I remember a couple of late night frantic phone calls to Tracy that resulted in her kindness in meeting us at the shelter. One involved a very old, weak pit bull that had been found tangled in a fence. The dog was terrified and in pain, but she immediately melted into Tracy and was calm and submissive during the examination and treatment.

Several weeks before her death, treatment was stopped and Tracy was put under hospice care. We desired to memorialize her in some way and told her we were establishing the Tracy Keller Pit Bull Buddy Fund. We added the word "Buddy" at her request. A few days before her death, Tracy, her husband David, daughter Davin Keller, and Tracy's sister visited the shelter to talk about the fund. We assured her that the money would be used wisely to help pit bulls.

Pit bulls (that is a catchword for many breeds of dogs, including Staffordshire Terrier, bull terrier, etc.) fill shelters today. Years ago, we would receive one occasionally and now, we and other shelters receive them on an average daily basis. From our experience, that breed is the most abused and neglected breed in today's world.

The need for The Tracy Keller Pit Bull Buddy Fund is immense and we would like to "resurrect" it. It will help pay for veterinary treatment, behavioral assessments, and sterilizations. **Donations to the fund may be made through PayPal, at the shelter, or may be mailed to our office at P.O. Insightful Labels

Brass inlaid inkstands were not a rarity in Victorian times. This one recently sold for \$188 at New Orleans Auction Galleries. It features a brass handle, two compartments for ink pots and a stamp box in the center. If you turn it upside down, you can see a nearly intact paper label on the base. The original paper label adds value to an antique. It also provides useful information, often more than just a mark.

A label can tell you the name and possibly the address of the maker or retailer. This inkstand was made by "L. Leuchars, Writing & Dressing Case Maker," located at "38 Picadilly, London." The label mentions the maker also made "Ink Stands, Chess Men, Tea Chests" and "Work Boxes," and it includes a crest with a crown showing a royal warrant "To Her Majesty and the Royal Family." An online search for "L. Leuchars" brought up Lucy Leuchars, the widow of James Leuchars, who took over his business. Later, when their son joined the business, it was called "Leuchars & Son." The royal warrant was issued in 1837, the first year of Queen Victoria's reign. ***

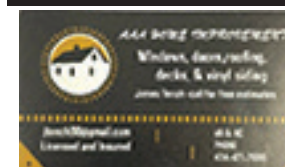

Chatham HS Varsity Wrestling Sends 9 to the State Championship

Buchanan, Virginia - The Chatham High School varsity wrestling team continued building success at the 2024 Virginia High School League's (VHSL) Class 2 Region C Championship on Saturday, February 10, 2024. In a contest of nine teams, Chatham High School varsity wrestlers walked away with a second place overall team finish and after sending 9 out of its 14 wrestlers to the state championship on Friday, February 16, 2024.

"It was an amazing day on the mats," Chatham Head Coach Marcus Clements said. "I knew they could do it. They have worked hard and represented Chatham High School very well."

Chatham came very close to winning its regionals. Glenvar High School, a perennial powerhouse, was the only other regional team that fielded 14 wrestlers, covering all weight classes. Chatham went head to head with them and came very close to ending Glenvar's ongoing domination of the region. Glenvar would finish 212.5 to Chatham's 194.5.

The remaining finishes were Patrick County (155.0), Radford, (150.0), James River (Buchanan, 115.0), Liberty (Bedford, 106.0), Dan River (91.0), Martinsville (81.5), and Floyd County (47.0).

While a win in a single weight class remained elusive for Chatham, the team managed a number of second and third place finishes. Finishing top three guarantees a spot to compete at the state level.

In the 113 weight class, Chatham sophomore Dallas Harrison (12-10) took second place after a tough battle with Glenvar's Alan Vu (20-12). Vu won by pin.

In the 126 weight class, Dan River's Brice Jones (36-2) defeated Chatham junior Jamie Simental (14-10) on points. Both competitors have engaged each other previously in the season. Simental would claim second place in the class.

Junior Matthew Marlowe (24-1) had an even contest in the 157 weight class. Radford's Taven Williams (33-1) managed to escape Marlowe's dominating open, which allowed a tiny opportunity for Williams to turn the tables on Marlowe. Marlowe would take second.

Chatham's third place finishers included sophomore Colin Bisson (14-8) in 132, sophomore Michael Ortiz (3-8) in 144, junior Cameron Martin (24-4) in 165, junior Jaxon Phillippi (19-2) in 175, Samuel Wiebking (18-4) in 190, and Jackson Reece (17-5) in 285.

Chatham's other finishers included freshman Brayden Bisson 4th in 106, sophomore Shauntae Pyles 5th in 120, sophomore Alfredo Gomez 6th in 138, junior Nathan Azous 5th in 150, and freshman Christopher Conner, 6th in 215.

"I love this team and the culture we are creating. They have definitely bought in," Coach Clements said. "The future is bright for Chatham Wrestling."

Chatham had a remarkable 2023-2024 winter season. Along with qualifying nine wrestlers for the state championship, the team won the 15 team Bison Invitation on January 13, 2024, now covers all 14 weight classes, and continues to improve by completing goals and milestones for all team members. Clements is in his 3rd year as Chatham's head coach.

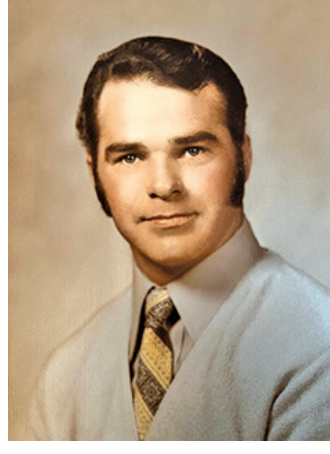

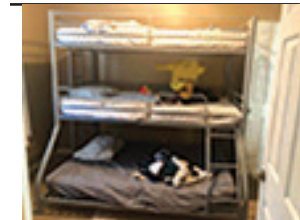

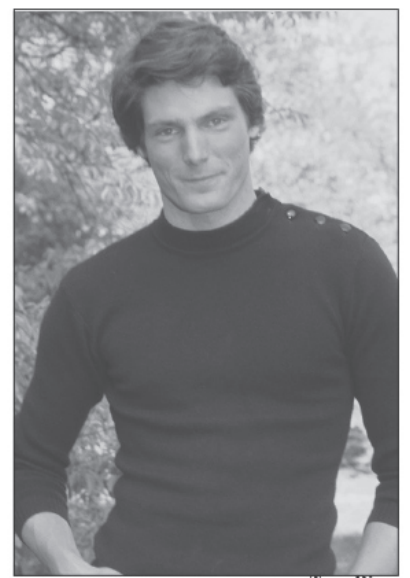

Christopher Reeve ("Superman")

HOLLYWOOD — The children of four-time "Superman" Christopher Reeve bare their souls in a documentary commemorating the 20th anniversary of their father's passing at the age of 52. The documentary follows his rise to fame through 1995, when he was thrown from a horse, breaking two vertebrae in his neck and leaving him paralyzed from the shoulders down.

I met Christopher in 1976 when he played Katharine Hepburn's grandson on Broadway in "A Matter of Gravity." He also starred in the soap "Love of Life" and asked me to write a story on why he was leaving the soap. The photos and story ran in Soap Opera Digest, and I invited him to stay in my guest room in Hollywood if he ever needed to.

To my surprise, he called six months later after completing a role in "Gray Lady Down" with Charlton Heston and Rosemary Forsyth, and he became my house guest. I shot new photos of him, and two of them were sent to the producers of the upcoming "Superman" movie, who saw the jawline of the future "Man of Steel" in my photographs.

He was then flown to London for testing and serious bodybuilding to become "Superman" for four films from 1978-1987. In addition, he made other classic films such as "Somewhere in Time" (1980). In 2006, despite having partial paralysis and being in a wheel chair, he directed and executive produced the computer-animated sports comedy "Everyone's Hero," with the voices of Rob Reiner, William H. Macy, Raven-Symone and Whoopi Goldberg. Christopher truly was a super man!

Glen Powell has become the first breakout star of 2024. His rom-com "Anyone but You" passed the \$100 million mark, possibly saving the genre. 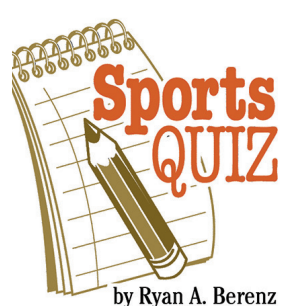

VETERANS POST

Double Benefits for Education

Per a Department of Veterans Affairs Office of Inspector General (VAOIG) report, veterans who are enrolled at the same time in two different education programs are receiving housing allowance benefits from both.

The two programs are the Post-9/11 GI Bill and VET TEC. Oddly enough, there's no prohibition against the double payments because the way that the VET TEC program was established isn't the same as other education programs (such as the Montgomery GI Bill) that specifically ban dual benefits. In other programs, a veteran must choose between one set of benefits or the other.

The Post-9/11 GI Bill program consists of three or four years of benefits that include books and supplies, tuition and a housing allowance.

The VET TEC program focuses on high-tech training through specific providers. Benefits include the cost of classes and a housing allowance.

The Office of Inspector General (OIG) took 30 random veterans to study and determined that all of them received dual housing allowance benefits, averaging \$3,100.

They were also able to identify 249 veterans whose training and education programs overlapped, and calculated how many days that included and how much in housing benefits were paid. In the first example in the OIG report, the veteran received over \$12,000 for 105 overlapping days. In the second example, the veteran received nearly \$11,000 for 58 overlapping days.

The VBA tried, says the report, to halt the dual housing payments. They were informed by attorneys that it wouldn't be "veteran-friendly" to reduce benefits and that no laws were being broken in paying the dual benefits. Only in other programs was the veteran required to only pick one program for benefits.

Congress stepped in with bill amendments to continue the VET TEC program past the end of the pilot period (the five-year pilot will end in April 2024), but according to the OIG report, the bills don't prevent "the concurrent receipt of educational benefits, including monthly housing allowance payments."

How to Get Financial Help

A survey released last month indicated that consumer sentiment was higher than it's been in quite a while, since the summer of 2021. This is supposed to be a good thing.

The first thing I needed to do was look up the definition of "consumer sentiment." It's how we feel about the state of the economy and our own finances, how positive we are about short-term and long-term economic growth. According to the survey, that positivity occurred everywhere, and income, education, age and location didn't matter.

I'm guessing they didn't survey participants in my area. However, I did. In one of my informal polls of local friends and acquaintances, I learned that:

-- Going to the grocery store is still an experience filled with tension and anxiety. We never know what prices will be this week, whether we'll be able to buy what we need and stick to a budget or whether we'll need to have soup and sandwiches for dinner three times this week instead of two.

-- Going to the food bank is still embarrassing, but we do it anyway, usually before making a trip to the grocery store and planning meals around what we get from the food bank.

Then there are basic expenses like utilities and transportation ...

If this describes your situation, consider looking into the National Council On Aging Benefits CheckUp. Every year billions of government dollars aren't claimed, mostly because seniors don't know about it. Specifically, there is money out there to help us pay for groceries, utilities, prescriptions, etc.

To get help, call the Benefits CheckUp helpline at 800-794-6559. You can also go online directly to benefitscheckup.org to see if you're eligible for any of the help. You don't need to sign up. You will still be shown a list of help options. I ended up with a list of over 80 programs.

 1 1/2 cups 2% low-fat plain Greek yogurt
 2 tablespoons honey
 2 tablespoons chopped, unsalted almonds
 1/2 cup chopped mango
 1/4 cup blackberries or raspberries
 1/2 cup blueberries
 In medium bowl, mix yogurt and honey.

Line 9-by-13-inch baking dish with parchment paper. Use spatula or knife to spread yogurt over entire bottom of dish. Pour chopped nuts over yogurt. Use fingers to slightly press into yogurt. Top yogurt with mango, blackberries and blueberries and slightly press into yogurt. Cover with plastic wrap or foil and place in freezer overnight. To serve: Lift parchment paper from baking dish onto cutting board. Use hands to break bark into pieces.

Grilled Tequila-Lime Chicken with Grilled Asparagus

 Servings: 4
 1/4 cup tequila or white vinegar
 2 teaspoons lime zest
 1/2 cup fresh lime juice
 2 medium garlic cloves, minced
 1 tablespoon chipotle pepper canned in adobo sauce, minced, plus 2 tablespoons adobo sauce
 1 1/2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breasts, fat discarded
 nonstick cooking spray
 3 bunches asparagus spears, trimmed
 1/4 teaspoon salt
 1/2 teaspoon black pepper, divided
 2 tablespoons canola oil or corn oil

In small bowl, stir tequila, lime zest, lime juice, garlic, chipotle pepper and adobo sauce. Pour into large resealable plastic bag. Add chicken and seal bag tightly; turn bag to coat. Refrigerate 2-12 hours. Preheat grill to medium-high heat. Lightly spray grates with nonstick cooking spray. In large dish, sprinkle asparagus with salt and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Drizzle with oil. Turn asparagus over to coat. Remove chicken from marinade. Discard marinade and wipe most of it off chicken. Sprinkle chicken with remaining pepper. Grill 8-12 minutes, or until chicken is no longer pink in center. Transfer to plate and cover with aluminum foil. Place asparagus on grill, facing opposite direction of grates. Grill 7 minutes, or until tender crisp. Serve asparagus with chicken.

Chewy Chunky Blondies



Ingredients

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ¾ teaspoon baking powder
- ½ teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 cup unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 1½ cups light brown sugar
- ½ cup granulated sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup butterscotch chips
- 1 cup coarsely chopped walnuts
- 1 cup sweetened shredded coconut

Instructions

Preheat the oven to 325 degrees F. Butter a 9x13-inch baking pan; set aside.

In a medium bowl, whisk together the flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt.

With a stand or hand mixer, beat the butter on medium speed until smooth and creamy, about 1 minute. Add both sugars and beat for another 3 minutes, until well incorporated. Add the eggs one at a time, beating until fully incorporated after each addition, then beat in the vanilla. Reduce the mixer speed to low and add the flour mixture, mixing just until they disappear into the batter.

Using a rubber spatula, stir in the chips, nuts and coconut. Scrape the batter into the buttered pan and use the spatula to even the top as best as you can.

Bake for 35 to 40 minutes, or until a knife inserted into the center of the blondies comes out clean. The blondies should pull away from the sides of the pan a little and the top should be a nice honey brown. Transfer the pan to a rack and cool completely. Cut into bars; store in an airtight container at room temperature for up to 4 days.

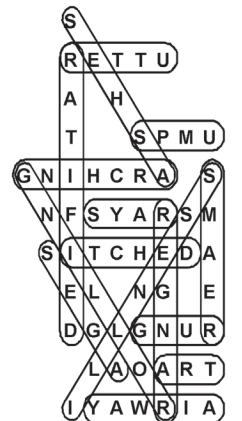
