Houston Market House 1890

At one time, the city of Houston was the capitol of the Republic of Texas. Actually, two times! Really, between 1836 and 1844, the capitol of Texas changed 7 different times....Washington-on-the-Brazos, the Battleship Cayuga, Velasco, Columbia, Houston and Austin (also twice) just adding to the body of evidence that Texas is woven of a fabric unique and magical. I read a new book about Texas, a work of historical fiction about a woman who lived in Texas during and after it's fight for independence from Mexico. In fact, the woman did some of the fighting herself, made some very good friends in high places and secured a most colorful place of her own in the story of Texas. She was Pamelia Mann, a real individual who is mentioned in accounts of early Texas. "Mentioned". Local author Gene Shelton is the first to embellish her story and bring it out of obscurity. Gene became fascinated with the woman who was a wife, mother, farmer and slave owner, influential business woman and the first female in Texas to be sentenced to hanging.

During a dangerous journey from her husband's cabin on the Brazos River (the flight known as the Runaway Scrape) with her two sons and three slaves, Pamelia Mann let it be known without a shadow of a doubt that she was as good as anybody else and would not be stolen from or taken advantage of by desperate fellow-travelers. She wore men's pants, toted a pistol and served up colorful language from a razor-sharp tongue. When her spare team of oxen was requisitioned by President Sam Houston himself, she did not take kindly but

agreed to a deal with Houston for the use of the animals to pull the two new cannon the Texian army had been given as a gift. However, when Houston did not keep his word about the route he would take, she went and got her oxen back at gunpoint. Her reputation as the only woman to ever back Sam Houston down was a deserved one. She eventually made it to the bold and blustery frontier village which was his namesake. In it's infancy in January 1836, there were only a dozen residents and one structure but by that summer, there were 1500 people living in Houston, some businesses and a hundred houses. According to Wikipedia, Houston's shallow port had begun to be visited by ships bringing goods and settlers. The newly-incorporated city had a bright future but it was also was plagued with drunkenness, dueling, brawls and prostitution. That's about the time Pamelia Mann came on the scene, bought a hotel, turned it into a boarding house and later a brothel. For a few colorful years, she deftly managed the business of her Mansion House with a pair of pistols and a policy of free-flowing liquor, carving a place for herself in Texas history.

"Houston Madam" is the 27th novel written by Gene Shelton of Sulphur Springs, and the first of his works to be electronically published. Jon was a member of a choir at Hardin Simmons and wore a tuxedo when he performed. So he and a couple of his choir buddies decided they would put on their tuxedos for the event.

"We got student tickets for the movie and we were acting like Hollywood big shots. We crashed the wine and cheese party they were having as part of the opening. Nobody stopped us I guess because we looked like we belonged, wearing tuxes and all. We were just goofing off and being silly when a gentlemen came up to us and said, 'you boys need to get down to the garage at the Abilene Reporter-News."

At the newspaper, Jon and his friends saw about twenty other guys in Tuxedos. They were from Abilene Christian University.

"We just kind of stood around away from the other group and pretty soon Steve Martin came out and gave all of us buttons that said DEAD MEN DON'T WEAR PLAID.. He then told us what the gag was. We were all going to get into this one limousine, kind of like a clown car, and just start piling out of that limo in front of the theater."

When they started getting out, Jon was the first one out and because he had light hair, the crowd thought he was Steve Martin and there was a burst of applause. Then the other guys started getting out and the crowd realized it was a joke, typical of comedian Steve Martin.

"After we got out we sort of formed a human chain in front of the spectators and then Steve Martin comes up riding in an old jalopy. We crowded around him and escorted him into the theater. I ended up sitting next to him. He was asked to say something, so he got up and made a short speech and then sat back down. The lights went down and the movie started. After it was on the screen for about three minutes, Steve got up and left the theater.

John got a job in real estate in Abilene and ended up selling Steve's condo.


