

An elderly woman burst into a pet store. "I want to buy a canary, but it's got to be a good singer. I've got good, hard cash, but I'm only paying for a good singer."







For years, I have not made New Year's resolutions; instead I choose a theme for the year. It is usually a verse of scripture or a quote from a trusted church leader. The first year I gave up setting resolutions, I used a quote from Charles Dickens, "Have a heart that never hardens, a temper that never tires, and a touch that never hurts."

The theme must reflect something I want to work on or learn. The mission statement of the Danville Area Humane Society is the theme of our work, and it has been in place since the 1980s. Our goals for each year may vary in scope, but they always support our mission statement:

Our purpose is to promote the welfare and humane treatment of all animals: mammals, fowl, reptiles, and fish; to prevent cruelty and promote kindness, respect, and reverence for all forms of life; and to this end, provide for the rescue and temporary maintenance of lost, strayed, abandoned animals; find responsible, loving homes for as many as possible; investigate acts of cruelty, abandonment and neglect; strive to decrease pet overpopulation through spay/neuter programs; disseminate the principles of humaneness through educational programs and through these efforts contribute to the creation of a truly humane society.

For 2024, we will continue to focus on our mission statement.

We will maintain 1. our vigorous spay/neuter program. Since the 1970s, we have had a spay/ neuter assistance program, but through the courtesy of the E. Stuart Grant Charitable Trust, we have been able to significantly expand the program since 1993. Over 40,000 dogs and cats have been spayed or neutered through our programs since 1993.

2. We continue our work in sheltering animals. When we negotiated with the City of Danville in the early 1980s to operate and maintain the shelter, the shelter consisted of a nine dog runs. Since that time, we have quadrupled the size of the shelter, at no cost to taxpayers

We resolve to 3. never turn away an animal, no matter the circumstance, need, or chance of finding them a home. We will not place animals on a waiting list, nor will we charge an acceptance fee. We will also never turn away a grieving owner who cannot afford veterinary care for their beloved pet, even when that includes the recommendation of euthanasia. Our doors can never be closed to the weakest members of society.

Finally, we are grateful for the privilege we have had this year of working on behalf of the animals. As always, we hope the next year will be a kinder one for the animals. We are grateful to every person in this community who respects the creatures with whom we share this earth. Without you, our work would be a heavy burden.





Art Deco

The legal definition of an antique is that it is at least 100 years old. This means the art deco era is officially reaching antique status. The name "art deco" is believed to come from the Exposition Internationale des Arts Decoratifs et Industriels Modernes (International Exhibition of Modern Decorative and Industrial Arts) in Paris in 1925, but the style already existed by the time of the exhibition.

World War I is generally considered the end of the art nouveau period and the beginning of art deco. People were moving into smaller homes and wanted inexpensive furniture where form followed function. The new machinery, manufacturing techniques and materials of the time lent themselves to the sleek geometric shapes that define the era.

This cabinet, made in Italy in 1934, shows characteristics of art deco style. It is constructed from smooth, simple shapes in veneers, acrylic and lacquered wood. Decorations are contained within the cabinet's shape. Instead of ornate carvings, the cabinet has burl veneer, bands and squared spirals of dark wood. The cabinet sold for \$2,322 at a Cowan's auction.





DEAR DR. ROACH: I am 81 and had a thyroidectomy in 2017. My whole thyroid gland was removed. I also had a little bit of cancer.

I have started to get hot flashes again. I had original-

ly been on thyroid medicine before and after surgery. Then I was put on levothyroxine and decided to try NP Thyroid. I was doing better on NP Thyroid, then started getting the hot flashes again. At this point, for several reasons, I would rather stay on NP Thyroid for the time being.

I was wondering if there is anything I can take for hot flashes? Years ago, in my 50s, I took estrogen, which helped, but this is a different time. I have spoken with other people who are also having hot flashes again. -- Anon.

ANSWER: Hot flashes are common -- about 75% of women in North America will experience them around the time of menopause. It's not uncommon for hot flashes to go away, then return, but I personally haven't seen them recur after 30 or so years. I'd be concerned that there may be another cause for them, which brings me to your thyroid.

Elevated levels of thyroid hormone can cause sensations very similar to hot flashes. One reason that I, along with most endocrinologists, recommend against products like NP Thyroid is because most of those products come from pigs. There are two thyroid hormones: thyroxine (T4) and triiodothyronine (T3). Humans have a different ratio of T3 and T4 than pigs do, with T4 getting converted into the active form, T3. T3 is then quickly broken down, so if it's used, it needs to be dosed twice daily.

As a result, if a person takes NP Thyroid, their thyroid levels are too high during one part of the day and too low during another. This isn't good for anyone; the "high times" not only cause hot flashes, but also predispose people to atrial fibrillation. But it's particularly a problem in a person with a history of thyroid cancer, where we want the thyroid-stimulating hormone (TSH, the hormone in the pituitary gland that regulates the activity of the thyroid gland)

If the thyroid blood levels get low in the afternoon/ evening when the T3 in NP Thyroid is gone, that can theoretically increase the risk of cancer recurrence as the TSH rises in response. So, in my opinion, you should be on levothyroxine, not NP Thyroid. (I do have a handful of patients who take levothyroxine and also take T3 twice daily. Some people are unable to convert T4 to T3 efficiently.)

Estrogen is the most effective treatment for hot flashes, but it increases the risk of heart disease when used by women more than 10 years away from menopause. I don't normally prescribe it to a woman in her 80s. However, there is a new medication called fezolinetant (Veozah), which is highly effective and reduced hot flashes by 93% in a trial. My only patient on it so far has reported 100% cessation of her hot flashes.

There are other rare causes of hot flashes, including tumors that secrete substances, such as carcinoid tumors, and tumors that secrete adrenalin-like hormones (pheochromocytomas).


I consulted the list of cat information posted on the wall. One was a boy, one was a girl. Both had been found on the streets, both unclaimed. And they were both 12 years old.

Make a Batch of Tasty Slow-Cooker Granola

We're a granola-eating family. When the tall jar in our pantry almost reads empty, we know that it's time to stir up a new batch. It's never a chore because the fresh homemade taste of heart-healthy oats with nuts and dried fruit is always satisfying, whether it's combined with yogurt and berries at breakfast or sprinkled over a scoop of ice cream for an evening dessert.

No wonder I was so curious when a friend suggested that I make granola in my slow cooker instead of baking it in the oven. Although skeptical, I gave it a try and loved the results. In fact, it's a game-changer.

I stick with my basic recipe that never disappoints. The hand-crafted, economical blend is open to variations, like substituting cashews for almonds or pecans. When I buy a jug of fresh, local maple syrup, I leave out the brown sugar entirely. For variety, I'll cut up something unusual, like dried persimmons, to toss in with the raisins at the end.

TASTY SLOW-COOKER GRANOLA

Yields about 6 cups Cooking spray or olive oil

- 4 cups old-fashioned rolled oats (not quick-cooking)
- 1/2 cup brown sugar — 1 teaspoon cinnamon — 1/2 teaspoon baking powder

— 1/2 teaspoon salt

- 1/2 cup coarsely chopped whole almonds
- 1/2 cup coarsely chopped pecans
