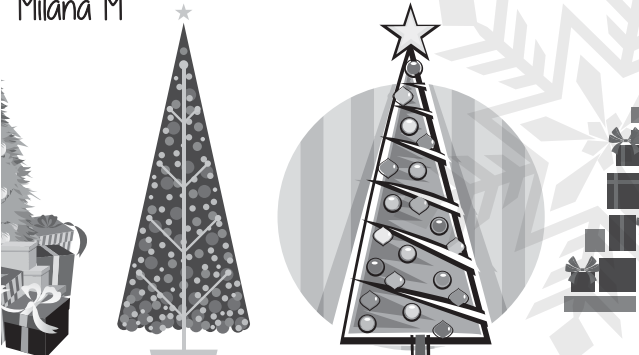

Research the company, the position and your interviewer to be able to talk about them in-depth during the interview.
- 3 MASTER THE PHONE INTERVIEW**
Enunciate clearly, talk slowly and go to a quiet place where you can concentrate and listen well.
- 4 PRESENT YOURSELF WELL**
First impressions are formed by 7% of what you say, 38% of your eloquence and confidence, 55% how you dress, act and walk through the door.
- 5 PREPARE QUESTIONS TO ASK**
Interviewing is a two-way street. What is important for you to know about the workplace, role, team? Be sure to ask those important questions.
- 6 PREPARE YOUR ANSWERS**
Your answers need to prove your skills and knowledge, aptitude for success in the role, and personality "fit" in the company.
- 7 USE THE S.T.A.R METHOD**
A good answer to behavioral questions includes stating the situation, task, actions, result.
- 8 ASK FOR THE JOB**

Start fresh in 2024

Drink more water (and less sugar and caffeine)

And if you drink caffeinated beverages like coffee, tea, and energy drinks, add 12 to 16 oz of water for each of those, because caffeine can dehydrate you. And while those energy drinks may give you a temporary boost, they're not the healthiest choice. Want to scale back? Do so gradually and avoid the headaches that come from stopping caffeinated drinks too quickly. Just reduce the number of daily servings and drink water instead.

Reach for more unprocessed foods

Foods that come in boxes and cans often have a lot of extra salt, sugar, and fat. Whatever your daily routine—three big, traditional meals, six smaller meals—try to incorporate more fresh fruits and vegetables as much as you can. 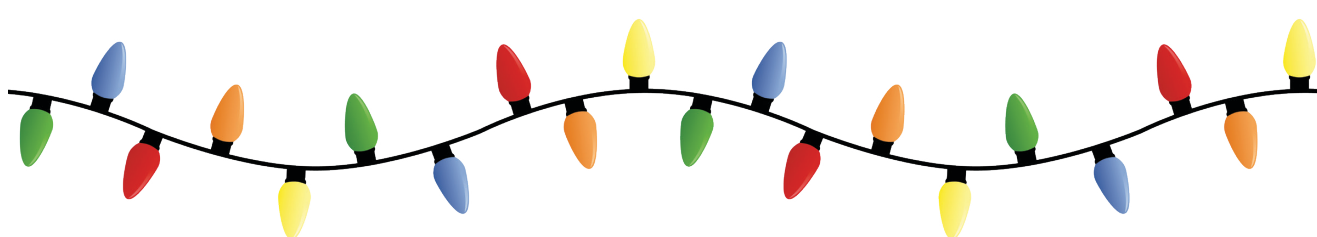

Movember Event Raises Money and Awareness for Mental Health at Medina CSD

Medina Junior-Senior High School Social Studies teacher and President of the Medina Teachers' Association, Joe Byrne, has made a tradition of challenging his male counterparts in the district to grow some facial hair every November. "Movember" raises attention to the growing number of men's health concerns such as mental health and suicide prevention, prostate cancer and testicular cancer. Staff is encouraged to make a pledge not to shave their moustaches for a full month. "Many of us deal with some strange looks and stares at school and the community along the way as we go from clean shaven to hairy, but it is for a good cause," laughs Byrne. "It is always funny what students say and think about us as our moustaches progress."

The money raised goes to the Orleans County Suicide Prevention Coalition. Mr. Byrne says this year the staff decided to continue bringing attention to a major health crisis that affects men. "Across the world, one man dies by suicide every minute of every day. Men account for 75% of all suicides. I'm so appreciative that our teachers, administrators, and staff continue to support this worthy cause. Men usually don't elaborate on their mental health issues because it's seen as a sign of weakness in our society. Now more than ever, we need to be able to talk openly about our social and emotional wellbeing. It's a tremendous feeling we are able to make a significant donation to Orleans County Mental Health and I know these funds will be earmarked to help assist countless number of men struggling with thoughts of suicide in our community."

Jeff Dole, a Math teacher at the Junior-Senior High School, organized this year's fundraiser. Everyone was thrilled with the \$1,400 that was raised. Mr. Byrne says a special shout out goes to retiring Social Studies teacher Doug Boje. "We were struggling to meet our goal the last few days in November and he sent an email to staff. He thanked those who already donated and gave the staff a challenge - he would match and double the highest donation for the last three days of the fundraiser. His gesture fits in with Movember's slogan on their suicide prevention page "Be a man of more words."

Superintendent of Medina Central School District, Dr. Mark Kruzynski says, "Every year, our faculty raises money for Movember and every year they continue to surpass the previous year. Mental health "IS" health, and I am proud that we were able to donate to this fantastic cause." Nola Goodrich-Kresse, Chairperson of the Orleans County Suicide Prevention Coalition says, "We are very grateful to the Medina Central School District staff for this very generous donation. Mental Wellness is something we all strive for, but we understand there are challenges for some in seeking help anytime of the year, but especially during the holidays. We encourage anyone who is struggling to talk to someone they trust or call 988 to talk with a trained crisis counselor 24/7, the call is free and confidential."

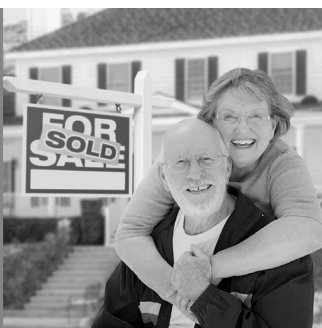

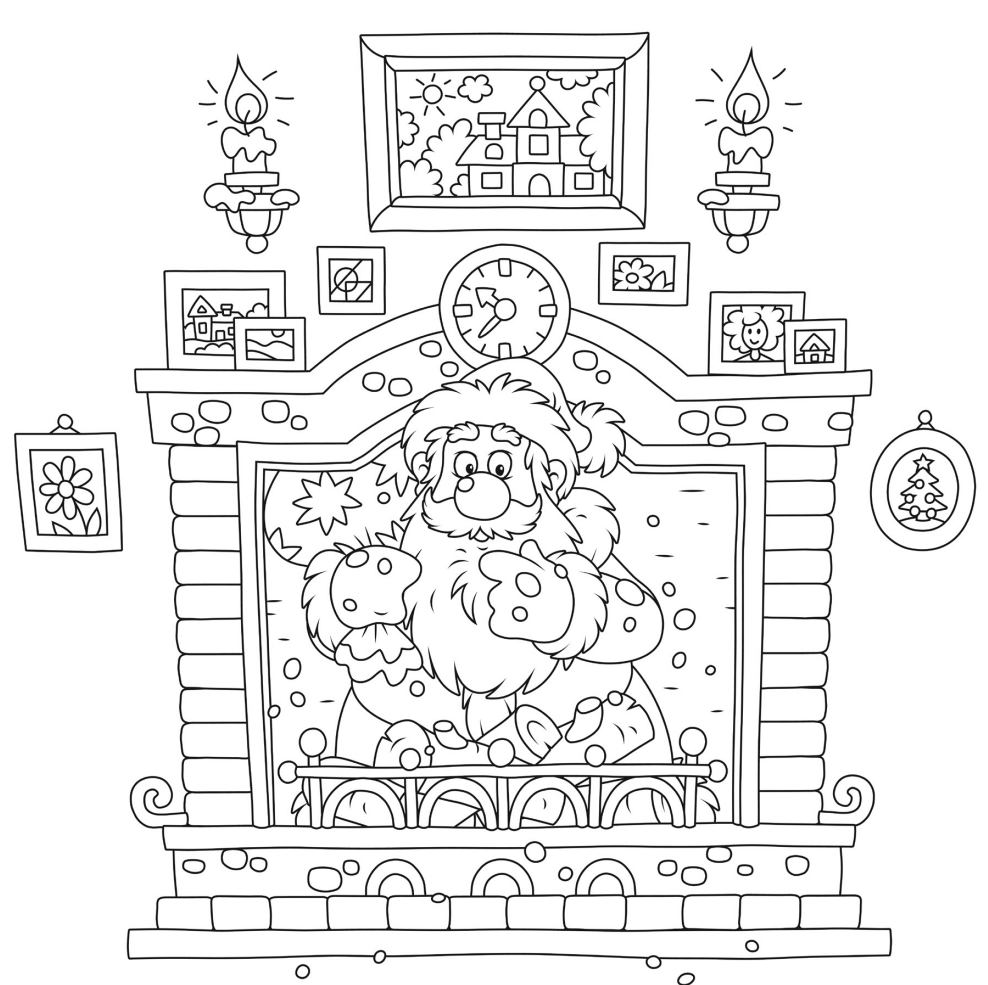

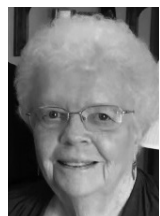

Activities to strengthen the heart

The heart is a vital component of the human body. Without a functional heart, life is simply not possible. As with other muscles in the body, it is important to give the heart a workout to improve its strength and vitality. Intermountain Health says an individual who does not exercise is more than twice as likely to get heart disease as someone who does. UCI Health says heart disease is the No. 1 cause of death worldwide.

Exercise is an ideal way to strengthen the heart and reduce your risk for heart disease and other conditions. Certain activities are prime for boosting heart health.

- **Aerobic exercise:** Aerobic exercise raises heart rate and gets the blood pumping throughout the body. Aerobic activity improves circulation, and over time it ensures the heart does not have to work as hard to pump blood, thus potentially lowering blood pressure. Also, aerobic exercise can reduce the risk for type 2 diabetes and can help those with diabetes to control blood glucose more readily. Aerobic exercises include brisk walking, running, swimming, cycling, playing tennis, and other activities that get the heart pumping. Aim for 30 minutes each day, for at least five days a week.

- **Resistance/weight training:** Building muscle can help the body burn fat and boost metabolism. This type of training can use weights or the body's own resistance. Improving muscle mass while reducing body fat and excess weight are heart-healthy steps to take. Strength training can be incorporated into a routine two to three days a week.

- **Balance and flexibility exercises:** A person may wonder what flexibility and balance has to do with heart health. While there isn't a direct correlation to how the heart works, these types of activities will help reduce the risk of falls or injuries to muscles and joints while working out. Inactivity is dangerous for the heart, so ensuring that physical activity can continue is important. Flexibility and balance exercises keep the body limber, and can be incorporated into daily workouts. Stretching, tai chi, yoga, and pilates can be included two or three times a week.

- **Healthy eating:** The foods people eat can affect heart health. Opt for lean protein sources and foods that include healthy fats. Salmon, avocados and olives are some options. Balance these foods with whole grains that are full of fiber, which can help a person feel fuller longer. Fiber also is essential for preventing atherosclerosis, a condition that causes hardening of the arteries.

- **Meditation:** Slowing down, performing deep-breathing exercises and meditation can reduce stress. That, in turn, can help prevent damage to the heart.

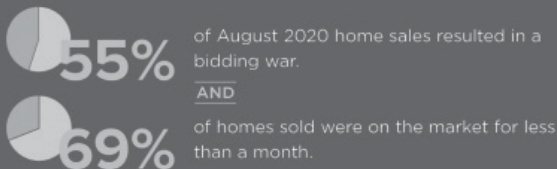
