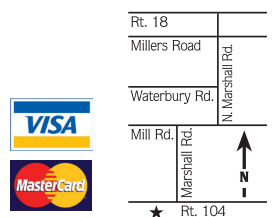

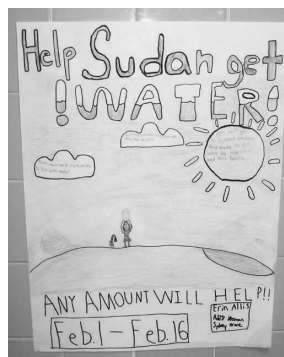

Clifford Wise Students Inspired By Book To Raise Money for a Well in Sudan



Fifth grade students at Clifford Wise Intermediate School are taking action to bring clean water to the Sudan after reading a book based on Salva Dut's life. His story, A Long Walk to Water, was told by New York Times bestselling author Linda Sue Park.

Mr. Sut was born in a rural village in southwestern Sudan in the Dinka tribe. When he was 11 years old, the Sudanese Civil War reached his village and separated Salva from his family. He and thousands of other boys were known as the Lost Boys of Sudan. They sought refuge in Ethiopia and Kenya by walking thousands of miles by foot where he faced many hardships and dangers. After living in a refugee camp for ten years, he moved to Rochester, New York and was sponsored and embraced by a family there who wanted to help him have a better life. He eventually returned to Sudan to reunite with his father, who was ill from waterborne parasites. His father's illness inspired him to bring clean water to the people in his country by establishing a foundation that installs deep-water wells in remote villages in dire need of clean water.

Teachers Deb Weber (Social Studies) and Michelle Gerdes (Science) talked about the story with their students and the how the lack of clean water impacted their lives. "It was a big surprise to our students that they couldn't go to a faucet and turn on the water," says Weber. "It was eye-opening for them that people would have to walk for miles to get a bucket of water and this is how they had to live." "I felt it was a very touching subject," says student Erin. "It's important to remember not everyone has it as good as you."

Gerdes says the students talked about the book and Salva's mission for weeks in class. "We really went into the scarcity of water and how these people's lives and health were impacted. It obviously really touched the students because we would hear them talking about it on their way to lunch and wanting to know what could they do to help." One student James said he enjoyed reading the book. "I liked it and knew I wanted to do something to help the people of Sudan." His schoolmate Noah says more people should read the book. "I think it would inspire them and make them aware of what the people in Sudan are going through and how much they need clean water." The students' passion for the book inspired other fifth grade teachers to read the book in class.

A foundation called Water for South Sudan, which is based in Rochester, raises money that supports the population of the country to access clean water and afford communities additional educational and economic opportunities. The Medina students decided to bring attention to that cause by posting posters around the school and setting up pails and boxes for their schoolmates and community members to donate to. "The kids came together as a team and assigned different jobs to one another to promote this charity," says Gerdes. "Some made posters, some wrote and spoke at announcements each morning about the fundraising efforts. They wanted to make a difference." Student Kailana says she was very inspired to help the foundation. "I made posters to put around the school. I have also been saving my change and bringing it in to donate. My mother said I could take her change as well to help with our fundraiser."

The students' efforts raised over \$300 for the foundation. Both Weber and Gerdes say they are incredibly proud of the students and the efforts they made for this worthwhile cause that will change the fate of so many in the Sudan.

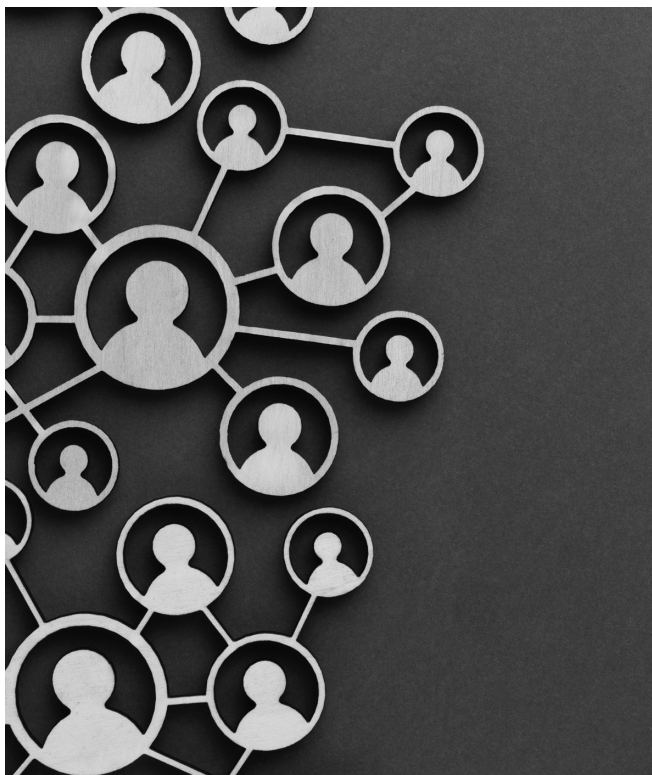

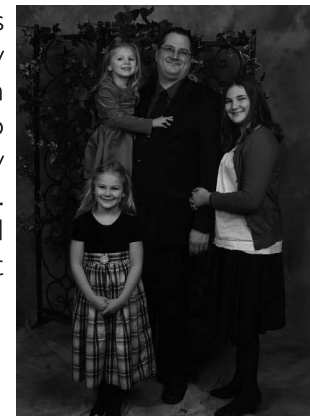

Medina Lions Club Provides Vision Screening for Oak Orchard

Did you know that 80% of all visual impairment can be prevented or cured? The first step to prevention is awareness. The second is early detection through vision screening. Recently at Oak Orchard Primary School, the Medina Lions Club partnered with medical professionals and community leaders to screen 62 students to identify those at risk for vision loss.

Oak Orchard Principal Jennifer Stearns says that the students were referred by their teachers and all of the kindergarten students had the opportunity to participate as well. "Eleven students were found to be in need of further evaluation. We are thankful to the Lions Club for not only offering this service, but providing families with financial support with the evaluation and a pair of glasses if needed."

The Lions Club schedules vision screenings every school year and the service is free to the community. Each screening takes approximately

five minutes or less and the results are given immediately. Although not a complete eye screening, it indicates when a full ophthalmological evaluation would be beneficial.

Lions KidSight USA Foundation is a nationwide program to safeguard children's vision, concentrating on children age six months through six years, but screening through grade 12 where possible is acceptable. According to educational experts 80% of learning is visual. So if a child can't see well, he or she cannot learn well.

The Lions' vision programs and vision screenings include programs that have, among other things: "Saved the sight of more than 15 million children by providing eye screenings, glasses and other treatments through Sight for Kids."

Making healthcare easier with technology

To keep you healthy and make sure we're addressing any barriers to good health, your providers need information. We ask parents about what their kids are doing or not doing at different ages, we ask if you've been feeling depressed or unhappy. We ask for insurance information so that your bills don't go to you and cause stress, we need to know if you have trouble getting transportation to the health center so we can arrange it for you. We even ask all our patients to provide us with their approximate annual income so we can receive federal dollars to support our patients in need.

Information is vital to providing care – but paper isn't! When we use paper forms, we create paper waste, and then we use our staff's valuable time to enter your information into our medical records. Time that could be spent answering your calls or taking care of patients in the waiting room. Our goal is to maximize the time we spend doing things that are directly beneficial to our patients. And of course, technology is helping us along the way.



Self-check-in

Tired of writing down your address every year in your health record even though you've lived in the same place since you were born? Self-check-in gives you the ability to review and approve existing demographic information. If you have a cell phone, you will receive a check-in link a few days before your appointment. With this link, you can confirm your appointment, and review your address, phone number, and insurance, even your medical history. When you arrive at the health center you can walk up to the receptionist when called and simply tell them that you filled out the self-check-in information. There still may be a few documents that need to be signed and payment may need to be received, but all the basic information about you and your loved ones will have already been done.

Keep in mind that self-check-in will come from a phone number that your phone may not recognize. We all have to be careful about clicking links from unknown numbers. The way you'll know this is a legitimate text is that it will include your name and an accurate appointment date. Then you can safely click on the link to review your information. In the future, self-check-in will become more complete allowing you to confirm other medical and personal information in the comfort of your home.

Kiosks at our health centers

Do not have a cell phone or forgot to do self-check-in? No problem. The Alexander, Pembroke, and Batavia offices now have kiosks in the waiting area. Soon all our health centers will have them.

What is a kiosk? It's a free-standing machine (think ATM) and it's super easy to use. Start by signing in with your name and birth date then begin to confirm or add information. Make sure your address and phone are correct. The kiosk also allows you to identify the person(s) you want to share your health information with should you need to do so. You can also review your medical history, just like in self-check-in.

You will still need to step up to the registration desk when it is your turn to let them know you are here to sign a few documents and review payment, but kiosks help us to reduce wait times by giving people different options to check-in.

Why is Oak Orchard Health getting rid of paper?

We always have our eye on patient experience, safe and high-quality care, and cost of care. In addition to the benefits to staff time mentioned before, the cost of printing and safely destroying documents is high and there's always a risk that a piece of paper with your information on it is given to the wrong person or dropped where it shouldn't be. The less paper we use, the more cost-effective we can be and the less risk there is of having your information in the wrong hands.
