

#### Good morning! Grab your favorite cup. Fill it up. And let's start this NEW YEAR right... TOGETHER!!!



Good morning! Grab your favorite cup. Fill it up. And let's start this day right... TOGETHER!!!

Let me start by saying how much I appreciated all of the shares and feedback over the past couple of weeks in regard to Risen Café's "Pay It Forward" Program for feeding the homeless. I hope you will be just as supportive this week as I share about another fantastic ministry that feeds many here in Orleans County.



I am of course talking about the Orleans Koinonia Kitchen (OK Kitchen) which sets up every Thursday from 4-5:30pm in the Harvest Christian Fellowship Dining Hall located at 560 East Ave. in Albion. I first met the Director, Faith Smith, years ago when she ran the Community Kitchen, a soup kitchen that my church at the time participated in, and so I was excited to sit down with her and her husband Mike to hear about the fruitfulness of their latest endeavor.

First off, for those who are not familiar with the Greek word Koinonia it is a term that describes fellowship, community, and intimacy. When asked what the word Koinonia meant to her Faith simply looked around the dining hall where people had started filling up the tables and responded "This!" and by "this" Faith explained that the vision for the OK Kitchen was not simply to be a soup kitchen to feed the poor but rather a place that anyone from any walk of life could gather with others and experience authentic community. The hope is that when people leave both their stomachs and their souls will be full.



With a "No Questions Asked" Policy and a warm greeting for all who stop by it's no surprise to find out that last year alone 24,184 meals were given away. And if that sounds like a lot, it is! Thankfully though this is not a solo effort by Faith and Mike. Several groups from churches and local organizations sign up to provide food, and servers if possible, for one or more Thursdays out of the year. Some, like the Albion-Medina Lion's Club, provide food every first Thursday of the month. Also, since the food is already taken care of, those first Thursdays are ideal for any individuals who would like to sign up to serve. On the evening that I was there a group from Oak Orchard Assembly of God both provided and served the meal. The church also filled a table with clothes that anyone could take, and other groups provide similar giveaways on their days.



Both Mike & Faith's enthusiasm for the ministry and their caring for those being served was evident, as was the camaraderie of the patrons and the joy of those volunteering. When asked what their biggest take away from 2023 was The Smiths quickly responded that they were overwhelmed by the amount of love and support that they had received not only from the local community but from all around the County as well.

Lastly, I asked what the biggest needs were for 2024 and the answer was funding and transportation. Last year OK Kitchen received \$37,534.90 in donations but are anticipating the need for more this coming year, especially as the cost of all the paper-ware, take-out containers, silverware, etc. continues to rise. I was reminded of the children's story "Stone Soup" as Faith shared how if the 60+ churches in the area committed to give only \$25 a month it would make a huge impact. How much more of an impact could be made if individuals, businesses, and organizations committed similarly? There is also a great need for volunteers who can deliver meals or, preferably, pick people up and bring them to the Kitchen so that they can truly experience the sense of community that has been developed there.

These meals include take-outs, frozen dinners, and even "Homeless Care" Bags which are actually backpacks filled with personal care items, food, first aid kits, blankets, water, pen & paper, etc. They have also partnered with Risen Café (469 E. State St. Albion) to allow people to pick up a bag there or to get a meal there that the OK Kitchen will pay for. The goal is to help anyone that is in need to receive 5 days of food.

I am grateful for all of the outdoor fridges, food, pantries, and food distribution sites that we have here in our County and hope you will support any and all as you are able. 





#### What does women's health mean to you?

Yes, it is true, that women's health can be confusing. So many rules and regulations! When do you get a mammogram or a Pap Smear? If you are at high risk for breast cancer, what are your options? What birth control is right for you? In this article, we will touch upon several topics related to women's health that we hope will clear up the mystery around women's health. These are all topics you should be discussing with your provider at Oak Orchard Health (OOH).

#### **Early Detection of Breast Cancer**

Mammograms and breast self-exams are two very important ways to detect cancer early. Early detection saves lives. The age range for a mammogram is 40-75 but talk with your provider if you want to get one earlier or continue past 75. The American College of Gynecology recommends mammograms yearly.

Breast ultrasounds are primarily used to find out if a problem discovered by a mammogram or physical exam of the breast may be a cyst filled with fluid or a solid tumor. Breast ultrasounds are also recommended for screening women with dense breast tissue along with a mammogram.

Breast MRIs may be recommended in addition to mammography if you are at high risk for breast cancer (usually because of a strong family history of cancer or genetic mutations, like BRCA1 or BRCA2). Or to gather more information after you have been diagnosed and to further evaluate breast abnormalities that are difficult to assess with mammography and breast ultrasound. the many options available. Some include birth control pills, patches, NuvaRing, condoms, and Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARC) including Nexplanon implants and IUDs, and Depo-Provera.

Did you know that you often do not need a pelvic exam to get birth control? Birth control pills come in 30-day packs, and you get your period each month, or 90-day pill packs and you get a period every three months. There is no medical reason to have a period, so these are safe options.

#### Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Testing is easier than you think.

STD testing including urine and blood tests can detect STDs even if you do not have symptoms. Diseases like gonorrhea and chlamydia can lead to pelvic inflammatory disease which can lead to infertility. Sometimes people can have these diseases with little or no symptoms. If caught early, they are highly treatable with an oral antibiotic. A simple urine test can detect gonorrhea and chlamydia. If you are positive, we can also treat your partner.

#### What is the HPV Vaccine?

The HPV infection is the most common sexually transmitted infection in the United States. Screening for HPV is effective in identifying precancerous lesions and allows for interventions that can prevent the development of cancer. The use of condoms may decrease the spread of the virus. The HPV Vaccination is effective in preventing the development of infection and related cancers. American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) recommends starting the series between ages 9-12 years and up to age 26. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), all preteens need HPV vaccination, so they are protected from HPV infections that can cause cancer later in life. Even if you have had HPV, you should still get the vaccine.

#### When and why should you get a Pap Smear?

The Pap test (or Pap Smear) looks for cancer, and cell changes on the cervix that might become cervical cancer if they are not treated appropriately.

Once you turn 21, the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecology (ACOG) recommends that you have three annual pap smears. If all those are normal and you are HPV negative, then you can go every three years. Once you turn 30, you can have a Pap every 3-5 years depending on your Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) status. If you are positive for HPV that is considered high risk, and your chance of cervical cancer goes up. So those who are HPV positive should have annual Pap Smears.

#### Birth Control – so many choices

If you are sexually active and do not want to get pregnant, consult with your Oak Orchard provider about According to the CDC, the HPV vaccine has the potential to prevent more than 90% of HPV-attributable cancers. Since the HPV vaccination was first recommended in 2006, HPV infections that cause most HPV cancers and genital warts have dropped 88% among teen girls and 81% among young adult women. The vaccine, often called Gardasil, is for both boys and girls. This vaccine not only prevents cervical cancer but also rectal, throat, and oral cancers, as well as penile cancer.







#### Correcting an omission to our Outstanding Citizens

Orleans Hub each year recognizes outstanding citizens who inspired the community, and worked selflessly for others or to move a difficult project forward.

We posted our list on Jan. 1, recognizing eight people for their efforts in 2023. We should have had nine in the list of extraordinary people.

I forgot about Brett Sobieraski. Brett does mighty feats frequently. In 2015, he swam 32 miles across Lake Ontario for a charity that helps support the surviving spouses and children of fallen soldiers. In 2018, he ran over 175 miles for 50 hours nonstop to raise money and awareness for Special Olympics.

Sobieraski is a retired Rochester police sergeant who lives in Kent. He ran for Orleans County sheriff in 2019, and was edged by Chris Bourke.

In 2023, Sobieraski announced he would be running a marathon every day for 48 days, traveling on foot from Florida and Rochester, going 26.2 miles a day. He would run the marathons to honor the memory of Rochester police officer Anthony "Maz" Mazurkiewicz. He was killed in the line of duty on July 21, 2022. Sobieraski also sought to raise \$100,000 for Mazurkiewicz's family.

Sobieraski said he met many inspiring people along

That goal was expanded to 50 marathons in 50 days, and Sobieraski would raise \$110.000 for the family.

The journey began April 23 in Palatka, Florida and ended June 11 in Rochester. Sobieraski added two marathons near the end. He was allowing two rest days but added more when he was feeling strong and the mission had such a following as he passed through communities and reporters picked up the story.

One of his extra days was June 10. He ran from his house in Carlton to Albion, and then ran the Albion Strawberry Festival 5K, and then ran back home. He wanted Orleans County to be part of the epic adventure.

In the end, he brought together the community, and honored Mazurkiewicz, a Rochester PD veteran who was shot in the upper body on Bauman Street. He worked in RPD's Tactical Unit 8. He investigated many of the city's toughest cases. Sobieraski said Maz was deeply respected in the RPD. Sobieraski picked eight states to run with the eight in recognition of Maz's tactical unit number.

"We need to pay attention when cops are murdered," Sobieraski said. "These are our people, and their families are suffering."
