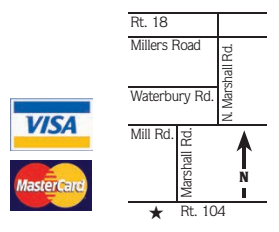

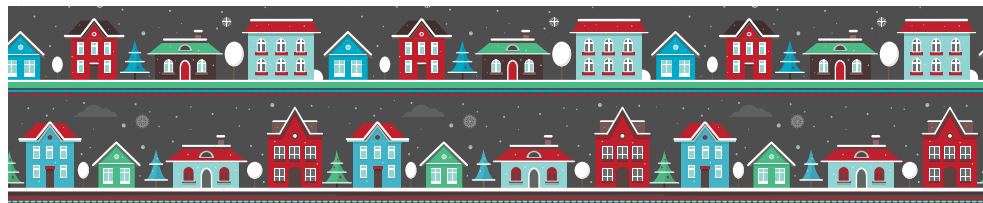

Medina pulls together in big way for Olde Tyme Christmas celebration

MEDINA – Saturday's 15th annual Parade of Lights is in the history books – the largest ever, with 71 entries, including 51 lighted floats, four marching bands and police and fire vehicles.

The parade is the highlight of Medina's Olde Tyme Christmas celebration, which brought throngs of people into town to shop, ride the Polar Express at Medina Railroad Museum and watch the spectacular parade.

Medina resident Todd Bensley, selected as this year's grand marshal for the Parade of Lights, welcomed the crowd before lighting the Christmas tree in Rotary Park.

By 4 p.m., restaurants were becoming packed with people who arrived early to get a parking space and then came in to eat while waiting for the start of the parade.

Evening festivities began with welcome remarks by Marguerite Sherman, deputy mayor, parade co-chair Jim Hancock and parade grand marshal Todd Bensley.

Hancock said Medina's parade has become the largest Parade of Lights in the state.

Bensley said people of Medina always pull together.

"My successes are your successes," he said.

Bensley then performed the ceremonial lighting of the giant Christmas tree in Rotary Park, before heading to Park Avenue to lead the parade down Main Street.

Handling the announcer's duties for at least the 12th year was Assemblyman Stave Hawley.

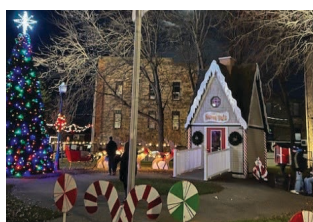
Looking out over the crowd which filled Main Street, Hawley said, "This is Americana. This is Main Street America, where the stories of yesterday are now the stories of tomorrow."

Parade entries included a number of first-timers, such as Coffee Pot Café, North Star Cruises, Logan's Landscaping, Medina Sports Boosters and Terry's Corners Volunteer Fire Company in Gasport.

The four marching bands included the Medina Mustang Marching Band, Mark Time Marchers, Pembroke High School Marching Band and Prime Time Brass, who entertained in Rotary Park prior to lighting of the Christmas tree.

Fire companies, in addition to Terry's Corners, were Albion, Medina, Shelby, Ridgeway, Oakfield, Hartland and East Shelby, which observed its 70th anniversary this year.

Participating FFAs came from Medina, Albion and Roy-Hart.



Crowds quickly thinned out in Rotary Park after the giant Christmas tree was lit, to seek out their spot to watch the more than hour-long Parade of Lights. Santa later took up residence to greet children in the North Pole house.

"These local kids are the heartbeat of our community," Hawley announced.

The North Wing at Medina Memorial Hospital entered a patient van with several residents from the unit riding in back.

Several floats paid tribute to the Buffalo Bills, including Blissetts, whose theme was "Bills-etts," with a bride in her wedding dress standing at the end of a football field.

Santa and Mrs. Claus, riding in their sleigh, arrived in the final float built by Takeform.

SNOW PLOWING BID SPECIFICATIONS 2023-2024

The following are specifications for snowplowing the grounds of the East Shelby Volunteer Fire Company. Bids are due by:
6:00 pm EST Tue., Dec. 9, 2023.
It may be dropped off at the fire station or mailed to the above address.

Plowing is to be done whenever there is an accumulation of 3" or more in the following areas:

- The area in front of the truck bays to include the entrance from East Shelby Road on both the north and south sides,
- In the north parking lot to the fire hydrant and an area large enough for emergency vehicles to access,
- The blacktopped parking area on the south side of the building where responders park,
- The area near the man door on the south side of the building into the truck bays must also be kept shoveled to allow access inside,
- The north parking lot, south non-blacktopped lot and the lot on the corner of Fletcher Chapel Road and East Shelby Road will be plowed whenever the accumulation reaches 10" or on days when there is an event being held. This may include, but not limited to, fundraising events, department banquet, and funeral dinners. For such events, the south side blacktopped area will also be plowed even if less than the normal 3" accumulation.

Any bidder: must show proof of liability insurance of \$1,000,000.00 minimum and have sufficient back-up capability either from their own resources or another provider in case they have break-downs or their primary snow removal equipment fails. This contract shall be in force from the acceptance by the fire company up to and including May 1, 2024.

It's that time of year again that we gather together to celebrate the holidays! For some though, this season will hit different. Those times that you once looked forward to with joy may now bring about unwanted feelings of pain or loneliness. If you can relate, I would like to share some tips with you to help you cope during this holiday season.

loved one's clothes to Hands 4 Hope to be given away to others who can use them, ringing bells for the Salvation Army, serving food to others at the Koinonia Kitchen, sponsoring a meal for a homeless individual at The Risen Café, or purchasing Hand Painted Ornaments in memory of your loved one at Hospice of Orleans. These are only a handful of the opportunities in Orleans County but there are many more as well.

SET REALISTIC EXPECTATIONS.
 Remind yourself that this year will be different. Decide if you can still handle past responsibilities and expectations. Examine the tasks and events of celebrating and ask yourself if you want to continue them. Accept others' offers to cook, shop, decorate, etc. Consider shopping online this year if you feel a need to avoid crowds or memories.

PRACTICE SELF-CARE.
 Avoid using alcohol or drugs to self-medicate your mood. Exercise as a means of relieving stress and boosting endorphins. Write in a journal as a good outlet for your grief. Give yourself permission to rest when needed.

SURROUND YOURSELF WITH PEOPLE WHO LOVE AND SUPPORT YOU.
 Share your plans with family and friends and let them know of changes in holiday routines. Memories can sometimes be a source of comfort so share them by telling stories and looking at photos.

CREATE A NEW TRADITION OR RITUAL THAT ACCOMMODATES YOUR CURRENT SITUATION.
 Some people find comfort by honoring traditions, while others find them painful. Discuss with your family the activities you want to include or exclude this year. Some examples of new rituals and traditions include:

- Announce beforehand that someone different will carve the turkey.
- Create a memory box. Fill it with photos of your loved one or memory notes from family members and friends. Ask young children to contribute drawings in the memory box.

AVOID "CANCELING" THE HOLIDAY.
 It is OK to avoid some circumstances that you don't feel ready to handle but fight the temptation to simply isolate yourself. Make some time for solitude, remembering and grieving, but balance it with planned social activities.

The most important thing to remember is that there really is no right or wrong way to celebrate the holiday season after the death of a loved one. The best coping mechanism is to plan ahead, get support from others, and take it easy.

ALLOW YOURSELF TO FEEL JOY, SADNESS, ANGER, ETC.

(i.e. experiencing joy and laughter during a time of grief does not mean you have forgotten your loved one.) Give yourself and others permission to experience whatever emotion is at the forefront.
DRAW COMFORT FROM DOING FOR OTHERS.
 Consider giving a donation or gift in memory of your loved one. Invite a guest who might otherwise be alone for the holidays. Find ways to serve others. Some possibilities are: donating some of your
