Tasting Tips

Enhance your wine tasting experience with these tips from Grand River Cellars Winery owner Cindy Lindberg

1. Look at your wine and observe the color. See if it's clear and bright. It's best to put your glass up against a white background.

2. Aerate your wine before drinking it. This can be done by using an aerator or by swirling your glass.

3. Be sure to take a minute to sniff your wine before drinking it to enhance your tasting experience. The aroma will give you a sense of what to expect in your glass.

4. When tasting wine, always taste twice. The first sip is cleansing your palate. The second sip is getting the true flavors of the wine.

5. Allow the wine to linger on your tongue in order to savor the flavors.

aci Winery is the re-imagining of a Lake County favorite in the heart of Grand River Valley wine country.

That re-imagining began in February 2021 with the purchase of the popular St. Joseph Vineyard in Harpersfield Township by Highland Heights residents Dominic and Shelley Piunno.

Dominic Piunno is the owner of MCR Printing and Packaging in Willoughby. He and his wife, Shelley, have overseen a remarkable transformation of the 60-acre property.

With its complex of new and renovated buildings, patio, and vineyard, along with an impressive wine list and expanded food menu, Baci Winery is positioned to compete with established, ambitious wineries in the Grand River Valley. "Our vision for Baci Winery is to offer a unique experience with exceptional wines, high quality Italian food and a beautiful property," Dominic Piunno said. "Our team is dedicated to creating the best of what our land and our space can provide so that our guests enjoy Baci during each and every visit."

The Piunnos engaged the services of Candace DiGirolamo to be vineyard and operations manager of Baci. She is well-versed in the dynamics of the Grand River Valley, having previously held the same jobs at nearby Laurentia Vineyard and Winery.

"This is Ohio's wine country, a destination for people to enjoy," DiGirolamo said. "The GRV is becoming an experience and not just a place to drink wine."

DiGirolamo savors the challenge of having her hands on every phase of the operation at Baci. The winery has 32 employees. "We want this to be a welcoming, happy place where people can

relax, enjoy great wine and food while experiencing the environment of wine country," she said.

weather months in Northeast Ohio," DiGirolamo said. "Having a large outdoor space to accommodate guests is so important."

A graduate of the viticulture program at Kent State University Ashtabula, DiGirolamo spends many an hour tending to nine acres of wine grape vines at Baci.

Varieties under cultivation at Baci include Pinot Noir, Pinot Gris, Chardonnay, Corvina and Saperavi.

"When you take over a vineyard, you have to learn how it grows," DiGirolamo said. "These vines needed some work at the beginning. It will take time to get them where I want them to be."

DiGirolamo sees Baci and the other Grand River Valley wineries having an uplifting effect on each other's businesses.

"I don't look at it as competition," she said. "Every winery offers something different. The more options we offer, the more people will come to our wine country."



Immersive Nature

Stroll through the lush forest and get close-ups of grazing deer and keep your eyes open for many different species of birds throughout park. If you're searching for a little more of a workout on your hike, visit the 400acre Chapin Forest Reservation where nearly six miles of trails await. Walk up the Lucky Stone Loop Trail for one of the most amazing, panoramic views in all of northeast Ohio. So good you can almost see Canada on a clear day!

You may have been to an arboretum or botanical garden in your hometown or on another trip, but we promise you've never experienced anything like the 3,000-acre, Holden Arboretum.
