

SHELBY – A contentious election season ended in Shelby with incumbents holding their seats, except John Pratt, a current councilman who fell short in a write-in campaign.

- · Linda Limina, 779, and Jeff Schiffer, 529, were both elected as Republicans. There were 427 write-in votes.
- · In other contested positions, Dale Root won re-election as highway superintendent over Bill Wolters, 556 to 488. Root had the Republican and Conservative lines while Wolter ran under the Democratic Party line. Wolter works as a motor equipment operator in the highway department.
- · Darlene Rich also held off a challenger and was reelected town clerk. Rich, a Democrat, also ran under the independent "People's Choice" Party. She received 616 votes to 446 for Christine Pask, a Republican. Rich has been the town clerk for 16 years.
- Other candidates were unopposed including: Scott Wengewicz for town supervisor, 706 votes; and Ed Grabowski for town justice, 771 votes.

Medina CSD FFA Advisor Takes Part in International Agriculture Conference



DES MOINES, Iowa—Outstanding Educators from 18 states and four countries convened in Iowa last month to participate in a unique professional development experience called the Global Guides program. Hosted by the World Food Prize Foundation and the Global Teach Ag Network, the Global Guides brought educators together for conversations and innovative learning opportunities with scientists, policymakers, and hunger fighters from around the world.

Todd Eick, agriscience educator at Medina Central School District, was selected to join the elite program that included 40 hours of immersive programming as part of the World Food Prize and the Norman E Borlaug International Dialogue, the premier global agri-

culture and food security convening. Eick engaged digitally for two months of preparation before attending

the Borlaug Dialogue, and will continue applying concepts in their communities over the next five months through designing and implementing interdisciplinary global learning projects as an individual or team with other Global Guides. "Words cannot begin to convey the experience," says Eick. "It was personally and professionally one of the most powerful and inspiring opportunities I've had in my career as an educator. The global network and direct connections I was able to make will bring a new level of global ag education to our program that we have never had."

During the Borlaug Dialogue, Eick and other Global Guides interacted with experts in food security, including 2023 World Food Prize Laureate Heidi Kühn, author Roger Thurow, Australia's Action For Agriculture Founder Lynne Strong, 2022 World Food Prize Laureate Dr. Cynthia Rozensweig, and 2018 World Food Prize Laureate Dr. Lawrence Haddad

The World Food Prize Global Guides program was facilitated by faculty from the Global Teach Ag Network including Daniel Foster, Ph.D., Associate Professor at the Pennsylvania State University, Melanie Miller Foster, Ph.D., Assistant Professor at the Pennsylvania State University, OP McCubbins, Associate Professor at Mississippi State University, and Tobin Redwine, Ph.D., Learning Strategist at Vivayic, Inc.

Foster, Co-founder of the Global Teah Ag Network explained the impact and importance of the Global Guides program. "Educators are an invaluable component of fighting global food insecurity," Foster said. "By situating educators as part of the conversation among scientists and world leaders, we bring global action to local contexts and see direct change."

The Town of Murray elected Gerald Rightmyer as the next town supervisor, ending Joe Sidonio's four-year tenure. Rightmyer, who beat Sidonio in a June 27 Republican primary, had 510 votes to the 175 for Sidonio, who ran under the Conservative Party line.

Other results in Murray include:

Town Council members for four-year terms (pick two) - Lloyd Christ Jr., 484; and Randall Bower, 489.

Town Council members for two-year terms (pick two) Michael Christopher, 441; Elaine Berg, 461; and Eric Collyer, 216.

In Kendall, residents elected a new member to the Town Board in David Bentley, a Republican with 361 votes. He ousted Margaret Lynn Szozda, a Democrat and incumbent, with 198 votes. Barb Flow, a Republican was re-elected with 432 votes.

CALL NOW 866.753.9521 Other candidates elected include: Tony Cammarata, town supervisor with 410 votes; and Eric Maxon, highway superintendent with 426 votes. There were also 88 write-ins for highway superintendent. Maxon will succeed Warren Kruger, who Maxon defeated in a Republican primary.

In Yates, incumbent Town Board members John Riggi and Susan Hrovat were re-elected, holding off a challenge from Paul Lauricella Jr. and Steven Colon.

Hrovat, 245 votes, and Riggi, 244, votes, are Republicans. They were challenged by Lauricella, 173 votes, and Colon, 129, who ran under the Conservative Party and independent "Taxpayers First."

Other Yates candidates to be re-elected include incumbents: Jim Simon for town supervisor, 312 votes; Michelle Harling for town clerk. 351 votes: and Roger Wolfe for highway superintendent, 352 votes.

PROPOSITION Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit:

Resolved that the Board of Education of the Kendall Central School District is hereby authorized to undertake certain capital improvements consisting of construction and reconstruction of existing school buildings and facilities, various site improvements and the acquisition of certain original furnishings, equipment, and apparatus and other incidental improvements required in connection therewith for such construction and school use, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$12,680,000; and to appropriate and expend from the existing capital reserve fund \$1,900,000 for such costs, and that the balance of such cost, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments, with such tax to be offset by state aid available therefor; and, in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary not to exceed \$10,780,000 shall be issued.


