NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special meeting of the qualified voters of the Kendall Central School District shall be held at the Kendall Town Hall, 1873 Kendall Road, in said District, on Tuesday, December 12, 2023, between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 9:00 PM The following proposition will be submitted for voter approval at said meeting:

**PROPOSITION** Shall the following resolution be adopted to wit:

Resolved that the Board of Education of the Kendall Central School District is hereby authorized to undertake certain capital improvements consisting of construction and reconstruction of existing school buildings and facilities, various site improvements and the acquisition of certain original furnishings, equipment, and apparatus and other incidental improvements required in connection therewith for such construction and school use, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$12,680,000; and to appropriate and expend from the existing capital reserve fund \$1,900,000 for such costs, and that the balance of such cost, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments, with such tax to be offset by state aid available therefor; and, in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary not to exceed \$10,780,000 shall be issued.

The School District, acting as lead agency under the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder ("SEQRA"), has completed its environmental review and, on October 18, 2023, has duly issued a negative declaration and has determined that the implementation of the type I action as proposed will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts.

AND NOTICE IS GIVEN that qualified military voters may apply for a military ballot by requesting an application from the District Clerk at (585) 659-2741 Ext. 1914 or AudraKeirn@kendallschools.org. For a military voter to be issued a military ballot, the District Clerk must have received a valid ballot application no later than 5:00 PM on November 16, 2023. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or email.




