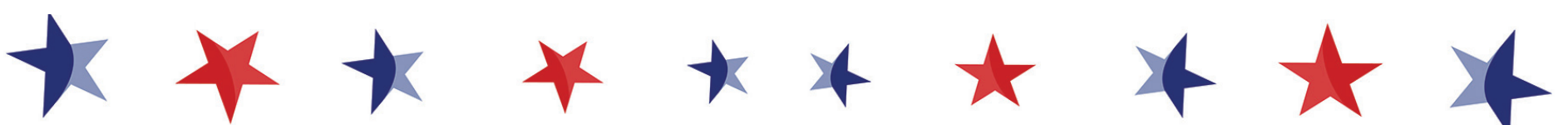

Losing It All in the St. Louis Fire

On July 12, 1973, a fire in St. Louis, Missouri, at the National Personnel Records Center destroyed between 16 and 18 million military personnel files. My mother's file was one of those.

The files covered the period from pre-World War 1 to 1963. There began decades of veterans struggling to prove military service in order to access their benefits.

When I sent away for my mother's records, what I received back was a certificate, similar to a Little League participation certificate. It has the information that I had provided: dates of service, branch of service, rank, but not much more. Thankfully, I'd had enough information on hand to send them to prove service, including a copy of a newspaper photo taken as she took the oath.

But what of people who don't have even those things? What if you have ... nothing?

After the fire, the Records Center started a new rule for all military facilities: Save everything. No matter where in the country a record was likely to be found, it was to be saved and indexed. In this way they were able to index approximately 6 million files. When a claim for benefits came in from a veteran whose file was burned, instructions were sent out to attempt to reconstruct the file from the pieces here and there.

The Veterans Affairs, Office of Inspector General was asked to audit the process of reconstructing a file. Here is what they found:

Last year it was taking an average of 450 days from time of claim to a claim decision, compared to 146 days for a non-fire claim.

Staff were not following the steps outlined in their instructions, thereby adding 73 days to the process.

Staff did not complete follow-up procedures 25% of the time due to lack of training.

If there's good news, I'll never have to send away for my father's military records. The man saved everything, and I mean everything: every transfer, pay stub, promotion notice, TDY order ... everything.

Perhaps you should do the same.

Q. I recently saw the movie "Killers of the Flower Moon," which is based on a true story. Who is the lead actress in it? Is she of Native American heritage? — *L.I.*

The original animated "Snow White" film was released in 1937. While the upcoming release is technically live-ac-

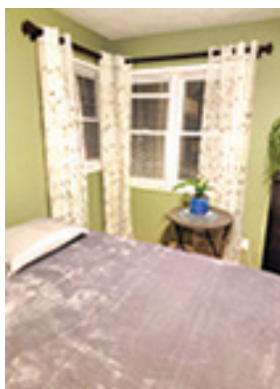

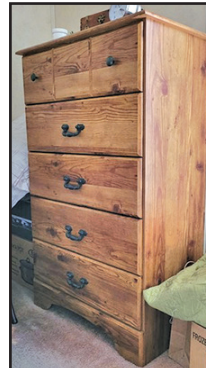

Carrot Cake Bars



Carrot Cake Bars

- ½ cup butter melted
- 1 cup light brown sugar packed
- 1 large egg
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ¼ teaspoon baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- 1 cup shredded carrots

Cheesecake Swirl

- 4 ounces cream cheese room temperature
- ¼ cup granulated sugar
- 1 large egg yolk
- ¾ teaspoon vanilla extract

INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray an 8x8 baking pan with non-stick spray and set aside. You can also line the pan with parchment paper and lightly spray with nonstick baking spray.

Carrot Cake Bars

Place the butter in a microwave-safe bowl. Microwave for 30 seconds. If needed, microwave another 15 seconds to melt the butter completely.

In a medium bowl, add the melted butter and brown sugar. Mix to combine. Stir in the egg and vanilla extract. Add in the flour, cinnamon, baking powder, and salt. Stir until completely combined. Fold in the shredded carrots. Set aside.

Cheesecake Swirl

In a medium bowl, add in the cream cheese and sugar. Beat with a hand mixer until smooth. Add in the egg yolk and vanilla extract. Beat until smooth and creamy.

Assemble

Add about half of the carrot cake batter into the pan and spread it out with an off-set spatula. Add half of the cheesecake batter to the carrot cake batter. Do this by dropping dollops of batter over the carrot cake batter. Don't swirl yet. Add the remaining carrot cake batter on top of the cheesecake batter and around the cheesecake batter. Add the remaining cheesecake batter by adding dollops on top of the carrot cake batter. Using a knife or skewer, swirl the batters together. Swirl as much or as little as you like.

Bake for about 35-40 minutes until the edges are golden brown. There will be very little jiggle to the center. Cool completely before cutting. Store in an airtight container in the refrigerator.

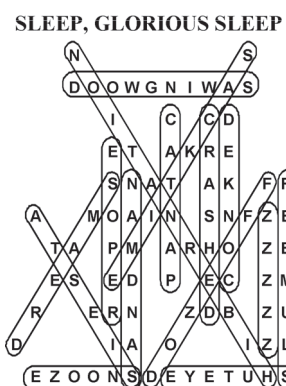
