





#### LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

The publisher does not necessarily share the views/opinions stated in the "Letters to the Editor" published in The Lakes News Shopper. To The Editor:

And the beat goes on for those of us along the route of the CO2 pipeline proposed by Summit Carbon Solutions. It's been around two years since most of us first heard about the project. Many aspects of the project are very concerning and we have received little to no information to allay our fears.

We continue to meet with local government officials with the hopes of getting sensible setback distances from the pipeline established. Homes, schools, hospitals, nursing homes and the like will find themselves in danger if this is not done. Quite simply, if a rupture happens it will be impossible for these vulnerable populations to have a chance of survival without these setbacks in place.

Landowners and supporters continue to lobby state government officials to enact legislation to put guardrails on the use of eminent domain. This is a strong sword that is only meant to be a last resort to allow for infrastructure projects for the good of all of society. It's not a tool in the toolbox of private companies so they can force their project on unwilling landowners. All Iowans must realize that their property may be the next target if eminent domain use for private projects is allowed.

The number of affected landowners recently grew exponentially when twelve POET ethanol plants agreed to sign up to be on Summit's pipeline. That doubles the number of facilities along the Summit route in Iowa and totally changes the footprint of the project. Sadly, many landowners and neighbors are unaware that they are on the route of the newly expanded project.

The Iowa Utilities Board is currently considering whether or not to grant Summit's permit to construct the project. It no longer seems appropriate for them to consider the application before them as it no longer encompasses Summit's full vision for the project. IUB proceedings should be paused and no permit granted until this is examined further.

Landowners have stayed committed to protecting their land from this project for so long because they understand that the web of issues that surround it will have a huge impact on the physical and legal landscape of Iowa for years to come- for better or worse. Please learn how close your community is to the proposed route and join with landowners, who above all, are fighting to maintain private property rights.

### **Corridor to Host Business Succession Panel**

Panelists include Duane Johnson, Program Manager with Iowa State University Extension; Dan Nieland, Small Business Education Specialist (Agriculture) at Iowa State University Extension; Kirsten Case Fuller, Regional Director of the North Central Iowa SBDC; and Gary Sterling, Director of the Lamberti Center for Rural Entrepreneurship and Instructor of Management at BVU.



#### **Dear Motor Medics,**

We have a 2008 Chevrolet Tahoe and when it was just a year old, we got a new puppy. The first time we left it alone while we went inside a restaurant to eat, she decided to eat the Tahoe. She chewed the back of the rear seat and the corner off the plastic trim too. The vehicle is in great shape with 70,000 miles and we want to sell it, but with a large hole in the seat and the damage to the plastic side trim it's making the sale very difficult. We checked with the dealer, and they are telling us they can repair it at a cost of over \$3500.00 parts and labor and our insurance will not cover repairs. Can you suggest anything that we can do in the way of a repair to save some money?

Thanks, David in Watertown, SD.

#### Dear David,

New interior parts can be very expensive so many people leave their vehicles unrepaired. What's wrong with a seat and trim from another Tahoe of the same year that has no damage? Look into certified used parts. Ask your dealer if they can find these parts so you can get a repair that makes more financial sense. With the hundreds of reliable used parts sources in the country they should be able to find a match for a late model vehicle like yours and make the repair affordable. There is always a way.

#### **Dear Motor Medics,**

We have a 2002 Hyundai Santa Fe that has been having the check brake light come on periodically. The fluid tank slowly drains so we fill the brake fluid, and it works fine for a while then comes on again. We had a mechanic look at it and told us we would have to replace the HCU in the brake system and that the part alone is about \$1600.00. Is this a common problem and does this sound reasonable? Is there anything else we can do? I'm a little hesitant to spend so much on a repair on a 10-year-old vehicle, when the value is maybe a little more than twice the cost to repair the problem.

#### Dear Kay,

The HCU is the Hydraulic Control Unit and it's the main component of the antilock brake system. The units don't tend to leak fluid but rather fail electrically so I would take a very close look at the lines going to the unit which are more common to fail. Shop around for brakes. A second opinion never hurts if you have any questions and by asking us, we assume that you do. When you have an older vehicle or any vehicle for that matter it is important to keep repairs economical but it's also important to be safe. Brakes are not an area to cut corners in but there are always ways to save money when repairing them.

#### An Ugly Win is a Good Win

I've said it for years in my coaching career that there is no such thing as a bad win and that it's better to win ugly than lose looking good, and on Saturday #6 Iowa State lived by those sayings with a 71-64 win over West Virginia. The Cyclones entered the game as an 18.5-point favorite versus the tied for last place Mountaineers, but this was a game that worried me all week as West Virginia has just gotten their roster back in full force following some players being granted eligibility in December and then others returning from injuries, and they had beaten teams like Kansas and Texas. Iowa State was coming off a hard-fought 73-65 loss at #2 Houston earlier in the week, and I felt like they were prime for a letdown after that physical loss in a game where they played the Cougars as tough as anyone has all year at Houston.

The Cyclone letdown was evident from the start as WVU raced out to a quick 11-2 lead behind some sloppy ISU turnovers and three-point jumpers. The Cyclones would quickly respond and take a 21-17 lead midway through the half behind six straight points by Keshon Gilbert. ISU would finish building on that lead and take a 40-30 lead into halftime. It looked like ISU would pull away early in the second half, but the Mountaineers would not go away and even take a brief 51-50 lead during a 1-8 shooting slump. Fortunately, the Cyclones would once again respond with a game-clinching 14-0 run to take a 64-51 lead with 3:27 remaining, and the Mountaineers would get no closer than the seven-point final margin of victory. Iowa State was not sharp on offense, but as they have done most of the season, they kept the pressure up on defense, forcing 23 WVU turnovers that led to 29 Cyclone points. Tamin Lipsey bounced back after a rough game at Houston to lead ISU with 14 points and 6 assists, Curtis Jones continued his push for the 6th Man of the Year in the Big 12 with 12 points and 4 rebounds. Iowa State also got huge minutes off the bench from Jackson Paveletzke, who scored 9 points in 16 key minutes of action.

The victory pushed the Cyclones to 21-6 overall and 10-4 in the rugged Big 12, which is good for solo possession of second place. Hilton Magic is alive and well, as the Cyclones pushed their home record to an impressive 16-0. Hopefully the ugly win on Saturday will grab Iowa State's attention that there are no "gimmes" in the Big 12 and they respond with a better effort on Wednesday versus Oklahoma, a team who beat the Cyclones early in Big 12 play. As we creep into March, I'm sure any Cyclone fan would have taken a 21-6 record and second place in the Big 12 at the start of the season, especially when ISU returned from their ESPN Tournament in Orlando with a 1-2 record and fourth place finish. The ceiling for this Cyclone team is higher than any of the past few years because they have the offense to go with their stingy defense, and as they showed on Saturday, as long as they guard like they can, when that offense is off, they can still win games. I know this Cyclone fan will be happy with any win moving forward in March, even the ugly ones!








#### Discovery House News





This will seem familiar to some of you because it has been published before. Earlier this week, a gentleman came to the Spencer Campus Discovery House to offer his skills as a volunteer. While talking with him, he shared that there was an article once that really helped someone dear to him. It was a nice reminder that people do read these articles, and that maybe it helps. Even if just one more person reads this and finds comfort and understanding, all the weekly articles become worth it. This was the article that was mentioned. I hope it finds the one who needs it the most right now.

To love an addict To many of you, this may be information you already know. Maybe it will be the validation that you need to know that you aren't crazy or that you aren't alone. Now, I want to clarify that I am referring to addicts/alcoholics that are in active addiction, meaning that they are currently using drugs or alcohol. That does not mean that some of this cannot be true for a dry addict (not actively using), or even someone in recovery, but that is not my focus for this article.

Loving an addict, as a family member, friend, or spouse/significant other is... exhausting. By exhausting, I mean you experience a variety of emotions at various times including: rage, disappointment, betrayal, distrust, devastation, hopelessness, desperation, etc.

Often, by the time we realize that the person we love has a problem with addiction, we have already become the caretaker, enabler, secret keeper, and "co-dependent". Maybe that looks like searching the bars for them at night, calling their boss to tell them that they have the "flu", or hiding from the kids that mom/dad didn't come home last night.

Sometimes, loving an addict means being told that you are the problem, that "if only" you would have done "xyz" then they wouldn't have relapsed, or that you are crazy because that bottle/ pipe/pill is not theirs and they have not used. And sometimes, no matter how badly your heart breaks, you have to let go and let them face their own consequences. If you are one of the people who has experienced a life of loving an addict, you know that what I just said feels like the most impossible suggestion ever. And many of us don't successfully let go. We beg, barter, negotiate, plead, threaten, cry, promise to never give up, and promise we're done forever.

The addict/alcoholic will lie, cheat, steal, beg, cry, promise to change, use/drink again, and lie again while looking you in the eye with the most convincing story ever. The cycle continues. But we don't have to keep going with that cycle. We have a choice, and we can step away while still loving the addict!

If you or someone you know is currently trying to get out of the cycle and aren't sure how, there are people who can help. I will have a list of resources available for anyone interested. You are not alone. Spirit Lake 712-336-5340, Spencer 712-580-5340, or call/ text 712-363-2722.







Grilled Buffalo Wings In a small bowl, combine the salt, pepper and garlic powder. 1 tablespoon kosher salt

In a large bowl, toss the wings with 1 teaspoon ground black pepper the salt mixture to evenly coat. Preheat a gas grill to medium heat 1 teaspoon garlic powder (about 350°F). Place the wings on 3 pounds whole chicken wings the grill, crowding them together so

that they are all touching (so they 6 tablespoons unsalted butter steam to stay moist). Grill, flipping the wings every 5 minutes, for a total of 20 minutes of cooking. 1/3 cup hot sauce

In the meantime, heat the butter, hot sauce, vinegar, and honey in a saucepan over low heat and whisk to combine. In a clean large bowl, toss the wings with the sauce. Turn the heat up on the grill to medium-high. Use tongs to remove the wings from the sauce and put them back on the grill until the skins crisp, 1 to 2 minutes per side. 


