The community is invited to attend the next Rosenmeier Forum: U.S. Foreign Policy update and a new playbook for the American economy, happening at 12 p.m. and 7 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 27 in the Chalberg Theatre, Central Lakes College, Brainerd campus. The event is free and open to the public.

Speaking will be Tom Hanson, a diplomat in residence at the University of Minnesota - Duluth. Hanson is

a frequent presenter of foreign policy forums for the Rosenmeier Center. He has previously conducted Rosenmeier forums on topics such as the war in Ukraine, China and foreign policy, and the 2018

mid-term elections. This program will analyze three crisis areas - Ukraine, the Middle East and China tensions - in light of the evolution of US foreign policy priorities since the 2008 economic crisis. It will also describe how national security concerns are leading to sharp disagreements over the future of the American economy.

Hanson, whose U.S. State Department postings included East Germany, France, Norway, the Soviet Union, Sweden and the former Soviet Republic of Georgia, serves as diplomat in residence at the Alworth Institute for International Affairs at UMD. The diplomat has participated in the opening of new U.S. embassies in Mongolia and Estonia, worked on the Foreign Relations Committees of the U.S. Senate and House of Representatives and served as director for NATO and European Affairs at the Atlantic Council of the United States. He serves as chair of the Minnesota Committee on Foreign Relations and as cochair of the Minnesota China Business Council. He is a past board member of the Oslo Center for Peace and Human Rights and past director at the Institute for Eastern Europe and Central Asia.

It finishes at the Pine Knoll Loop (indicated above with a circle and number one), which is currently under development and will be a loop consisting of approximately 1.6 miles, with entry and exit in the same location.






