Electricity/Electronics Teacher Passes the Baton to Former Student

When 2016 Electricity/Electronics graduate Isaac Dauphin ran into his former Orleans Career and Technical Education Center (OCTEC) teacher Bill Leggett at a Buffalo Bills game, he never suspected that the outcome would be a change in career.
