Appeals Court bars the doors to citizens seeking to protect their rights

The Minnesota Court of Appeals issued a decision on February 12 denying a motion to intervene in Dr. Jane Doe, et al. v. State of Minnesota, a Ramsey County District Court case in which the lower court judge struck down a longstanding safety protection law requiring abortion providers to notify a girl's parents before performing an abortion on the

Mothers Offering Maternal Support, known as MOMS, is a statewide group of 60 mothers of minor-age daughters who have come together to defend this longstanding health and safety protection for young women. The group is represented by Teresa Collett, Esq.

The Minnesota Court of Appeals affirmed the trial court's ruling denying intervention on the basis that it was untimely. According to the court, some members of MOMS read early newspaper accounts of the case and therefore had an opportunity to intervene at an earlier stage. The court that made MOMS' motion timely: 1) plaintiffs had filed an amended complaint only one month prior to the trial court striking down the parental notice law; 2) other parties had tried to intervene to defend the law and were denied on the lower court's assurance that the Attorney General would defend the law vigorously; and 3) the Attorney General dropped his defense of the law after the trial court ruling.

The policy implications of this decision should be a concern to all Minnesotans. In its opinion the trial court noted several times that state officials failed to provide any evidence supporting the right of parents to guide their young daughters when responding to an unplanned pregnancy. When MOMS asked the court to allow it to provide the missing evidence, the Attorney General joined the plaintiffs in fighting to keep MOMS out of the case. That the Attorney General failed to defend

ignored three relevant facts the law is significant to this case, yet the Court of Appeals makes no mention of that critical fact, nor any reference to the expert declarations that MOMS filed in the district court, clearly demonstrating the Attorney General's inadequate defense of the parental notification statute.

Now more than ever, the Minnesota Supreme Court needs to step in to make sure that when the Attorney General fails to do his job, ordinary Minnesota citizens can protect their own and others statutory and constitutional rights.

After learning about the Court of Appeal's decision today, MOMS Representative Dr. Jessica Chastek said, "Minnesota courts are the backstop to the enforcement of the law when the government has deprived citizens of their constitutional rights. We expect the courts to allow parents to intervene when state officials like the Attorney General have stepped aside and refused to protect the rights of parents of

minor daughters, especially in matters relating to life altering healthcare and medical decisions."

With advice of its legal counsel, MOMS is prepared to take the matter up on appeal to the state's highest court.

"We are confident the Minnesota Supreme Court will understand the importance their daughters from sexual exploitation and be involved in life-changing medical decisions. The court of appeals has upheld a dangerous precedent allowing a partisan attorney general to fail to defend state law, then fight allowing parents the ability to protect their unique interest. Put

of MOMS right to protect simply, this decision bars the courthouse door to citizens to intervene when the Attorney General fails in his duty to defend state law," said MOMS' attorney, Teresa Collett. "We are optimistic that the Court of final review will allow these Minnesota mothers to protect their constitutional rights under the law."
